council a Pharisee [44 ACT 05 34](#) # Then stood there up one in the council, a Pharisee, named Gamaliel, a doctor of the law, had in reputation among all the people, and commanded to put the apostles forth a little space;

council against him [40 MAT 12 14](#) # Then the Pharisees went out, and held a council against him, how they might destroy him.

council and bound [41 MAR 15 01](#) # And straightway in the morning the chief priests held a consultation with the elders and scribes and the whole council, and bound Jesus, and carried [him] away, and delivered [him] to Pilate.

council and said [43 JOH 11 47](#) # Then gathered the chief priests and the Pharisees a council, and said, What do we? for this man doeth many miracles.

council and the [44 ACT 05 27](#) # And when they had brought them, they set [them] before the council: and the high priest asked them,

council answered Hast [44 ACT 25 12](#) # Then Festus, when he had conferred with the council, answered, Hast thou appealed unto Caesar? unto Caesar shalt thou go.

council as though [44 ACT 23 20](#) # And he said, The Jews have agreed to desire thee that thou wouldest bring down Paul to morrow into the council, as though they would inquire somewhat of him more perfectly.

council but whosoever [40 MAT 05 22](#) # But I say unto you, That whosoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment: and whosoever shall say to his brother, Raca, shall be in danger of the council: but whosoever shall say, Thou fool, shall be in danger of hell fire.

council looking stedfastly [44 ACT 06 15](#) # And all that sat in the council, looking stedfastly on him, saw his face as it had been the face of an angel.

council Men and [44 ACT 23 06](#) # But when Paul perceived that the one part were Sadducees, and the other Pharisees, he cried out in the council, Men [and] brethren, I am a Pharisee, the son of a Pharisee: of the hope and resurrection of the dead I am called in question.

council rejoicing that [44 ACT 05 41](#) # And they departed from the presence of the council, rejoicing that they were counted worthy to suffer shame for his name.

council said Men [44 ACT 23 01](#) # And Paul, earnestly beholding the council, said, Men [and] brethren, I have lived in all good conscience before God until this day.

council saying [42 LUK 22 66](#) # And as soon as it was day, the elders of the people and the chief priests and the scribes came together, and led him into their council, saying,

council signify to [44 ACT 23 15](#) # Now therefore ye with the council signify to the chief captain that he bring him down unto you to morrow, as though ye would inquire something more perfectly concerning him: and we, or ever he come near, are ready to kill him.

council sought false [40 MAT 26 59](#) # Now the chief priests, and elders, and all the council, sought false witness against Jesus, to put him to death;

council sought for [41 MAR 14 55](#) # And the chief priests and all the council sought for witness against Jesus to put him to death; and found none.

council the princes [19 PSA 68 27](#) # There [is] little Benjamin [with] their ruler, the princes of Judah [and] their council, the princes of Zebulun, [and] the princes of Naphtali.

council they conferred [44 ACT 04 15](#) # But when they had commanded them to go aside out of the council, they conferred among themselves,

council to appear [44 ACT 22 30](#) # On the morrow, because he would have known the certainty wherefore he was accused of the Jews, he loosed him from [his] bands, and commanded the chief priests and all their council to appear, and brought Paul down, and set him before them.

council together and [44 ACT 05 21](#) # And when they heard [that], they entered into the temple early in the morning, and taught. But the high priest came, and they that were with him, and called the council together, and all the senate of the children of Israel, and sent to the prison to have them brought.

council [44 ACT 06 12](#) # And they stirred up the people, and the elders, and the scribes, and came upon [him], and caught him, and brought [him] to the council,
