contend by fire 30 AMO 07 04 # Thus hath the Lord GOD showed unto me: and, behold, the Lord GOD called to contend by fire, and it devoured the great deep, and did eat up a part.

contend for ever 23 ISA 57 16 # For I will not contend for ever, neither will I be always wroth: for the spirit should fail before me, and the souls [which] I have made.

contend for God 18 JOB 13 08 # Will ye accept his person? will ye contend for God?

contend for the 65 JDE 01 03 # Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort [you] that ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints.

contend thou before 33 MIC 06 01 # Hear ve now what the LORD saith; Arise, contend thou before the mountains, and let the hills hear thy voice.

contend with him <u>05 DEU 02 24</u># Rise ye up, take your journey, and pass over the river Arnon: behold, I have given into thine hand Sihon the Amorite, king of Heshbon, and his land: begin to possess [it], and contend with him in battle.

contend with him 21 ECC 06 10 # That which hath been is named already, and it is known that it [is] man: neither may be contend with him that is mightier than be.

contend with him 23 ISA 49 25 # But thus saith the LORD, Even the captives of the mighty shall be taken away, and the prey of the terrible shall be delivered: for I will contend with him that contendeth with thee, and I will save thy children.

contend with him 18 JOB 09 03 # If he will contend with him, he cannot answer him one of a thousand.

contend with horses 24 JER 12 05 # If thou hast run with the footmen, and they have wearied thee, then how canst thou contend with horses? and [if] in the land of peace, [wherein] thou trustedst, [they wearied thee], then how wilt thou do in the swelling of Jordan?

contend with me 23 ISA 50 08# [He is] near that justifieth me; who will contend with me? let us stand together: who [is] mine adversary? let him come near to me.

contend with me 24 JER 18 19 # Give heed to me, O LORD, and hearken to the voice of them that contend with me.

contend with them 05 DEU 02 09 # And the LORD said unto me, Distress not the Moabites, neither contend with them in battle: for I will not give thee of their land [for] a possession; because I have given Ar unto the children of Lot [for] a possession.

contend with them 20 PRO 28 04 # They that forsake the law praise the wicked: but such as keep the law contend with them.

contended I with 16 NEH 13 11# Then contended I with the rulers, and said, Why is the house of God forsaken? And I gathered them together, and set them in their place.

contended with him 44 ACT 11 02 # And when Peter was come up to Jerusalem, they that were of the circumcision contended with him,

contended with me 18 JOB 31 13# If I did despise the cause of my manservant or of my maidservant, when they contended with me;

contended with the 16 NEH 13 17# Then I contended with the nobles of Judah, and said unto them, What evil thing [is] this that ye do, and profane the sabbath day?

contended with thee 23 ISA 41 12 # Thou shalt seek them, and shalt not find them, [even] them that contended with thee: they that war against thee shall be as nothing, and as a thing of nought.

contended with them 16 NEH 13 25 # And I contended with them, and cursed them, and smote certain of them, and plucked off their hair, and made them swear by God, [saying], Ye shall not give your daughters unto their sons, nor take their daughters unto your sons, or for yourselves.

 $contendeth \ with \ a \ \underline{20 \ PRO \ 29 \ 09} \# [If] \ a \ wise \ man \ contendeth \ with \ a \ foolish \ man, \ whether \ he \ rage \ or \ laugh, \ [there \ is] \ no \ rest.$

contendeth with the 18 JOB 40 02 # Shall he that contendeth with the Almighty instruct [him]? he that reproveth God, let him answer it.

contendeth with thee 23 ISA 49 25 # But thus saith the LORD, Even the captives of the mighty shall be taken away, and the prey of the terrible shall be delivered: for I will contend with him that contendeth with thee, and I will save thy children.

contending with the 65_JDE_01_09 # Yet Michael the archangel, when contending with the devil he disputed about the body of Moses, durst not bring against him a railing accusation, but said, The Lord rebuke thee.
