deceitfully and cursed [24 JER 48 10](#) # Cursed [be] he that doeth the work of the LORD deceitfully, and cursed [be] he that keepeth back his sword from blood.

deceitfully and said [01 GEN 34 13](#) # And the sons of Jacob answered Shechem and Hamor his father deceitfully, and said, because he had defiled Dinah their sister:

deceitfully any more [02 EXO 08 29](#) # And Moses said, Behold, I go out from thee, and I will entreat the LORD that the swarms [of flies] may depart from Pharaoh, from his servants, and from his people, to morrow: but let not Pharaoh deal deceitfully any more in not letting the people go to sacrifice to the LORD.

deceitfully for he [27 DAN 11 23](#) # And after the league [made] with him he shall work deceitfully: for he shall come up, and shall become strong with a small people.

deceitfully for him [18 JOB 13 07](#) # Will ye speak wickedly for God? and talk deceitfully for him?

deceitfully gotten or [03 LEV 06 04](#) # Then it shall be, because he hath sinned, and is guilty, that he shall restore that which he took violently away, or the thing which he hath deceitfully gotten, or that which was delivered him to keep, or the lost thing which he found,

deceitfully with her [02 EXO 21 08](#) # If she please not her master, who hath betrothed her to himself, then shall he let her be redeemed: to sell her unto a strange nation he shall have no power, seeing he hath dealt deceitfully with her.

deceitfully [19 PSA 24 04](#) # He that hath clean hands, and a pure heart; who hath not lifted up his soul unto vanity, nor sworn deceitfully.
