constrained him saying [42 LUK 24 29](#) # But they constrained him, saying, Abide with us: for it is toward evening, and the day is far spent. And he went in to tarry with them.

constrained him to [12 2KI 04 08](#) # And it fell on a day, that Elisha passed to Shunem, where [was] a great woman; and she constrained him to eat bread. And [so] it was, [that] as oft as he passed by, he turned in thither to eat bread.

constrained his disciples [41 MAR 06 45](#) # And straightway he constrained his disciples to get into the ship, and to go to the other side before unto Bethsaida, while he sent away the people.

constrained his disciples [40 MAT 14 22](#) # And straightway Jesus constrained his disciples to get into a ship, and to go before him unto the other side, while he sent the multitudes away.
