dost afflict them [14 2CH 06 26](#) # When the heaven is shut up, and there is no rain, because they have sinned against thee; [yet] if they pray toward this place, and confess thy name, and turn from their sin, when thou dost afflict them;

dost ask after [01 GEN 32 29](#) # And Jacob asked [him], and said, Tell [me], I pray thee, thy name. And he said, Wherefore [is] it [that] thou dost ask after my name? And he blessed him there.

dost but hate [07 JUD 14 16](#) # And Samson's wife wept before him, and said, Thou dost but hate me, and lovest me not: thou hast put forth a riddle unto the children of my people, and hast not told [it] me. dost dwell among [26 EZE 02 06](#) # And thou, son of man, be not afraid of them, neither be afraid of their words, though briars and thorns [be] with thee, and thou dost dwell among scorpions: be not afraid of their words, nor be dismayed at their looks, though they [be] a rebellious house.

dost embrace her [20 PRO 04 08](#) # Exalt her, and she shall promote thee: she shall bring thee to honour, when thou dost embrace her.

dost establish equity [19 PSA 99 04](#) # The king's strength also loveth judgment; thou dost establish equity, thou executest judgment and righteousness in Jacob.

dost lend shall [05 DEU 24 11](#) # Thou shalt stand abroad, and the man to whom thou dost lend shall bring out the pledge abroad unto thee.

dost lend thy [05 DEU 24 10](#) # When thou dost lend thy brother any thing, thou shalt not go into his house to fetch his pledge.

dost not hear [18 JOB 30 20](#) # I cry unto thee, and thou dost not hear me: I stand up, and thou regardest me [not].

dost not increase [19 PSA 44 12](#) # Thou sellest thy people for nought, and dost not increase [thy wealth] by their price.

dost not inquire [21 ECC 07 10](#) # Say not thou, What is [the cause] that the former days were better than these? for thou dost not inquire wisely concerning this.

dost not speak [26 EZE 33 08](#) # When I say unto the wicked, O wicked [man], thou shalt surely die; if thou dost not speak to warn the wicked from his way, that wicked [man] shall die in his iniquity; but his blood will I require at thine hand.

Dost not thou [42_LUK_23_40](#) # But the other answering rebuked him, saying, Dost not thou fear God, seeing thou art in the same condemnation?
