didst afflict the <u>19\_PSA\_44\_02</u> # [How] thou didst drive out the heathen with thy hand, and plantedst them; [how] thou didst afflict the people, and cast them out.

didst among them <u>16\_NEH\_09\_17</u># And refused to obey, neither were mindful of thy wonders that thou didst among them; but hardened their necks, and in their rebellion appointed a captain to return to their bondage: but thou [art] a God ready to pardon, gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and forsookest them not.

didst anoint their <u>02\_EXO\_40\_15</u> # And thou shalt anoint them, as thou didst anoint their father, that they may minister unto me in the priest's office: for their anointing shall surely be an everlasting priesthood throughout their generations.

didst blaspheme God <u>11\_1KI\_21\_10</u># And set two men, sons of Belial, before him, to bear witness against him, saying, Thou didst blaspheme God and the king. And [then] carry him out, and stone him, that he may die.

didst blow with  $02_{EXO_{15}10}$  # Thou didst blow with thy wind, the sea covered them: they sank as lead in the mighty waters.

didst break and <u>26\_EZE\_29\_07</u> # When they took hold of thee by thy hand, thou didst break, and rend all their shoulder: and when they leaned upon thee, thou brakest, and madest all their loins to be at a stand.

didst call me <u>09\_18A\_03\_06</u># And the LORD called yet again, Samuel. And Samuel arose and went to Eli, and said, Here [am] I; for thou didst call me. And he answered, I called not, my son; lie down again.

didst call me <u>09\_1SA\_03\_08</u># And the LORD called Samuel again the third time. And he arose and went to Eli, and said, Here [am] I; for thou didst call me. And Eli perceived that the LORD had called the child.

didst cause it <u>19\_PSA\_80\_09</u># Thou preparedst [room] before it, and didst cause it to take deep root, and it filled the land.

didst cause judgment <u>19\_PSA\_76\_08</u># Thou didst cause judgment to be heard from heaven; the earth feared, and was still,

didst choose Abram <u>16\_NEH\_09\_07</u># Thou [art] the LORD the God, who didst choose Abram, and broughtest him forth out of Ur of the Chaldees, and gavest him the name of Abraham;

didst cleave the <u>35\_HAB\_03\_09</u> # Thy bow was made quite naked, [according] to the oaths of the tribes, [even thy] word. Selah. Thou didst cleave the earth with rivers.

didst cleave the <u>19\_PSA\_74\_15</u> # Thou didst cleave the fountain and the flood: thou driedst up mighty rivers.

didst command that <u>25\_LAM\_01\_10</u> # The adversary hath spread out his hand upon all her pleasant things: for she hath seen [that] the heathen entered into her sanctuary, whom thou didst command [that] they should not enter into thy congregation.

didst commit whoredom <u>26\_EZE\_16\_17</u> # Thou hast also taken thy fair jewels of my gold and of my silver,

didst confirm thine <u>19\_PSA\_68\_09</u># Thou, O God, didst send a plentiful rain, whereby thou didst confirm thine inheritance, when it was weary.

didst eat with <u>44\_ACT\_11\_03</u># Saying, Thou wentest in to men uncircumcised, and didst eat with them.

didst enrich the <u>26\_EZE\_27\_33</u> # When thy wares went forth out of the seas, thou filledst many people; thou didst enrich the kings of the earth with the multitude of thy riches and of thy merchandise.

didst evil in <u>09\_18A\_15\_19</u># Wherefore then didst thou not obey the voice of the LORD, but didst fly upon the spoil, and didst evil in the sight of the LORD?

didst fast and <u>10\_2SA\_12\_21</u># Then said his servants unto him, What thing [is] this that thou hast done? thou didst fast and weep for the child, [while it was] alive; but when the child was dead, thou didst rise and

eat bread.

didst give unto <u>26\_EZE\_16\_36</u># Thus saith the Lord GOD; Because thy filthiness was poured out, and thy nakedness discovered through thy whoredoms with thy lovers, and with all the idols of thy abominations, and by the blood of thy children, which thou didst give unto them;

didst hide thy <u>19\_PSA\_30\_07</u> # LORD, by thy favour thou hast made my mountain to stand strong: thou didst hide thy face, [and] I was troubled.

didst in their <u>19\_PSA\_44\_01</u> # To the chief Musician for the sons of Korah, Maschil. We have heard with our ears, O God, our fathers have told us, [what] work thou didst in their days, in the times of old.

didst increase thy <u>23\_ISA\_57\_09</u> # And thou wentest to the king with ointment, and didst increase thy perfumes, and didst send thy messengers far off, and didst debase [thyself even] unto hell.

didst it secretly <u>10\_2SA\_12\_12</u># For thou didst [it] secretly: but I will do this thing before all Israel, and before the sun.

didst it <u>19\_PSA\_39\_09</u># I was dumb, I opened not my mouth; because thou didst [it].

didst laugh <u>01\_GEN\_18\_15</u># Then Sarah denied, saying, I laughed not; for she was afraid. And he said, Nay; but thou didst laugh.

didst let us <u>06\_JOS\_02\_18</u> # Behold, [when] we come into the land, thou shalt bind this line of scarlet thread in the window which thou didst let us down by: and thou shalt bring thy father, and thy mother, and thy brethren, and all thy father's household, home unto thee.

didst look in <u>23\_ISA\_22\_08</u> # And he discovered the covering of Judah, and thou didst look in that day to the armour of the house of the forest.

didst make me <u>19\_PSA\_22\_09</u> # But thou [art] he that took me out of the womb: thou didst make me hope [when I was] upon my mother's breasts.

didst march through <u>35\_HAB\_03\_12</u># Thou didst march through the land in indignation, thou didst thresh the heathen in anger.

didst march through <u>19\_PSA\_68\_07</u> # O God, when thou wentest forth before thy people, when thou didst march through the wilderness; Selah:

didst not anoint <u>42\_LUK\_07\_46</u># My head with oil thou didst not anoint: but this woman hath anointed my feet with ointment.

didst not bear 23\_ISA\_54\_01 # Sing, O barren, thou [that] didst not bear; break forth into singing, and cry

aloud, thou [that] didst not travail with child: for more [are] the children of the desolate than the children of the married wife, saith the LORD.

didst not call <u>07\_JUD\_12\_01</u> # And the men of Ephraim gathered themselves together, and went northward, and said unto Jephthah, Wherefore passedst thou over to fight against the children of Ammon, and didst not call us to go with thee? we will burn thine house upon thee with fire.

didst not desire <u>19\_PSA\_40\_06</u> # Sacrifice and offering thou didst not desire; mine ears hast thou opened: burnt offering and sin offering hast thou not required.

didst not go <u>19\_PSA\_60\_10</u> # [Wilt] not thou, O God, [which] hadst cast us off? and [thou], O God, [which] didst not go out with our armies?

didst not know 23\_ISA\_48\_06 # Thou hast heard, see all this; and will not ye declare [it]? I have showed thee new things from this time, even hidden things, and thou didst not know them.

didst not lay <u>23\_ISA\_47\_07</u> # And thou saidst, I shall be a lady for ever: [so] that thou didst not lay these [things] to thy heart, neither didst remember the latter end of it.

didst not receive <u>46\_1CO\_04\_07</u> # For who maketh thee to differ [from another]? and what hast thou that thou didst not receive? now if thou didst receive [it], why dost thou glory, as if thou hadst not received [it]?

didst not sow <u>42\_LUK\_19\_21</u> # For I feared thee, because thou art an austere man: thou takest up that thou layedst not down, and reapest that thou didst not sow.

didst not tell <u>01\_GEN\_31\_27</u># Wherefore didst thou flee away secretly, and steal away from me; and didst not tell me, that I might have sent thee away with mirth, and with songs, with tabret, and with harp?

Didst not thou <u>11\_1KI\_01\_13</u># Go and get thee in unto king David, and say unto him, Didst not thou, my lord, O king, swear unto thine handmaid, saying, Assuredly Solomon thy son shall reign after me, and he shall sit upon my throne? why then doth Adonijah reign?

didst not thou <u>40\_MAT\_13\_27</u># So the servants of the householder came and said unto him, Sir, didst not thou sow good seed in thy field? from whence then hath it tares?

didst not thou <u>40\_MAT\_20\_13</u># But he answered one of them, and said, Friend, I do thee no wrong: didst not thou agree with me for a penny?

didst not travail <u>23\_ISA\_54\_01</u># Sing, O barren, thou [that] didst not bear; break forth into singing, and cry aloud, thou [that] didst not travail with child: for more [are] the children of the desolate than the children of the married wife, saith the LORD.

didst not utterly <u>16\_NEH\_09\_31</u># Nevertheless for thy great mercies' sake thou didst not utterly consume them, nor forsake them; for thou [art] a gracious and merciful God.

didst prosper into <u>26\_EZE\_16\_13</u> # Thus wast thou decked with gold and silver; and thy raiment [was of] fine linen, and silk, and broidered work; thou didst eat fine flour, and honey, and oil: and thou wast exceeding beautiful, and thou didst prosper into a kingdom.

didst rend thy <u>14\_2CH\_34\_27</u># Because thine heart was tender, and thou didst humble thyself before God, when thou heardest his words against this place, and against the inhabitants thereof, and humbledst thyself before me, and didst rend thy clothes, and weep before me; I have even heard [thee] also, saith the LORD.

didst ride upon <u>35\_HAB\_03\_08</u> # Was the LORD displeased against the rivers? [was] thine anger against the rivers? [was] thy wrath against the sea, that thou didst ride upon thine horses [and] thy chariots of salvation?

didst rise and <u>10\_2SA\_12\_21</u># Then said his servants unto him, What thing [is] this that thou hast done? thou didst fast and weep for the child, [while it was] alive; but when the child was dead, thou didst rise and eat bread.

didst say Woe 24\_JER\_45\_03 # Thou didst say, Woe is me now! for the LORD hath added grief to my sorrow; I fainted in my sighing, and I find no rest.

didst see the <u>16\_NEH\_09\_09</u># And didst see the affliction of our fathers in Egypt, and heardest their cry by the Red sea;

didst send a <u>19\_PSA\_68\_09</u> # Thou, O God, didst send a plentiful rain, whereby thou didst confirm thine inheritance, when it was weary.

didst send come <u>07\_JUD\_13\_08</u># Then Manoah entreated the LORD, and said, O my Lord, let the man of God which thou didst send come again unto us, and teach us what we shall do unto the child that shall be born.

didst send for <u>11\_1KI\_20\_09</u># Wherefore he said unto the messengers of Benhadad, Tell my lord the king, All that thou didst send for to thy servant at the first I will do: but this thing I may not do. And the messengers departed, and brought him word again.

didst send thy <u>23\_ISA\_57\_09</u> # And thou wentest to the king with ointment, and didst increase thy perfumes, and didst send thy messengers far off, and didst debase [thyself even] unto hell.

didst send 09\_1SA\_25\_25 # Let not my lord, I pray thee, regard this man of Belial, [even] Nabal: for as his

name [is], so [is] he; Nabal [is] his name, and folly [is] with him: but I thine handmaid saw not the young men of my lord, whom thou didst send.

didst separate them <u>11\_1KI\_08\_53</u># For thou didst separate them from among all the people of the earth, [to be] thine inheritance, as thou spakest by the hand of Moses thy servant, when thou broughtest our fathers out of Egypt, O Lord GOD.

didst set him <u>58\_HEB\_02\_07</u># Thou madest him a little lower than the angels; thou crownedst him with glory and honour, and didst set him over the works of thy hands:

didst set them <u>19\_PSA\_73\_18</u># Surely thou didst set them in slippery places: thou castedst them down into destruction.

didst set thine <u>27\_DAN\_10\_12</u> # Then said he unto me, Fear not, Daniel: for from the first day that thou didst set thine heart to understand, and to chasten thyself before thy God, thy words were heard, and I am come for thy words.

didst show them <u>23\_ISA\_47\_06</u># I was wroth with my people, I have polluted mine inheritance, and given them into thine hand: thou didst show them no mercy; upon the ancient hast thou very heavily laid thy yoke.

didst strike through <u>35\_HAB\_03\_14</u># Thou didst strike through with his staves the head of his villages: they came out as a whirlwind to scatter me: their rejoicing [was] as to devour the poor secretly.

didst strive at <u>05\_DEU\_33\_08</u># And of Levi he said, [Let] thy Thummim and thy Urim [be] with thy holy one, whom thou didst prove at Massah, [and with] whom thou didst strive at the waters of Meribah;

didst swear to <u>24\_JER\_32\_22</u> # And hast given them this land, which thou didst swear to their fathers to give them, a land flowing with milk and honey;

didst take and <u>26\_EZE\_16\_16</u># And of thy garments thou didst take, and deckedst thy high places with divers colours, and playedst the harlot thereupon: [the like things] shall not come, neither shall it be [so].

didst terrible things <u>23\_ISA\_64\_03</u> # When thou didst terrible things [which] we looked not for, thou camest down, the mountains flowed down at thy presence.

didst testify against <u>16\_NEH\_09\_34</u> # Neither have our kings, our princes, our priests, nor our fathers, kept thy law, nor hearkened unto thy commandments and thy testimonies, wherewith thou didst testify against them.

didst this in <u>01\_GEN\_20\_06</u># And God said unto him in a dream, Yea, I know that thou didst this in the integrity of thy heart; for I also withheld thee from sinning against me: therefore suffered I thee not to touch her.

didst thou deliver <u>16\_NEH\_09\_28</u># But after they had rest, they did evil again before thee: therefore leftest thou them in the hand of their enemies, so that they had the dominion over them: yet when they returned, and cried unto thee, thou heardest [them] from heaven; and many times didst thou deliver them according to thy mercies;

didst thou doubt <u>40\_MAT\_14\_31</u># And immediately Jesus stretched forth [his] hand, and caught him, and said unto him, O thou of little faith, wherefore didst thou doubt?

didst thou flee <u>01\_GEN\_31\_27</u> # Wherefore didst thou flee away secretly, and steal away from me; and didst not tell me, that I might have sent thee away with mirth, and with songs, with tabret, and with harp?

didst thou forbear <u>16 NEH\_09\_30</u> # Yet many years didst thou forbear them, and testifiedst against them by thy spirit in thy prophets: yet would they not give ear: therefore gavest thou them into the hand of the people of the lands.

didst thou get <u>16\_NEH\_09\_10</u># And showedst signs and wonders upon Pharaoh, and on all his servants, and on all the people of his land: for thou knewest that they dealt proudly against them. So didst thou get thee a name, as [it is] this day.

didst thou lead 23\_ISA\_63\_14 # As a beast goeth down into the valley, the Spirit of the LORD caused him to rest: so didst thou lead thy people, to make thyself a glorious name.

didst thou make <u>13\_1CH\_17\_22</u># For thy people Israel didst thou make thine own people for ever; and thou, LORD, becamest their God.

didst thou marvel <u>66\_REV\_17\_07</u># And the angel said unto me, Wherefore didst thou marvel? I will tell thee the mystery of the woman, and of the beast that carrieth her, which hath the seven heads and ten horns.

didst thou not <u>09\_18A\_15\_19</u># Wherefore then didst thou not obey the voice of the LORD, but didst fly upon the spoil, and didst evil in the sight of the LORD?

didst thou not <u>10\_2SA\_11\_10</u># And when they had told David, saying, Uriah went not down unto his house, David said unto Uriah, Camest thou not from [thy] journey? why [then] didst thou not go down unto thine house?

didst thou not <u>10\_2SA\_18\_11</u># And Joab said unto the man that told him, And, behold, thou sawest [him], and why didst thou not smite him there to the ground? And I would have given thee ten [shekels] of silver, and a girdle.

didst thou not <u>01\_GEN\_12\_18</u> # And Pharaoh called Abram, and said, What [is] this [that] thou hast done unto me? why didst thou not tell me that she [was] thy wife?

didst thou require <u>01\_GEN\_31\_39</u># That which was torn [of beasts] I brought not unto thee; I bare the loss of it; of my hand didst thou require it, [whether] stolen by day, or stolen by night.

didst thou set <u>10\_2SA\_19\_28</u> # For all [of] my father's house were but dead men before my lord the king: yet didst thou set thy servant among them that did eat at thine own table. What right therefore have I yet to cry any more unto the king?

didst thou sustain <u>16\_NEH\_09\_21</u> # Yea, forty years didst thou sustain them in the wilderness, [so that] they lacked nothing; their clothes waxed not old, and their feet swelled not.

didst thou tell <u>01\_GEN\_21\_26</u># And Abimelech said, I wot not who hath done this thing: neither didst thou tell me, neither yet heard I [of it], but to day.

didst thou write <u>24\_JER\_36\_17</u> # And they asked Baruch, saying, Tell us now, How didst thou write all these words at his mouth?

didst thresh the <u>35\_HAB\_03\_12</u># Thou didst march through the land in indignation, thou didst thresh the heathen in anger.

didst to David <u>11\_1KI\_02\_44</u># The king said moreover to Shimei, Thou knowest all the wickedness which thine heart is privy to, that thou didst to David my father: therefore the LORD shall return thy wickedness upon thine own head;

didst trust in <u>26\_EZE\_16\_15</u># But thou didst trust in thine own beauty, and playedst the harlot because of thy renown, and pouredst out thy fornications on every one that passed by; his it was.

didst trust in <u>28\_HOS\_10\_13</u> # Ye have plowed wickedness, ye have reaped iniquity; ye have eaten the fruit of lies: because thou didst trust in thy way, in the multitude of thy mighty men.

didst unto Jericho <u>06\_JOS\_08\_02</u> # And thou shalt do to Ai and her king as thou didst unto Jericho and her king: only the spoil thereof, and the cattle thereof, shall ye take for a prey unto yourselves: lay thee an ambush for the city behind it.

didst unto me <u>10\_2SA\_13\_16</u># And she said unto him, [There is] no cause: this evil in sending me away [is] greater than the other that thou didst unto me. But he would not hearken unto her.

didst unto Sihon <u>05\_DEU\_03\_02</u> # And the LORD said unto me, Fear him not: for I will deliver him, and all his people, and his land, into thy hand; and thou shalt do unto him as thou didst unto Sihon king of the Amorites, which dwelt at Heshbon.

didst unto Sihon <u>04\_NUM\_21\_34</u># And the LORD said unto Moses, Fear him not: for I have delivered him into thy hand, and all his people, and his land; and thou shalt do to him as thou didst unto Sihon king of the Amorites, which dwelt at Heshbon.

didst walk through <u>35\_HAB\_03\_15</u># Thou didst walk through the sea with thine horses, [through] the heap of great waters.

didst wash thyself <u>26\_EZE\_23\_40</u> # And furthermore, that ye have sent for men to come from far, unto whom a messenger [was] sent; and, lo, they came: for whom thou didst wash thyself, paintedst thy eyes, and deckedst thyself with ornaments,

didst weaken the <u>23\_ISA\_14\_12</u> # How art thou fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! [how] art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations!

didst well in <u>14\_2CH\_06\_08</u># But the LORD said to David my father, Forasmuch as it was in thine heart to build an house for my name, thou didst well in that it was in thine heart:
