couch and go <u>42_LUK_05_24</u># But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power upon earth to forgive sins, [he said unto the sick of the palsy,] I say unto thee, Arise, and take up thy couch, and go into thine house.

couch in their 18_JOB_38_40 # When they couch in [their] dens, [and] abide in the covert to lie in wait?

couch into the <u>42_LUK_05_19</u># And when they could not find by what [way] they might bring him in because of the multitude, they went upon the housetop, and let him down through the tiling with [his] couch into the midst before Jesus.

couch shall ease 18_JOB_07_13 # When I say, My bed shall comfort me, my couch shall ease my complaint;

couch with my 19_PSA_06_06_# I am weary with my groaning; all the night make I my bed to swim; I water my couch with my tears.

couch <u>30_AMO_03_12</u># Thus saith the LORD; As the shepherd taketh out of the mouth of the lion two legs, or a piece of an ear; so shall the children of Israel be taken out that dwell in Samaria in the corner of a bed, and in Damascus [in] a couch.

couch <u>01_GEN_49_04</u> # Unstable as water, thou shalt not excel; because thou wentest up to thy father's bed; then defiledst thou [it]: he went up to my couch.

couched as a <u>01_GEN_49_09</u> # Judah [is] a lion's whelp: from the prey, my son, thou art gone up: he stooped down, he couched as a lion, and as an old lion; who shall rouse him up?
