

KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

conceal a thing <u>20_PRO_25_02</u> # [It is] the glory of God to conceal a thing: but the honour of kings [is] to search out a matter.

conceal him <u>05_DEU_13_08</u> # Thou shalt not consent unto him, nor hearken unto him; neither shall thine eye pity him, neither shalt thou spare, neither shalt thou conceal him:

conceal his blood <u>01_GEN_37_26</u># And Judah said unto his brethren, What profit [is it] if we slay our brother, and conceal his blood?

conceal his parts 18_JOB_41_12 # I will not conceal his parts, nor his power, nor his comely proportion.

conceal not say <u>24 JER_50_02</u># Declare ye among the nations, and publish, and set up a standard; publish, [and] conceal not: say, Babylon is taken, Bel is confounded, Merodach is broken in pieces; her idols are confounded, her images are broken in pieces.

conceal <u>18_JOB_27_11</u># I will teach you by the hand of God: [that] which [is] with the Almighty will I not conceal.

concealed the words <u>18_JOB_06_10</u> # Then should I yet have comfort; yea, I would harden myself in sorrow: let him not spare; for I have not concealed the words of the Holy One.

concealed thy lovingkindness <u>19_PSA_40_10</u># I have not hid thy righteousness within my heart; I have declared thy faithfulness and thy salvation: I have not concealed thy lovingkindness and thy truth from the great congregation.

concealeth knowledge but <u>20_PRO_12_23</u> # A prudent man concealeth knowledge: but the heart of fools proclaimeth foolishness.

concealeth the matter <u>20_PRO_11_13</u> # A talebearer revealeth secrets: but he that is of a faithful spirit concealeth the matter.
