crowned are as [34 NAH 03 17](#) # Thy crowned [are] as the locusts, and thy captains as the great grasshoppers, which camp in the hedges in the cold day, [but] when the sun ariseth they flee away, and their place is not known where they [are].

crowned except he [55 2TI 02 05](#) # And if a man also strive for masteries, [yet] is he not crowned, except he strive lawfully.

crowned him in [22 SON 03 11](#) # Go forth, O ye daughters of Zion, and behold king Solomon with the crown wherewith his mother crowned him in the day of his espousals, and in the day of the gladness of his heart.

crowned him with [19 PSA 08 05](#) # For thou hast made him a little lower than the angels, and hast crowned him with glory and honour.
