occupy thy merchandise <u>26\_EZE\_27\_09</u># The ancients of Gebal and the wise [men] thereof were in thee thy calkers: all the ships of the sea with their mariners were in thee to occupy thy merchandise.

Occupy till I <u>42\_LUK\_19\_13</u># And he called his ten servants, and delivered them ten pounds, and said unto them, Occupy till I come.

unoccupied and the <u>07\_JUD\_05\_06</u># In the days of Shamgar the son of Anath, in the days of Jael, the highways were unoccupied, and the travellers walked through byways.
