accustomed to do 24 JER 13 23 # Can the Ethiopian change his skin, or the leopard his spots? [then] may ye also do good, that are accustomed to do evil.

custom and he 42 LUK 05 27 # And after these things he went forth, and saw a publican, named Levi, sitting at the receipt of custom: and he said unto him, Follow me.

custom and he 40 MAT 09 09# And as Jesus passed forth from thence, he saw a man, named Matthew, sitting at the receipt of custom: and he saith unto him, Follow me. And he arose, and followed him.

custom and said 41 MAR 02 14 # And as he passed by, he saw Levi the [son] of Alphaeus sitting at the receipt of custom, and said unto him, Follow me. And he arose and followed him.

custom and so 15 EZR 04 13 # Be it known now unto the king, that, if this city be builded, and the walls set up [again, then] will they not pay toll, tribute, and custom, and [so] thou shalt endamage the revenue of the kings.

custom and that 24 JER 32 11 # So I took the evidence of the purchase, [both] that which was sealed [according] to the law and custom, and that which was open:

custom as the 15 EZR 03 04 # They kept also the feast of tabernacles, as [it is] written, and [offered] the daily burnt offerings by number, according to the custom, as the duty of every day required;

custom fear to 45 ROM 13 07 # Render therefore to all their dues: tribute to whom tribute [is due]; custom to whom custom; fear to whom fear; honour to whom honour.

custom in Israel <u>07 JUD 11 39</u># And it came to pass at the end of two months, that she returned unto her father, who did with her [according] to his vow which he had vowed: and she knew no man. And it was a custom in Israel,

custom neither the 46 1CO 11 16# But if any man seem to be contentious, we have no such custom, neither the churches of God.

custom of the 42 LUK 01 09 # According to the custom of the priest's office, his lot was to burn incense when he went into the temple of the Lord.

custom of the 42 LUK 02 27# And he came by the Spirit into the temple: and when the parents brought in the child Jesus, to do for him after the custom of the law,

custom of the 42 LUK 02 42 # And when he was twelve years old, they went up to Jerusalem after the custom of the feast,

custom of women 01 GEN 31 35 # And she said to her father, Let it not displease my lord that I cannot rise up before thee; for the custom of women [is] upon me. And he searched, but found not the images.

custom or tribute 40 MAT 17 25 # He saith, Yes. And when he was come into the house, Jesus prevented him, saying, What thinkest thou, Simon? of whom do the kings of the earth take custom or tribute? of their own children, or of strangers?

custom that I 43 JOH 18 39 # But ye have a custom, that I should release unto you one at the passover: will ye therefore that I release unto you the King of the Jews?

custom to whom 45 ROM 13 07 # Render therefore to all their dues: tribute to whom tribute [is due]; custom to whom custom; fear to whom fear; honour to whom honour.

custom upon them 15 EZR 07 24 # Also we certify you, that touching any of the priests and Levites, singers, porters, Nethinims, or ministers of this house of God, it shall not be lawful to impose toll, tribute, or custom, upon them.

custom was he 42 LUK 04 16# And he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up: and, as his custom was, he went into the synagogue on the sabbath day, and stood up for to read.

custom was paid 15 EZR 04 20 # There have been mighty kings also over Jerusalem, which have ruled over all [countries] beyond the river; and toll, tribute, and custom, was paid unto them.

custom with the 09 1SA 02 13# And the priests' custom with the people [was, that], when any man offered sacrifice, the priest's servant came, while the flesh was in seething, with a fleshhook of three teeth in his hand;

customs and questions 44 ACT 26 03 # Especially [because I know] thee to be expert in all customs and questions which are among the Jews: wherefore I beseech thee to hear me patiently.

customs of our 44 ACT 28 17 # And it came to pass, that after three days Paul called the chief of the Jews together: and when they were come together, he said unto them, Men [and] brethren, though I have committed nothing against the people, or customs of our fathers, yet was I delivered prisoner from Jerusalem into the hands of the Romans.

customs of the 24 JER 10 03 # For the customs of the people [are] vain: for [one] cutteth a tree out of the forest, the work of the hands of the workman, with the ax.

 $\textbf{customs which Moses} \ \underline{\textbf{44}} \ \underline{\textbf{ACT}} \ \underline{\textbf{06}} \ \underline{\textbf{14}} \# \textbf{For we have heard him say, that this Jesus of Nazareth shall destroy this place, and shall change the customs which Moses delivered us. } \\$

customs which were 03 LEV 18 30 # Therefore shall ye keep mine ordinance, that [ye] commit not [any one] of these abominable customs, which were committed before you, and that ye defile not yourselves therein: I [am] the LORD your God.

customs 44 ACT 21 21 # And they are informed of thee, that thou teachest all the Jews which are among the Gentiles to forsake Moses, saying that they ought not to circumcise [their] children, neither to walk after the customs.

unaccustomed to the 24 JER 31 18 # I have surely heard Ephraim bemoaning himself [thus]; Thou hast chastised me, and I was chastised, as a bullock unaccustomed [to the yoke]: turn thou me, and I shall be turned; for thou [art] the LORD my God.
