derision and a 24\_JER\_48\_39 # They shall howl, [saying], How is it broken down! how hath Moab turned the back with shame! so shall Moab be a derision and a dismaying to all them about him.

derision daily every <u>24\_JER\_20\_07</u> # O LORD, thou hast deceived me, and I was deceived: thou art stronger than I, and hast prevailed: I am in derision daily, every one mocketh me.

derision daily <u>24\_JER\_20\_08</u># For since I spake, I cried out, I cried violence and spoil; because the word of the LORD was made a reproach unto me, and a derision, daily.

derision in the <u>28\_HOS\_07\_16</u># They return, [but] not to the most High: they are like a deceitful bow: their princes shall fall by the sword for the rage of their tongue: this [shall be] their derision in the land of Egypt.

derision it containeth <u>26\_EZE\_23\_32</u> # Thus saith the Lord GOD; Thou shalt drink of thy sister's cup deep and large: thou shalt be laughed to scorn and had in derision; it containeth much.

derision to all 25\_LAM\_03\_14 # I was a derision to all my people; [and] their song all the day.

derision to the <u>26\_EZE\_36\_04</u># Therefore, ye mountains of Israel, hear the word of the Lord GOD; Thus saith the Lord GOD to the mountains, and to the hills, to the rivers, and to the valleys, to the desolate wastes, and to the cities that are forsaken, which became a prey and derision to the residue of the heathen that [are] round about;

derision to them <u>19 PSA\_44\_13</u># Thou makest us a reproach to our neighbours, a scorn and a derision to them that are round about us.

derision to them <u>19\_PSA\_79\_04</u># We are become a reproach to our neighbours, a scorn and derision to them that are round about us.

derision unto thee 24\_JER\_48\_27 # For was not Israel a derision unto thee? was he found among thieves? for since thou spakest of him, thou skippedst for joy.

derision whose fathers <u>18\_JOB\_30\_01</u> # But now [they that are] younger than I have me in derision, whose fathers I would have disdained to have set with the dogs of my flock.

derision yet have <u>19\_PSA\_119\_51</u># The proud have had me greatly in derision: [yet] have I not declined from thy law.

derision 24\_JER\_48\_26 # Make ye him drunken: for he magnified [himself] against the LORD: Moab also shall wallow in his vomit, and he also shall be in derision.

derision 19\_PSA\_02\_04 # He that sitteth in the heavens shall laugh: the Lord shall have them in derision.

derision 19\_PSA\_59\_08 # But thou, O LORD, shalt laugh at them; thou shalt have all the heathen in derision.
