covetous boasters proud 55 2TI 03 02 # For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy,

covetous heard all 42 LUK 16 14 # And the Pharisees also, who were covetous, heard all these things: and they derided him.

covetous man who 49 EPH 05 05 # For this ye know, that no whoremonger, nor unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, hath any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God.

covetous nor drunkards 46 1CO 06 10 # Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God.

covetous or an 46 1CO 05 11 But now I have written unto you not to keep company, if any man that is called a brother be a fornicator, or covetous, or an idolater, or a railer, or a drunkard, or an extortioner; with such an one no not to eat.

covetous or extortioners 46 1CO 05 10 # Yet not altogether with the fornicators of this world, or with the covetous, or extortioners, or with idolaters; for then must ye needs go out of the world.

covetous practices cursed 61 2PE 02 14# Having eyes full of adultery, and that cannot cease from sin; beguiling unstable souls: an heart they have exercised with covetous practices; cursed children:

covetous whom the 19 PSA 10 03 # For the wicked boasteth of his heart's desire, and blesseth the covetous, [whom] the LORD abhorreth.

covetous 54 1TI 03 03 # Not given to wine, no striker, not greedy of filthy lucre; but patient, not a brawler, not covetous;

covetousness and be 58 HEB 13 05 # [Let your] conversation [be] without covetousness; [and be] content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.

covetousness and for 24 JER 22 17 # But thine eyes and thine heart [are] not but for thy covetousness, and for to shed innocent blood, and for oppression, and for violence, to do [it].

covetousness and from 24 JER 06 13 # For from the least of them even unto the greatest of them every one [is] given to covetousness; and from the prophet even unto the priest every one dealeth falsely.

covetousness and place <u>02 EXO 18 21</u> # Moreover thou shalt provide out of all the people able men, such as fear God, men of truth, hating covetousness; and place [such] over them, [to be] rulers of thousands, [and] rulers of hundreds, rulers of fifties, and rulers of tens:

covetousness for a 42 LUK 12 15 # And he said unto them, Take heed, and beware of covetousness: for a man's life consisteth not in the abundance of the things which he possesseth.

covetousness from the 24 JER 08 10 # Therefore will I give their wives unto others, [and] their fields to them that shall inherit [them]: for every one from the least even unto the greatest is given to covetousness, from the prophet even unto the priest every one dealeth falsely.

covetousness God is 52 1TH 02 05 # For neither at any time used we flattering words, as ye know, nor a cloak of covetousness; God [is] witness:

covetousness let it 49 EPH 05 03 # But fornication, and all uncleanness, or covetousness, let it not be once named among you, as becometh saints;

covetousness maliciousness full 45 ROM 01 29 # Being filled with all unrighteousness, fornication, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, debate, deceit, malignity; whisperers,

covetousness shall prolong 20 PRO 28 16# The prince that wanteth understanding [is] also a great oppressor: [but] he that hateth covetousness shall prolong [his] days.

covetousness shall they 61 2PE 02 03 # And through covetousness shall they with feigned words make merchandise of you; whose judgment now of a long time lingereth not, and their damnation slumbereth not.

covetousness to his 35 HAB 02 09 # Woe to him that coveteth an evil covetousness to his house, that he may set his nest on high, that he may be delivered from the power of evil!

covetousness which is 51 COL 03 05 # Mortify therefore your members which are upon the earth; fornication, uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil concupiscence, and covetousness, which is idolatry:

covetousness wickedness deceit 41 MAR 07 22 # Thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness:

covetousness 47 2CO 09 05 # Therefore I thought it necessary to exhort the brethren, that they would go before unto you, and make up before hand your bounty, whereof ye had notice before, that the same might be ready, as [a matter of] bounty, and not as [of] covetousness.

covetousness 26 EZE 33 31# And they come unto thee as the people cometh, and they sit before thee [as] my people, and they hear thy words, but they will not do them: for with their mouth they show much love, [but] their heart goeth after their covetousness.

covetousness 24 JER 51 13# O thou that dwellest upon many waters, abundant in treasures, thine end is come, [and] the measure of thy covetousness.
