could answer a [23 ISA 41 28](#) # For I beheld, and [there was] no man; even among them, and [there was] no counsellor, that, when I asked of them, could answer a word.

could any man [41 MAR 05 04](#) # Because that he had been often bound with fetters and chains, and the chains had been plucked asunder by him, and the fetters broken in pieces: neither could any [man] tame him.

could be healed [42 LUK 08 43](#) # And a woman having an issue of blood twelve years, which had spent all her living upon physicians, neither could be healed of any,

could bear with [47 2CO 11 01](#) # Would to God ye could bear with me a little in [my] folly: and indeed bear with me.

could bind him [41 MAR 05 03](#) # Who had [his] dwelling among the tombs; and no man could bind him, no, not with chains:

could carry away [14 2CH 20 25](#) # And when Jehoshaphat and his people came to take away the spoil of them, they found among them in abundance both riches with the dead bodies, and precious jewels, which they stripped off for themselves, more than they could carry away: and they were three days in gathering of the spoil, it was so much.

could declare it [01 GEN 41 24](#) # And the thin ears devoured the seven good ears: and I told [this] unto the magicians; but [there was] none that could declare [it] to me.

could deliver his [14 2CH 32 14](#) # Who [was there] among all the gods of those nations that my fathers utterly destroyed, that could deliver his people out of mine hand, that your God should be able to deliver you out of mine hand?

could deliver out [27 DAN 08 04](#) # I saw the ram pushing westward, and northward, and southward; so that no beasts might stand before him, neither [was there any] that could deliver out of his hand; but he did according to his will, and became great.

could deliver the [27 DAN 08 07](#) # And I saw him come close unto the ram, and he was moved with choler against him, and smote the ram, and brake his two horns: and there was no power in the ram to stand before him, but he cast him down to the ground, and stamped upon him: and there was none that could deliver the ram out of his hand.

could do nothing [43 JOH 09 33](#) # If this man were not of God, he could do nothing.

could find a [07 JUD 17 08](#) # And the man departed out of the city from Bethlehemjudah to sojourn where he could find [a place]: and he came to mount Ephraim to the house of Micah, as he journeyed.

could find none [27 DAN 06 04](#) # Then the presidents and princes sought to find occasion against Daniel concerning the kingdom; but they could find none occasion nor fault; forasmuch as he [was] faithful, neither was there any error or fault found in him.

could go And [09 ISA 23 13](#) # Then David and his men, [which were] about six hundred, arose and departed out of Keilah, and went whithersoever they could go. And it was told Saul that David was escaped

from Keilah; and he forbore to go forth.

could handle shield [13 1CH 12 08](#) # And of the Gadites there separated themselves unto David into the hold to the wilderness men of might, [and] men of war [fit] for the battle, that could handle shield and buckler, whose faces [were like] the faces of lions, and [were] as swift as the roes upon the mountains;

could handle spear [14 2CH 25 05](#) # Moreover Amaziah gathered Judah together, and made them captains over thousands, and captains over hundreds, according to the houses of [their] fathers, throughout all Judah and Benjamin: and he numbered them from twenty years old and above, and found them three hundred thousand choice [men, able] to go forth to war, that could handle spear and shield.

could have been [23 ISA 05 04](#) # What could have been done more to my vineyard, that I have not done in it? wherefore, when I looked that it should bring forth grapes, brought it forth wild grapes?

could have borne [19 PSA 55 12](#) # For [it was] not an enemy [that] reproached me; then I could have borne [it]: neither [was it] he that hated me [that] did magnify [himself] against me; then I would have hid myself from him:

could have given [48 GAL 03 21](#) # [Is] the law then against the promises of God? God forbid: for if there had been a law given which could have given life, verily righteousness should have been by the law.

could he not [28 HOS 05 13](#) # When Ephraim saw his sickness, and Judah [saw] his wound, then went Ephraim to the Assyrian, and sent to king Jareb: yet could he not heal you, nor cure you of your wound.

could heap up [18 JOB 16 04](#) # I also could speak as ye [do]: if your soul were in my soul's stead, I could heap up words against you, and shake mine head at you.

could hear with [16 NEH 08 02](#) # And Ezra the priest brought the law before the congregation both of men and women, and all that could hear with understanding, upon the first day of the seventh month.

could in no [42 LUK 13 11](#) # And, behold, there was a woman which had a spirit of infirmity eighteen years, and was bowed together, and could in no wise lift up [herself].

could interpret them [01 GEN 41 08](#) # And it came to pass in the morning that his spirit was troubled; and he sent and called for all the magicians of Egypt, and all the wise men thereof: and Pharaoh told them his dream; but [there was] none that could interpret them unto Pharaoh.

could keep rank [13 1CH 12 33](#) # Of Zebulun, such as went forth to battle, expert in war, with all instruments of war, fifty thousand, which could keep rank: [they were] not of double heart.

could keep rank [13 1CH 12 38](#) # All these men of war, that could keep rank, came with a perfect heart to Hebron, to make David king over all Israel: and all the rest also of Israel [were] of one heart to make David king.

could know another [08 RUT 03 14](#) # And she lay at his feet until the morning: and she rose up before one could know another. And he said, Let it not be known that a woman came into the floor.

could learn that [66 REV 14 03](#) # And they sung as it were a new song before the throne, and before the four beasts, and the elders: and no man could learn that song but the hundred [and] forty [and] four thousand, which were redeemed from the earth.

could no longer [52 1TH 03 01](#) # Wherefore when we could no longer forbear, we thought it good to be left at Athens alone;

could no longer [52 1TH 03 05](#) # For this cause, when I could no longer forbear, I sent to know your faith,

lest by some means the tempter have tempted you, and our labour be in vain.

could no longer [24 JER 44 22](#) # So that the LORD could no longer bear, because of the evil of your doings, [and] because of the abominations which ye have committed; therefore is your land a desolation, and an astonishment, and a curse, without an inhabitant, as at this day.

could no more [41 MAR 01 45](#) # But he went out, and began to publish [it] much, and to blaze abroad the matter, insomuch that Jesus could no more openly enter into the city, but was without in desert places: and they came to him from every quarter.

could not answer [10 2SA 03 11](#) # And he could not answer Abner a word again, because he feared him.

could not answer [01 GEN 45 03](#) # And Joseph said unto his brethren, I [am] Joseph; doth my father yet live? And his brethren could not answer him; for they were troubled at his presence.

could not answer [42 LUK 14 06](#) # And they could not answer him again to these things.

could not any [07 JUD 02 14](#) # And the anger of the LORD was hot against Israel, and he delivered them into the hands of spoilers that spoiled them, and he sold them into the hands of their enemies round about, so that they could not any longer stand before their enemies.

could not arise [10 2SA 22 39](#) # And I have consumed them, and wounded them, that they could not arise: yea, they are fallen under my feet.

could not be [11 1KI 08 05](#) # And king Solomon, and all the congregation of Israel, that were assembled unto him, [were] with him before the ark, sacrificing sheep and oxen, that could not be told nor numbered for multitude.

could not be [09 1SA 10 21](#) # When he had caused the tribe of Benjamin to come near by their families, the family of Matri was taken, and Saul the son of Kish was taken: and when they sought him, he could not be found.

could not be [14 2CH 04 18](#) # Thus Solomon made all these vessels in great abundance: for the weight of the brass could not be found out.

could not be [14 2CH 05 06](#) # Also king Solomon, and all the congregation of Israel that were assembled unto him before the ark, sacrificed sheep and oxen, which could not be told nor numbered for multitude.

could not be [44 ACT 13 39](#) # And by him all that believe are justified from all things, from which ye could not be justified by the law of Moses.

could not be [26 EZE 47 05](#) # Afterward he measured a thousand; [and it was] a river that I could not pass over: for the waters were risen, waters to swim in, a river that could not be passed over.

could not be [01 GEN 41 21](#) # And when they had eaten them up, it could not be known that they had eaten them; but they [were] still ill favoured, as at the beginning. So I awoke.

could not be [24 JER 15 01](#) # Then said the LORD unto me, Though Moses and Samuel stood before me, [yet] my mind [could] not [be] toward this people: cast [them] out of my sight, and let them go forth.

could not be [24 JER 24 02](#) # One basket [had] very good figs, [even] like the figs [that are] first ripe: and the other basket [had] very naughty figs, which could not be eaten, they were so bad.

could not be [41 MAR 07 24](#) # And from thence he arose, and went into the borders of Tyre and Sidon, and entered into an house, and would have no man know [it]: but he could not be hid.

could not be [19\\_PSA\\_37\\_36](#) # Yet he passed away, and, lo, he [was] not: yea, I sought him, but he could not be found.

could not bear [44\\_ACT\\_27\\_15](#) # And when the ship was caught, and could not bear up into the wind, we let [her] drive.

could not bear [01\\_GEN\\_36\\_07](#) # For their riches were more than that they might dwell together; and the land wherein they were strangers could not bear them because of their cattle.

could not believe [43\\_JOH\\_12\\_39](#) # Therefore they could not believe, because that Esaias said again,

could not build [11\\_1KI\\_05\\_03](#) # Thou knowest how that David my father could not build an house unto the name of the LORD his God for the wars which were about him on every side, until the LORD put them under the soles of his feet.

could not cause [15\\_EZR\\_05\\_05](#) # But the eye of their God was upon the elders of the Jews, that they could not cause them to cease, till the matter came to Darius: and then they returned answer by letter concerning this [matter].

could not come [42\\_LUK\\_08\\_19](#) # Then came to him [his] mother and his brethren, and could not come at him for the press.

could not come [41\\_MAR\\_02\\_04](#) # And when they could not come nigh unto him for the press, they uncovered the roof where he was: and when they had broken [it] up, they let down the bed wherein the sick of the palsy lay.

could not contain [43\\_JOH\\_21\\_25](#) # And there are also many other things which Jesus did, the which, if they should be written every one, I suppose that even the world itself could not contain the books that should be written. Amen.

could not countervail [17\\_EST\\_07\\_04](#) # For we are sold, I and my people, to be destroyed, to be slain, and to perish. But if we had been sold for bondmen and bondwomen, I had held my tongue, although the enemy could not countervail the king's damage.

could not cure [40\\_MAT\\_17\\_16](#) # And I brought him to thy disciples, and they could not cure him.

could not deliver [14\\_2CH\\_25\\_15](#) # Wherefore the anger of the LORD was kindled against Amaziah, and he sent unto him a prophet, which said unto him, Why hast thou sought after the gods of the people, which could not deliver their own people out of thine hand?

could not deliver [23\\_ISA\\_46\\_02](#) # They stoop, they bow down together; they could not deliver the burden, but themselves are gone into captivity.

could not discern [15\\_EZR\\_03\\_13](#) # So that the people could not discern the noise of the shout of joy from the noise of the weeping of the people: for the people shouted with a loud shout, and the noise was heard afar off.

could not discern [18\\_JOB\\_04\\_16](#) # It stood still, but I could not discern the form thereof: an image [was] before mine eyes, [there was] silence, and I heard a voice, [saying],

could not do [07\\_JUD\\_06\\_27](#) # Then Gideon took ten men of his servants, and did as the LORD had said unto him: and [so] it was, because he feared his father's household, and the men of the city, that he could not do [it] by day, that he did [it] by night.

could not do [45 ROM 08 03](#) # For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh:

could not draw [07 JUD 03 22](#) # And the haft also went in after the blade; and the fat closed upon the blade, so that he could not draw the dagger out of his belly; and the dirt came out.

could not drink [02 EXO 07 21](#) # And the fish that [was] in the river died; and the river stank, and the Egyptians could not drink of the water of the river; and there was blood throughout all the land of Egypt.

could not drink [02 EXO 07 24](#) # And all the Egyptians digged round about the river for water to drink; for they could not drink of the water of the river.

could not drink [02 EXO 15 23](#) # And when they came to Marah, they could not drink of the waters of Marah, for they [were] bitter: therefore the name of it was called Marah.

could not drink [19 PSA 78 44](#) # And had turned their rivers into blood; and their floods, that they could not drink.

could not drive [06 JOS 15 63](#) # As for the Jebusites the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the children of Judah could not drive them out: but the Jebusites dwell with the children of Judah at Jerusalem unto this day.

could not drive [06 JOS 17 12](#) # Yet the children of Manasseh could not drive out [the inhabitants of] those cities; but the Canaanites would dwell in that land.

could not drive [07 JUD 01 19](#) # And the LORD was with Judah; and he drave out [the inhabitants of] the mountain; but could not drive out the inhabitants of the valley, because they had chariots of iron.

could not dwell [01 GEN 13 06](#) # And the land was not able to bear them, that they might dwell together: for their substance was great, so that they could not dwell together.

could not eat [12 2KI 04 40](#) # So they poured out for the men to eat. And it came to pass, as they were eating of the pottage, that they cried out, and said, O [thou] man of God, [there is] death in the pot. And they could not eat [thereof].

could not endure [58 HEB 12 20](#) # [For they could not endure that which was commanded, And if so much as a beast touch the mountain, it shall be stoned, or thrust through with a dart:

could not endure [18 JOB 31 23](#) # For destruction [from] God [was] a terror to me, and by reason of his highness I could not endure.

could not enter [14 2CH 07 02](#) # And the priests could not enter into the house of the LORD, because the glory of the LORD had filled the LORD'S house.

could not enter [58 HEB 03 19](#) # So we see that they could not enter in because of unbelief.

could not find [10 2SA 17 20](#) # And when Absalom's servants came to the woman to the house, they said, Where [is] Ahimaaz and Jonathan? And the woman said unto them, They be gone over the brook of water. And when they had sought and could not find [them], they returned to Jerusalem.

could not find [42 LUK 05 19](#) # And when they could not find by what [way] they might bring him in because of the multitude, they went upon the housetop, and let him down through the tiling with [his] couch into the midst before Jesus.

could not find [42 LUK 19 48](#) # And could not find what they might do: for all the people were very attentive to hear him.

could not find [22 SON 05 06](#) # I opened to my beloved; but my beloved had withdrawn himself, [and] was gone: my soul failed when he spake: I sought him, but I could not find him; I called him, but he gave me no answer.

could not flay [14 2CH 29 34](#) # But the priests were too few, so that they could not flay all the burnt offerings: wherefore their brethren the Levites did help them, till the work was ended, and until the [other] priests had sanctified themselves: for the Levites [were] more upright in heart to sanctify themselves than the priests.

could not follow [09 ISA 30 21](#) # And David came to the two hundred men, which were so faint that they could not follow David, whom they had made also to abide at the brook Besor: and they went forth to meet David, and to meet the people that [were] with him: and when David came near to the people, he saluted them.

could not for [32 JON 01 13](#) # Nevertheless the men rowed hard to bring [it] to the land; but they could not: for the sea wrought, and was tempestuous against them.

could not for [42 LUK 19 03](#) # And he sought to see Jesus who he was; and could not for the press, because he was little of stature.

could not frame [07 JUD 12 06](#) # Then said they unto him, Say now Shibboleth: and he said Sibboleth: for he could not frame to pronounce [it] right. Then they took him, and slew him at the passages of Jordan: and there fell at that time of the Ephraimites forty and two thousand.

could not go [13 1CH 21 30](#) # But David could not go before it to inquire of God: for he was afraid because of the sword of the angel of the LORD.

could not go [09 ISA 30 10](#) # But David pursued, he and four hundred men: for two hundred abode behind, which were so faint that they could not go over the brook Besor.

could not hide [26 EZE 31 08](#) # The cedars in the garden of God could not hide him: the fir trees were not like his boughs, and the chestnut trees were not like his branches; nor any tree in the garden of God was like unto him in his beauty.

could not in [07 JUD 14 14](#) # And he said unto them, Out of the eater came forth meat, and out of the strong came forth sweetness. And they could not in three days expound the riddle.

could not keep [14 2CH 30 03](#) # For they could not keep it at that time, because the priests had not sanctified themselves sufficiently, neither had the people gathered themselves together to Jerusalem.

could not keep [04 NUM 09 06](#) # And there were certain men, who were defiled by the dead body of a man, that they could not keep the passover on that day: and they came before Moses and before Aaron on that day:

could not know [44 ACT 21 34](#) # And some cried one thing, some another, among the multitude: and when he could not know the certainty for the tumult, he commanded him to be carried into the castle.

could not live [10 2SA 01 10](#) # So I stood upon him, and slew him, because I was sure that he could not live after that he was fallen: and I took the crown that [was] upon his head, and the bracelet that [was] on his arm, and have brought them hither unto my lord.

could not longer [02 EXO 02 03](#) # And when she could not longer hide him, she took for him an ark of bulrushes, and daubed it with slime and with pitch, and put the child therein; and she laid [it] in the flags by the river's brink.



could not make [58 HEB 09 09](#) # Which [was] a figure for the time then present, in which were offered both gifts and sacrifices, that could not make him that did the service perfect, as pertaining to the conscience;

could not overcome [12 2KI 16 05](#) # Then Rezin king of Syria and Pekah son of Remaliah king of Israel came up to Jerusalem to war: and they besieged Ahaz, but could not overcome [him].

could not pass [26 EZE 47 05](#) # Afterward he measured a thousand; [and it was] a river that I could not pass over: for the waters were risen, waters to swim in, a river that could not be passed over.

could not prevail [23 ISA 07 01](#) # And it came to pass in the days of Ahaz the son of Jotham, the son of Uzziah, king of Judah, [that] Rezin the king of Syria, and Pekah the son of Remaliah, king of Israel, went up toward Jerusalem to war against it, but could not prevail against it.

could not profit [23 ISA 30 05](#) # They were all ashamed of a people [that] could not profit them, nor be an help nor profit, but a shame, and also a reproach.

could not prove [44 ACT 25 07](#) # And when he was come, the Jews which came down from Jerusalem stood round about, and laid many and grievous complaints against Paul, which they could not prove.

could not pull [11 1KI 13 04](#) # And it came to pass, when king Jeroboam heard the saying of the man of God, which had cried against the altar in Bethel, that he put forth his hand from the altar, saying, Lay hold on him. And his hand, which he put forth against him, dried up, so that he could not pull it in again to him.

could not read [27 DAN 05 08](#) # Then came in all the king's wise [men]: but they could not read the writing, nor make known to the king the interpretation thereof.

could not recover [14 2CH 14 13](#) # And Asa and the people that [were] with him pursued them unto Gerar: and the Ethiopians were overthrown, that they could not recover themselves; for they were destroyed before the LORD, and before his host; and they carried away very much spoil.

could not refrain [01 GEN 45 01](#) # Then Joseph could not refrain himself before all them that stood by him; and he cried, Cause every man to go out from me. And there stood no man with him, while Joseph made himself known unto his brethren.

could not save [25 LAM 04 17](#) # As for us, our eyes as yet failed for our vain help: in our watching we have watched for a nation [that] could not save [us].

could not see [11 1KI 14 04](#) # And Jeroboam's wife did so, and arose, and went to Shiloh, and came to the house of Ahijah. But Ahijah could not see; for his eyes were set by reason of his age.

could not see [09 ISA 03 02](#) # And it came to pass at that time, when Eli [was] laid down in his place, and his eyes began to wax dim, [that] he could not see;

could not see [09 ISA 04 15](#) # Now Eli was ninety and eight years old; and his eyes were dim, that he could not see.

could not see [44 ACT 22 11](#) # And when I could not see for the glory of that light, being led by the hand of them that were with me, I came into Damascus.

could not see [01 GEN 27 01](#) # And it came to pass, that when Isaac was old, and his eyes were dim, so that he could not see, he called Esau his eldest son, and said unto him, My son: and he said unto him, Behold, [here am] I.

could not see [01\\_GEN\\_48\\_10](#) # Now the eyes of Israel were dim for age, [so that] he could not see. And he brought them near unto him; and he kissed them, and embraced them.

could not shake [42\\_LUK\\_06\\_48](#) # He is like a man which built an house, and digged deep, and laid the foundation on a rock: and when the flood arose, the stream beat vehemently upon that house, and could not shake it: for it was founded upon a rock.

could not show [27\\_DAN\\_05\\_15](#) # And now the wise [men], the astrologers, have been brought in before me, that they should read this writing, and make known unto me the interpretation thereof: but they could not show the interpretation of the thing:

could not show [15\\_EZR\\_02\\_59](#) # And these [were] they which went up from Telmelah, Telharsa, Cherub, Addan, [and] Immer: but they could not show their father's house, and their seed, whether they [were] of Israel:

could not show [16\\_NEH\\_07\\_61](#) # And these [were] they which went up [also] from Telmelah, Telharesha, Cherub, Addon, and Immer: but they could not show their father's house, nor their seed, whether they [were] of Israel.

could not so [02\\_EXO\\_08\\_18](#) # And the magicians did so with their enchantments to bring forth lice, but they could not: so there were lice upon man, and upon beast.

could not so [41\\_MAR\\_03\\_20](#) # And the multitude cometh together again, so that they could not so much as eat bread.

could not speak [46\\_1CO\\_03\\_01](#) # And I, brethren, could not speak unto you as unto spiritual, but as unto carnal, [even] as unto babes in Christ.

could not speak [01\\_GEN\\_37\\_04](#) # And when his brethren saw that their father loved him more than all his brethren, they hated him, and could not speak peaceably unto him.

could not speak [42\\_LUK\\_01\\_22](#) # And when he came out, he could not speak unto them: and they perceived that he had seen a vision in the temple: for he beckoned unto them, and remained speechless.

could not speak [16\\_NEH\\_13\\_24](#) # And their children spake half in the speech of Ashdod, and could not speak in the Jews' language, but according to the language of each people.

could not spread [23\\_ISA\\_33\\_23](#) # Thy tacklings are loosed; they could not well strengthen their mast, they could not spread the sail: then is the prey of a great spoil divided; the lame take the prey.

could not stand [11\\_1KI\\_08\\_11](#) # So that the priests could not stand to minister because of the cloud: for the glory of the LORD had filled the house of the LORD.

could not stand [14\\_2CH\\_05\\_14](#) # So that the priests could not stand to minister by reason of the cloud: for the glory of the LORD had filled the house of God.

could not stand [02\\_EXO\\_09\\_11](#) # And the magicians could not stand before Moses because of the boils; for the boil was upon the magicians, and upon all the Egyptians.

could not stand [06\\_JOS\\_07\\_12](#) # Therefore the children of Israel could not stand before their enemies, [but] turned [their] backs before their enemies, because they were accursed: neither will I be with you any more, except ye destroy the accursed from among you.

could not stay [24\\_JER\\_20\\_09](#) # Then I said, I will not make mention of him, nor speak any more in his name. But [his word] was in mine heart as a burning fire shut up in my bones, and I was weary with



forbearing, and I could not [stay].

could not stedfastly [47 2CO 03 07](#) # But if the ministration of death, written [and] engraven in stones, was glorious, so that the children of Israel could not stedfastly behold the face of Moses for the glory of his countenance; which [glory] was to be done away:

could not stedfastly [47 2CO 03 13](#) # And not as Moses, [which] put a veil over his face, that the children of Israel could not stedfastly look to the end of that which is abolished:

could not take [42 LUK 20 26](#) # And they could not take hold of his words before the people: and they marvelled at his answer, and held their peace.

could not tarry [02 EXO 12 39](#) # And they baked unleavened cakes of the dough which they brought forth out of Egypt, for it was not leavened; because they were thrust out of Egypt, and could not tarry, neither had they prepared for themselves any victual.

could not tell [42 LUK 20 07](#) # And they answered, that they could not tell whence [it was].

could not the [17 EST 06 01](#) # On that night could not the king sleep, and he commanded to bring the book of records of the chronicles; and they were read before the king.

Could not this [43 JOH 11 37](#) # And some of them said, Could not this man, which opened the eyes of the blind, have caused that even this man should not have died?

could not touch [25 LAM 04 14](#) # They have wandered [as] blind [men] in the streets, they have polluted themselves with blood, so that men could not touch their garments.

could not we [41 MAR 09 28](#) # And when he was come into the house, his disciples asked him privately, Why could not we cast him out?

could not we [40 MAT 17 19](#) # Then came the disciples to Jesus apart, and said, Why could not we cast him out?

could not well [23 ISA 33 23](#) # Thy tacklings are loosed; they could not well strengthen their mast, they could not spread the sail: then is the prey of a great spoil divided; the lame take the prey.

could not withstand [14 2CH 13 07](#) # And there are gathered unto him vain men, the children of Belial, and have strengthened themselves against Rehoboam the son of Solomon, when Rehoboam was young and tenderhearted, and could not withstand them.

could not [12 2KI 03 26](#) # And when the king of Moab saw that the battle was too sore for him, he took with him seven hundred men that drew swords, to break through [even] unto the king of Edom: but they could not.

could not [42 LUK 09 40](#) # And I besought thy disciples to cast him out; and they could not.

could not [41 MAR 06 19](#) # Therefore Herodias had a quarrel against him, and would have killed him; but she could not:

could not [41 MAR 09 18](#) # And wheresoever he taketh him, he teareth him: and he foameth, and gnasheth with his teeth, and pineth away: and I spake to thy disciples that they should cast him out; and they could not.

could number of [66 REV 07 09](#) # After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the

Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands;

could prevail nothing [40 MAT 27 24](#) # When Pilate saw that he could prevail nothing, but [that] rather a tumult was made, he took water, and washed [his] hands before the multitude, saying, I am innocent of the blood of this just person: see ye [to it].

could remove mountains [46 1CO 13 02](#) # And though I have [the gift of] prophecy, and understand all mysteries, and all knowledge; and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, and have not charity, I am nothing.

could say nothing [44 ACT 04 14](#) # And beholding the man which was healed standing with them, they could say nothing against it.

could she is [41 MAR 14 08](#) # She hath done what she could: she is come aforehand to anoint my body to the burying.

could skill of [14 2CH 34 12](#) # And the men did the work faithfully: and the overseers of them [were] Jahath and Obadiah, the Levites, of the sons of Merari; and Zechariah and Meshullam, of the sons of the Kohathites, to set [it] forward; and [other of] the Levites, all that could skill of instruments of music.

could sling stones [07 JUD 20 16](#) # Among all this people [there were] seven hundred chosen men lefthanded; every one could sling stones at an hair [breadth], and not miss.

could speak as [18 JOB 16 04](#) # I also could speak as ye [do]: if your soul were in my soul's stead, I could heap up words against you, and shake mine head at you.

could swear by [58 HEB 06 13](#) # For when God made promise to Abraham, because he could swear by no greater, he sware by himself,

could swim should [44 ACT 27 43](#) # But the centurion, willing to save Paul, kept them from [their] purpose; and commanded that they which could swim should cast [themselves] first [into the sea], and get to land:

could there do [41 MAR 06 05](#) # And he could there do no mighty work, save that he laid his hands upon a few sick folk, and healed [them].

could they blush [24 JER 06 15](#) # Were they ashamed when they had committed abomination? nay, they were not at all ashamed, neither could they blush: therefore they shall fall among them that fall: at the time [that] I visit them they shall be cast down, saith the LORD.

could they blush [24 JER 08 12](#) # Were they ashamed when they had committed abomination? nay, they were not at all ashamed, neither could they blush: therefore shall they fall among them that fall: in the time of their visitation they shall be cast down, saith the LORD.

could understand and [16 NEH 08 03](#) # And he read therein before the street that [was] before the water gate from the morning until midday, before the men and the women, and those that could understand; and the ears of all the people [were attentive] unto the book of the law.

could use both [13 1CH 12 02](#) # [They were] armed with bows, and could use both the right hand and the left in [hurling] stones and [shooting] arrows out of a bow, [even] of Saul's brethren of Benjamin.

could we certainly [01 GEN 43 07](#) # And they said, The man asked us straitly of our state, and of our kindred, saying, [Is] your father yet alive? have ye [another] brother? and we told him according to the tenor of these words: could we certainly know that he would say, Bring your brother down?

could wish that [45 ROM 09 03](#) # For I could wish that myself were accursed from Christ for my brethren, my kinsmen according to the flesh:

could wish [19 PSA 73 07](#) # Their eyes stand out with fatness: they have more than heart could wish.

could withstand God [44 ACT 11 17](#) # Forasmuch then as God gave them the like gift as [he did] unto us, who believed on the Lord Jesus Christ; what was I, that I could withstand God?

could withstand them [17 EST 09 02](#) # The Jews gathered themselves together in their cities throughout all the provinces of the king Ahasuerus, to lay hand on such as sought their hurt: and no man could withstand them; for the fear of them fell upon all people.

could ye not [40 MAT 26 40](#) # And he cometh unto the disciples, and findeth them asleep, and saith unto Peter, What, could ye not watch with me one hour?

couldst have no [43 JOH 19 11](#) # Jesus answered, Thou couldst have no power [at all] against me, except it were given thee from above: therefore he that delivered me unto thee hath the greater sin.

couldst not be [26 EZE 16 28](#) # Thou hast played the whore also with the Assyrians, because thou wast unsatiable; yea, thou hast played the harlot with them, and yet couldst not be satisfied.

couldst not thou [41 MAR 14 37](#) # And he cometh, and findeth them sleeping, and saith unto Peter, Simon, sleepest thou? couldst not thou watch one hour?

couldst reveal this [27 DAN 02 47](#) # The king answered unto Daniel, and said, Of a truth [it is], that your God [is] a God of gods, and a Lord of kings, and a revealer of secrets, seeing thou couldst reveal this secret.

couldst [24 JER 03 05](#) # Will he reserve [his anger] for ever? will he keep [it] to the end? Behold, thou hast spoken and done evil things as thou couldst.
