dost afflict them <u>14\_2CH\_06\_26</u> # When the heaven is shut up, and there is no rain, because they have sinned against thee; [yet] if they pray toward this place, and confess thy name, and turn from their sin, when thou dost afflict them;

dost ask after <u>01\_GEN\_32\_29</u># And Jacob asked [him], and said, Tell [me], I pray thee, thy name. And he said, Wherefore [is] it [that] thou dost ask after my name? And he blessed him there.

dost but hate <u>07\_JUD\_14\_16</u># And Samson's wife wept before him, and said, Thou dost but hate me, and lovest me not: thou hast put forth a riddle unto the children of my people, and hast not told [it] me. And he said unto her, Behold, I have not told [it] my father nor my mother, and shall I tell [it] thee?

dost destroy me <u>18\_JOB\_10\_08</u># Thine hands have made me and fashioned me together round about; yet thou dost destroy me.

dost dwell among <u>26\_EZE\_02\_06</u># And thou, son of man, be not afraid of them, neither be afraid of their words, though briers and thorns [be] with thee, and thou dost dwell among scorpions: be not afraid of their words, nor be dismayed at their looks, though they [be] a rebellious house.

dost embrace her <u>20\_PRO\_04\_08</u> # Exalt her, and she shall promote thee: she shall bring thee to honour, when thou dost embrace her.

dost establish equity <u>19\_PSA\_99\_04</u># The king's strength also loveth judgment; thou dost establish equity, thou executest judgment and righteousness in Jacob.

dost not speak <u>26\_EZE\_33\_08</u># When I say unto the wicked, O wicked [man], thou shalt surely die; if thou dost not speak to warn the wicked from his way, that wicked [man] shall die in his iniquity; but his blood will I require at thine hand.
