conscience also bearing 45 ROM 02 15.# Which show the work of the law written in their hearts, their conscience also bearing witness, and [their] thoughts the mean while accusing or else excusing one another;] conscience also bearing 45 ROM 09 01 # I say the truth in Christ, I lie not, my conscience also bearing me witness in the Holy Ghost,

conscience and of 54 1TI 01 05 # Now the end of the commandment is charity out of a pure heart, and [of] a good conscience, and [of] faith unfeigned:

conscience and our 58 HEB 10 22 # Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water.

conscience before God 44 ACT 23 01 # And Paul, earnestly beholding the council, said, Men [and] brethren, I have lived in all good conscience before God until this day.

conscience being weak 46 1CO 08 07 # Howbeit [there is] not in every man that knowledge: for some with conscience of the idol unto this hour eat [it] as a thing offered unto an idol; and their conscience being weak is defiled.

conscience from dead 58 HEB 09 14 # How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

Conscience I say 46 1CO 10 29 # Conscience, I say, not thine own, but of the other; for why is my liberty judged of another [man's] conscience?

conscience in all 58 HEB 13 18# Pray for us: for we trust we have a good conscience, in all things willing to live honestly

conscience in the 47 2CO 04 02 # But have renounced the hidden things of dishonesty, not walking in craftiness, nor handling the word of God deceitfully; but by manifestation of the truth commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God.

conscience is defiled 56 TIT 01 15 # Unto the pure all things [are] pure: but unto them that are defiled and unbelieving [is] nothing pure; but even their mind and conscience is defiled.

conscience of him 46 1CO 08 10 # For if any man see thee which hast knowledge sit at meat in the idol's temple, shall not the conscience of him which is weak be emboldened to eat those things which are offered to idols;

conscience of sins 58 HEB 10 02 # For then would they not have ceased to be offered? because that the worshippers once purged should have had no more conscience of sins.

conscience of the 46 1CO 08 07 # Howbeit [there is] not in every man that knowledge: for some with conscience of the idol unto this hour eat [it] as a thing offered unto an idol; and their conscience being weak is defiled.

conscience sake for 46 1CO 10 28 But if any man say unto you, This is offered in sacrifice unto idols, eat not for his sake that showed it, and for conscience sake: for the earth [is] the Lord's, and the fulness thereof:

conscience sake 46 1CO 10 25 # Whatsoever is sold in the shambles, [that] eat, asking no question for conscience sake

conscience sake 46 1CO 10 27 # If any of them that believe not bid you [to a feast], and ye be disposed to go; whatsoever is set before you, eat, asking no question for conscience sake.

conscience sake 45 ROM 13 05 # Wherefore [ye] must needs be subject, not only for wrath, but also for conscience sake.

conscience seared with 54 1TI 04 02 # Speaking lies in hypocrisy; having their conscience seared with a hot iron;

conscience that in 47 2CO 01 12 # For our rejoicing is this, the testimony of our conscience, that in simplicity and godly sincerity, not with fleshly wisdom, but by the grace of God, we have had our conversation in the world, and more abundantly to you ward.

conscience that whereas 60 1PE 03 16# Having a good conscience; that, whereas they speak evil of you, as of evildoers, they may be ashamed that falsely accuse your good conversation in Christ.

conscience that without 55 2TI 01 03.# I thank God, whom I serve from [my] forefathers with pure conscience, that without ceasing I have remembrance of thee in my prayers night and day;

conscience toward God 60 1PE 03 21. The like figure whereunto [even] baptism doth also now save us [not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,] by the resurrection of Jesus Christ:

conscience void of 44 ACT 24 16 # And herein do I exercise myself, to have always a conscience void of offence toward God, and [toward] men

conscience went out 43 JOH 08 09 # And they which heard [it], being convicted by [their own] conscience, went out one by one, beginning at the eldest, [even] unto the last: and Jesus was left alone, and the woman standing in the midst.

conscience which some 54 1TI 01 19 # Holding faith, and a good conscience; which some having put away concerning faith have made shipwreck:

conscience ye sin 46 1CO 08 12 # But when ye sin so against the brethren, and wound their weak conscience, ye sin against Christ.

conscience 46 1CO 10 29 # Conscience, I say, not thine own, but of the other: for why is my liberty judged of another [man's] conscience?

conscience 54 1TI 03 09 # Holding the mystery of the faith in a pure conscience.
