Edomite came and 19 PSA 52 01 # To the chief Musician, Maschil, [A Psalm] of David, when Doeg the Edomite came and told Saul, and said unto him, David is come to the house of Ahimelech. Why boastest thou thyself in mischief, O mighty man? the goodness of God [endureth] continually.

Edomite for he 05 DEU 23 07 # Thou shalt not abhor an Edomite; for he [is] thy brother: thou shalt not abhor an Egyptian; because thou wast a stranger in his land.

Edomite he was 11 1KI 11 14# And the LORD stirred up an adversary unto Solomon, Hadad the Edomite: he [was] of the king's seed in Edom.

Edomite the chiefest 09 1SA 21 07 # Now a certain man of the servants of Saul [was] there that day, detained before the LORD; and his name [was] Doeg, an Edomite, the chiefest of the herdmen that [belonged] to Saul.

Edomite turned and 09 18A 22 18 # And the king said to Doeg, Turn thou, and fall upon the priests. And Doeg the Edomite turned, and he fell upon the priests, and slew on that day fourscore and five persons that did wear a linen ephod.

Edomite was there 09 1SA 22 22 # And David said unto Abiathar, I knew [it] that day, when Doeg the Edomite [was] there, that he would surely tell Saul: I have occasioned [the death] of all the persons of thy father's house

Edomite which was 99 1SA 22 09 # Then answered Doeg the Edomite, which was set over the servants of Saul, and said, I saw the son of Jesse coming to Nob, to Ahimelech the son of Ahitub.

Edomites and thine 14 2CH 25 19 # Thou sayest, Lo, thou hast smitten the Edomites; and thine heart lifteth thee up to boast: abide now at home; why shouldest thou meddle to [thine] hurt, that thou shouldest fall, [even] thou, and Judah with thee?

Edomites became David's 13 1CH 18 13 # And he put garrisons in Edom; and all the Edomites became David's servants. Thus the LORD preserved David whithersoever he went.

Edomites had come 14 2CH 28 17 # For again the Edomites had come and smitten Judah, and carried away captives.

Edomites in mount $\underline{01}$ GEN 36 $\underline{09}$ # And these [are] the generations of Esau the father of the Edomites in mount Seir:

Edomites in the 13 1CH 18 12 # Moreover Abishai the son of Zeruiah slew of the Edomites in the valley of salt eighteen thousand.

Edomites of his 11 1KI 11 17# That Hadad fled, he and certain Edomites of his father's servants with him, to go into Egypt; Hadad [being] yet a little child.

Edomites revolted from 14 2CH 21 08 # In his days the Edomites revolted from under the dominion of Judah, and made themselves a king.

Edomites revolted from 14 2CH 21 10 # So the Edomites revolted from under the hand of Judah unto this day. The same time [also] did Libnah revolt from under his hand; because he had forsaken the LORD God of his fathers.

Edomites that he 14 2CH 25 14 # Now it came to pass, after that Amaziah was come from the slaughter of the Edomites, that he brought the gods of the children of Seir, and set them up [to be] his gods, and bowed down himself before them, and burned incense unto them.

Edomites which compassed 14 2CH 21 09 # Then Jehoram went forth with his princes, and all his chariots with him: and he rose up by night, and smote the Edomites which compassed him in, and the captains of the chariots.

Edomites which compassed 12 2KI 08 21 # So Joram went over to Zair, and all the chariots with him: and he rose by night, and smote the Edomites which compassed him about, and the captains of the chariots: and the people fled into their tents.

Edomites Zidonians and 11 1KI 11 01# But king Solomon loved many strange women, together with the daughter of Pharaoh, women of the Moabites, Ammonites, Edomites, Zidonians, [and] Hittites;

Edomites <u>01 GEN 36 43</u> # Duke Magdiel, duke Iram: these [be] the dukes of Edom, according to their habitations in the land of their possession: he [is] Esau the father of the Edomites.
