Egypt a chariot 14\_2CH\_01\_17 # And they fetched up, and brought forth out of Egypt a chariot for six hundred [shekels] of silver, and an horse for an hundred and fifty: and so brought they out [horses] for all the kings of the Hittites, and for the kings of Syria, by their means.

Egypt a long <u>04\_NUM\_20\_15</u># How our fathers went down into Egypt, and we have dwelt in Egypt a long time; and the Egyptians vexed us, and our fathers:

Egypt according to <u>02\_EXO\_06\_26</u> # These [are] that Aaron and Moses, to whom the LORD said, Bring out the children of Israel from the land of Egypt according to their armies.

Egypt and had <u>16\_NEH\_09\_18</u> # Yea, when they had made them a molten calf, and said, This [is] thy God that brought thee up out of Egypt, and had wrought great provocations;

Egypt and how <u>05\_DEU\_29\_16</u># [For ye know how we have dwelt in the land of Egypt; and how we came through the nations which ye passed by;

Egypt and I <u>44\_ACT\_07\_34</u># I have seen, I have seen the affliction of my people which is in Egypt, and I have heard their groaning, and am come down to deliver them. And now come, I will send thee into Egypt.

Egypt and the <u>24\_JER\_42\_16</u># Then it shall come to pass, [that] the sword, which ye feared, shall overtake you there in the land of Egypt, and the famine, whereof ye were afraid, shall follow close after you there in Egypt; and there ye shall die.

Egypt and the <u>24\_JER\_43\_13</u># He shall break also the images of Bethshemesh, that [is] in the land of Egypt; and the houses of the gods of the Egyptians shall he burn with fire.

Egypt and the <u>06\_JOS\_15\_04</u># [From thence] it passed toward Azmon, and went out unto the river of Egypt; and the goings out of that coast were at the sea: this shall be your south coast.

Egypt and the <u>06\_JOS\_15\_47</u> # Ashdod with her towns and her villages, Gaza with her towns and her villages, unto the river of Egypt, and the great sea, and the border [thereof]:

Egypt and the <u>04\_NUM\_34\_05</u># And the border shall fetch a compass from Azmon unto the river of Egypt, and the goings out of it shall be at the sea.

Egypt and the <u>38\_ZEC\_14\_19</u> # This shall be the punishment of Egypt, and the punishment of all nations that come not up to keep the feast of tabernacles.

Egypt and there <u>02\_EXO\_09\_04</u># And the LORD shall sever between the cattle of Israel and the cattle of Egypt: and there shall nothing die of all [that is] the children's of Israel.

Egypt and there <u>24\_JER\_42\_16</u># Then it shall come to pass, [that] the sword, which ye feared, shall overtake you there in the land of Egypt, and the famine, whereof ye were afraid, shall follow close after you there in Egypt; and there ye shall die.

Egypt and they <u>26\_EZE\_30\_04</u># And the sword shall come upon Egypt, and great pain shall be in Ethiopia, when the slain shall fall in Egypt, and they shall take away her multitude, and her foundations shall be broken down.

Egypt and they <u>26\_EZE\_30\_19</u> # Thus will I execute judgments in Egypt: and they shall know that I [am] the LORD.

Egypt and they <u>28\_HOS\_09\_03</u> # They shall not dwell in the LORD'S land; but Ephraim shall return to Egypt, and they shall eat unclean [things] in Assyria.

Egypt and thou <u>05\_DEU\_16\_12</u># And thou shalt remember that thou wast a bondman in Egypt: and thou shalt observe and do these statutes.

Egypt and thou <u>28\_HOS\_13\_04</u> # Yet I [am] the LORD thy God from the land of Egypt, and thou shalt know no god but me: for [there is] no saviour beside me.

Egypt and to <u>26\_EZE\_31\_02</u># Son of man, speak unto Pharaoh king of Egypt, and to his multitude; Whom art thou like in thy greatness?

Egypt and took 11\_1KI\_03\_01# And Solomon made affinity with Pharaoh king of Egypt, and took Pharaoh's daughter, and brought her into the city of David, until he had made an end of building his own house, and the house of the LORD, and the wall of Jerusalem round about.

Egypt and unto <u>05\_DEU\_11\_03</u># And his miracles, and his acts, which he did in the midst of Egypt unto Pharaoh the king of Egypt, and unto all his land;

Egypt and upon <u>23\_ISA\_20\_03</u># And the LORD said, Like as my servant Isaiah hath walked naked and barefoot three years [for] a sign and wonder upon Egypt and upon Ethiopia;

Egypt and walked <u>07\_JUD\_11\_16</u># But when Israel came up from Egypt, and walked through the wilderness unto the Red sea, and came to Kadesh;

Egypt and was <u>11\_1KI\_11\_40</u># Solomon sought therefore to kill Jeroboam. And Jeroboam arose, and fled into Egypt, unto Shishak king of Egypt, and was in Egypt until the death of Solomon.

Egypt and we <u>04\_NUM\_20\_15</u> # How our fathers went down into Egypt, and we have dwelt in Egypt a long time; and the Egyptians vexed us, and our fathers:

Egypt and what <u>06\_JOS\_02\_10</u> # For we have heard how the LORD dried up the water of the Red sea for you, when ye came out of Egypt; and what ye did unto the two kings of the Amorites, that [were] on the other side Jordan, Sihon and Og, whom ye utterly destroyed.

Egypt and when 26\_EZE\_30\_08 # And they shall know that I [am] the LORD, when I have set a fire in Egypt, and [when] all her helpers shall be destroyed.

Egypt and when 24\_JER\_37\_05 # Then Pharaoh's army was come forth out of Egypt: and when the Chaldeans that besieged Jerusalem heard tidings of them, they departed from Jerusalem.

Egypt and will <u>26\_EZE\_29\_14</u> # And I will bring again the captivity of Egypt, and will cause them to return [into] the land of Pathros, into the land of their habitation; and they shall be there a base kingdom.

Egypt and will <u>26\_EZE\_30\_22</u> # Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I [am] against Pharaoh king of Egypt, and will break his arms, the strong, and that which was broken; and I will cause the sword to fall out of his hand.

Egypt and with 44\_ACT\_13\_17 # The God of this people of Israel chose our fathers, and exalted the people when they dwelt as strangers in the land of Egypt, and with an high arm brought he them out of it.

Egypt and with <u>05\_DEU\_28\_27</u> # The LORD will smite thee with the botch of Egypt, and with the emerods, and with the scab, and with the itch, whereof thou canst not be healed.

Egypt and with 23 ISA 19 24 # In that day shall Israel be the third with Egypt and with Assyria, [even] a blessing in the midst of the land:

Egypt and ye <u>02\_EXO\_03\_18</u># And they shall hearken to thy voice: and thou shalt come, thou and the elders of Israel, unto the king of Egypt, and ye shall say unto him, The LORD God of the Hebrews hath met with us: and now let us go, we beseech thee, three days' journey into the wilderness, that we may sacrifice to the LORD our God.

Egypt and ye <u>01\_GEN\_45\_18</u> # And take your father and your households, and come unto me: and I will give you the good of the land of Egypt, and ye shall eat the fat of the land.

Egypt and ye 23\_ISA\_27\_12 # And it shall come to pass in that day, [that] the LORD shall beat off from the channel of the river unto the stream of Egypt, and ye shall be gathered one by one, O ye children of Israel.

Egypt and ye 24\_JER\_42\_18 # For thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; As mine anger and my fury hath been poured forth upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem; so shall my fury be poured forth upon you, when ye shall enter into Egypt: and ye shall be an execration, and an astonishment, and a curse, and a reproach; and ye shall see this place no more.

Egypt and ye <u>06\_JOS\_24\_06</u> # And I brought your fathers out of Egypt: and ye came unto the sea; and the Egyptians pursued after your fathers with chariots and horsemen unto the Red sea.

Egypt and ye <u>06\_JOS\_24\_07</u># And when they cried unto the LORD, he put darkness between you and the Egyptians, and brought the sea upon them, and covered them; and your eyes have seen what I have done in Egypt: and ye dwelt in the wilderness a long season.

Egypt and your <u>09\_1SA\_12\_08</u># When Jacob was come into Egypt, and your fathers cried unto the LORD, then the LORD sent Moses and Aaron, which brought forth your fathers out of Egypt, and made them dwell in this place.

Egypt any more <u>26\_EZE\_23\_27</u># Thus will I make thy lewdness to cease from thee, and thy whoredom [brought] from the land of Egypt: so that thou shalt not lift up thine eyes unto them, nor remember Egypt any more.

Egypt are mine <u>01\_GEN\_48\_05</u> # And now thy two sons, Ephraim and Manasseh, which were born unto thee in the land of Egypt before I came unto thee into Egypt, [are] mine; as Reuben and Simeon, they shall be mine.

Egypt as a 24\_JER\_43\_12 # And I will kindle a fire in the houses of the gods of Egypt; and he shall burn them, and carry them away captives: and he shall array himself with the land of Egypt, as a shepherd putteth on his garment; and he shall go forth from thence in peace.

Egypt as I <u>24\_JER\_44\_13</u> # For I will punish them that dwell in the land of Egypt, as I have punished Jerusalem, by the sword, by the famine, and by the pestilence:

Egypt as thou <u>01\_GEN\_13\_10</u># And Lot lifted up his eyes, and beheld all the plain of Jordan, that it [was] well watered every where, before the LORD destroyed Sodom and Gomorrah, [even] as the garden of the LORD, like the land of Egypt, as thou comest unto Zoar.

Egypt as thou <u>01\_GEN\_25\_18</u> # And they dwelt from Havilah unto Shur, that [is] before Egypt, as thou goest toward Assyria: [and] he died in the presence of all his brethren.

Egypt as thou <u>24\_JER\_02\_36</u># Why gaddest thou about so much to change thy way? thou also shalt be ashamed of Egypt, as thou wast ashamed of Assyria.

Egypt be like 23\_ISA\_19\_16# In that day shall Egypt be like unto women: and it shall be afraid and fear because of the shaking of the hand of the LORD of hosts, which he shaketh over it.

Egypt because they <u>58\_HEB\_08\_09</u> # Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; because they continued not in my covenant, and I regarded them not, saith the Lord.

Egypt before I <u>01\_GEN\_48\_05</u># And now thy two sons, Ephraim and Manasseh, which were born unto thee in the land of Egypt before I came unto thee into Egypt, [are] mine; as Reuben and Simeon, they shall be mine.

Egypt before the <u>11\_1KI\_08\_65</u># And at that time Solomon held a feast, and all Israel with him, a great congregation, from the entering in of Hamath unto the river of Egypt, before the LORD our God, seven days and seven days, [even] fourteen days.

Egypt before your <u>05\_DEU\_01\_30</u> # The LORD your God which goeth before you, he shall fight for you, according to all that he did for you in Egypt before your eyes;

Egypt before your <u>05 DEU 04\_34</u> # Or hath God assayed to go [and] take him a nation from the midst of [another] nation, by temptations, by signs, and by wonders, and by war, and by a mighty hand, and by a stretched out arm, and by great terrors, according to all that the LORD your God did for you in Egypt before your eyes?

Egypt Behold I <u>24\_JER\_44\_26</u># Therefore hear ye the word of the LORD, all Judah that dwell in the land of Egypt; Behold, I have sworn by my great name, saith the LORD, that my name shall no more be named in the mouth of any man of Judah in all the land of Egypt, saying, The Lord GOD liveth.

Egypt Behold the <u>23\_ISA\_19\_01</u> # The burden of Egypt. Behold, the LORD rideth upon a swift cloud, and shall come into Egypt: and the idols of Egypt shall be moved at his presence, and the heart of Egypt shall melt in the midst of it.

Egypt behold they <u>04\_NUM\_22\_05</u># He sent messengers therefore unto Balaam the son of Beor to Pethor, which [is] by the river of the land of the children of his people, to call him, saying, Behold, there is a people come out from Egypt: behold, they cover the face of the earth, and they abide over against me:

Egypt both in <u>02\_EXO\_07\_19</u># And the LORD spake unto Moses, Say unto Aaron, Take thy rod, and stretch out thine hand upon the waters of Egypt, upon their streams, upon their rivers, and upon their ponds, and upon all their pools of water, that they may become blood; and [that] there may be blood throughout all the land of Egypt, both in [vessels of] wood, and in [vessels of] stone.

Egypt both man <u>02\_EXO\_12\_12</u># For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I [am] the LORD.

Egypt both of 19\_PSA\_135\_08 # Who smote the firstborn of Egypt, both of man and beast.

Egypt both the <u>02\_EXO\_13\_15</u># And it came to pass, when Pharaoh would hardly let us go, that the LORD slew all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both the firstborn of man, and the firstborn of beast: therefore I sacrifice to the LORD all that openeth the matrix, being males; but all the firstborn of my

children I redeem.

Egypt buried they <u>06\_JOS\_24\_32</u># And the bones of Joseph, which the children of Israel brought up out of Egypt, buried they in Shechem, in a parcel of ground which Jacob bought of the sons of Hamor the father of Shechem for an hundred pieces of silver: and it became the inheritance of the children of Joseph.

Egypt but God 44\_ACT\_07\_09 # And the patriarchs, moved with envy, sold Joseph into Egypt: but God was with him,

Egypt but now <u>07\_JUD\_06\_13</u># And Gideon said unto him, Oh my Lord, if the LORD be with us, why then is all this befallen us? and where [be] all his miracles which our fathers told us of, saying, Did not the LORD bring us up from Egypt? but now the LORD hath forsaken us, and delivered us into the hands of the Midianites.

Egypt but the <u>28\_HOS\_11\_05</u># He shall not return into the land of Egypt, but the Assyrian shall be his king, because they refused to return.

Egypt but they <a href="#">14\_2CH\_20\_10</a># And now, behold, the children of Ammon and Moab and mount Seir, whom thou wouldest not let Israel invade, when they came out of the land of Egypt, but they turned from them, and destroyed them not;

Egypt by great <u>02\_EXO\_07\_04</u># But Pharaoh shall not hearken unto you, that I may lay my hand upon Egypt, and bring forth mine armies, [and] my people the children of Israel, out of the land of Egypt by great judgments.

Egypt by Moses <u>58\_HEB\_03\_16</u># For some, when they had heard, did provoke: howbeit not all that came out of Egypt by Moses.

Egypt by night <u>05\_DEU\_16\_01</u> # Observe the month of Abib, and keep the passover unto the LORD thy God: for in the month of Abib the LORD thy God brought thee forth out of Egypt by night.

Egypt by their <u>02\_EXO\_12\_51</u> # And it came to pass the selfsame day, [that] the LORD did bring the children of Israel out of the land of Egypt by their armies.

Egypt called for <u>02\_EXO\_01\_18</u> # And the king of Egypt called for the midwives, and said unto them, Why have ye done this thing, and have saved the men children alive?

Egypt came not 12\_2KI\_24\_07 # And the king of Egypt came not again any more out of his land: for the king of Babylon had taken from the river of Egypt unto the river Euphrates all that pertained to the king of Egypt.

Egypt came up <u>11\_1KI\_14\_25</u># And it came to pass in the fifth year of king Rehoboam, [that] Shishak king of Egypt came up against Jerusalem:

Egypt came up 14\_2CH\_12\_02 # And it came to pass, [that] in the fifth year of king Rehoboam Shishak king of Egypt came up against Jerusalem, because they had transgressed against the LORD,

Egypt came up <a href="14\_2CH\_12\_09">14\_2CH\_12\_09</a> # So Shishak king of Egypt came up against Jerusalem, and took away the treasures of the house of the LORD, and the treasures of the king's house; he took all: he carried away also the shields of gold which Solomon had made.

Egypt came up 14\_2CH\_35\_20 # After all this, when Josiah had prepared the temple, Necho king of Egypt came up to fight against Charchemish by Euphrates: and Josiah went out against him.

Egypt come down 01\_GEN\_45\_09 # Haste ye, and go up to my father, and say unto him, Thus saith thy son

Joseph, God hath made me lord of all Egypt: come down unto me, tarry not:

Egypt commanded them <u>02\_EXO\_01\_17</u># But the midwives feared God, and did not as the king of Egypt commanded them, but saved the men children alive.

Egypt concerning burnt 24\_JER\_07\_22 # For I spake not unto your fathers, nor commanded them in the day that I brought them out of the land of Egypt, concerning burnt offerings or sacrifices:

Egypt desolate and <u>26\_EZE\_32\_15</u># When I shall make the land of Egypt desolate, and the country shall be destitute of that whereof it was full, when I shall smite all them that dwell therein, then shall they know that I [am] the LORD.

Egypt desolate in <u>26\_EZE\_29\_12</u> # And I will make the land of Egypt desolate in the midst of the countries [that are] desolate, and her cities among the cities [that are] laid waste shall be desolate forty years: and I will scatter the Egyptians among the nations, and will disperse them through the countries.

Egypt did so <u>02\_EXO\_07\_22</u> # And the magicians of Egypt did so with their enchantments: and Pharaoh's heart was hardened, neither did he hearken unto them; as the LORD had said.

Egypt died and <u>02\_EXO\_02\_23</u># And it came to pass in process of time, that the king of Egypt died: and the children of Israel sighed by reason of the bondage, and they cried, and their cry came up unto God by reason of the bondage.

Egypt died but <u>02\_EXO\_09\_06</u> # And the LORD did that thing on the morrow, and all the cattle of Egypt died: but of the cattle of the children of Israel died not one.

Egypt dwell in <u>01\_GEN\_26\_02</u> # And the LORD appeared unto him, and said, Go not down into Egypt; dwell in the land which I shall tell thee of:

Egypt Ethiopia shall 19\_PSA\_68\_31 # Princes shall come out of Egypt; Ethiopia shall soon stretch out her hands unto God.

Egypt even darkness <u>02\_EXO\_10\_21</u># And the LORD said unto Moses, Stretch out thine hand toward heaven, that there may be darkness over the land of Egypt, even darkness [which] may be felt.

Egypt even they <u>23\_ISA\_19\_13</u> # The princes of Zoan are become fools, the princes of Noph are deceived; they have also seduced Egypt, [even they that are] the stay of the tribes thereof.

Egypt even to 10\_2SA\_07\_06 # Whereas I have not dwelt in [any] house since the time that I brought up the children of Israel out of Egypt, even to this day, but have walked in a tent and in a tabernacle.

Egypt even to <u>01\_GEN\_47\_21</u># And as for the people, he removed them to cities from [one] end of the borders of Egypt even to the [other] end thereof.

Egypt even until <u>04\_NUM\_14\_19</u> # Pardon, I beseech thee, the iniquity of this people according unto the greatness of thy mercy, and as thou hast forgiven this people, from Egypt even until now.

Egypt even unto <u>13\_1CH\_13\_05</u># So David gathered all Israel together, from Shihor of Egypt even unto the entering of Hemath, to bring the ark of God from Kirjathjearim.

Egypt even unto <u>09\_1SA\_08\_08</u> # According to all the works which they have done since the day that I brought them up out of Egypt even unto this day, wherewith they have forsaken me, and served other gods, so do they also unto thee.

Egypt even unto 12\_2KI\_21\_15 # Because they have done [that which was] evil in my sight, and have

provoked me to anger, since the day their fathers came forth out of Egypt, even unto this day.

Egypt even unto 24\_JER\_11\_07 # For I earnestly protested unto your fathers in the day [that] I brought them up out of the land of Egypt, [even] unto this day, rising early and protesting, saying, Obey my voice.

Egypt even unto <u>24\_JER\_32\_20</u> # Which hast set signs and wonders in the land of Egypt, [even] unto this day, and in Israel, and among [other] men; and hast made thee a name, as at this day;

Egypt even unto <u>06\_JOS\_13\_03</u># From Sihor, which [is] before Egypt, even unto the borders of Ekron northward, [which] is counted to the Canaanite: five lords of the Philistines; the Gazathites, and the Ashdothites, the Eshkalonites, the Gittites, and the Ekronites; also the Avites:

Egypt every man <u>02\_EXO\_01\_01</u> # Now these [are] the names of the children of Israel, which came into Egypt; every man and his household came with Jacob.

Egypt every one <u>23\_ISA\_19\_17</u> # And the land of Judah shall be a terror unto Egypt, every one that maketh mention thereof shall be afraid in himself, because of the counsel of the LORD of hosts, which he hath determined against it.

Egypt for all <u>02\_EXO\_04\_19</u> # And the LORD said unto Moses in Midian, Go, return into Egypt: for all the men are dead which sought thy life.

Egypt for badness <u>01\_GEN\_41\_19</u> # And, behold, seven other kine came up after them, poor and very ill favoured and leanfleshed, such as I never saw in all the land of Egypt for badness:

Egypt for chariots 12\_2KI\_18\_24 # How then wilt thou turn away the face of one captain of the least of my master's servants, and put thy trust on Egypt for chariots and for horsemen?

Egypt for chariots <u>23\_ISA\_36\_09</u> # How then wilt thou turn away the face of one captain of the least of my master's servants, and put thy trust on Egypt for chariots and for horsemen?

Egypt for he <u>14\_2CH\_26\_08</u># And the Ammonites gave gifts to Uzziah: and his name spread abroad [even] to the entering in of Egypt; for he strengthened [himself] exceedingly.

Egypt for he <u>58\_HEB\_11\_26</u># Esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures in Egypt: for he had respect unto the recompense of the reward.

Egypt for help <u>23\_ISA\_31\_01</u> # Woe to them that go down to Egypt for help; and stay on horses, and trust in chariots, because [they are] many; and in horsemen, because they are very strong; but they look not unto the Holy One of Israel, neither seek the LORD!

Egypt for his <u>26\_EZE\_29\_20</u># I have given him the land of Egypt [for] his labour wherewith he served against it, because they wrought for me, saith the Lord GOD.

Egypt for I <u>01\_GEN\_46\_03</u># And he said, I [am] God, the God of thy father: fear not to go down into Egypt; for I will there make of thee a great nation:

Egypt for in <u>26\_EZE\_23\_08</u># Neither left she her whoredoms [brought] from Egypt: for in her youth they lay with her, and they bruised the breasts of her virginity, and poured their whoredom upon her.

Egypt for it <u>02\_EXO\_12\_39</u> # And they baked unleavened cakes of the dough which they brought forth out of Egypt, for it was not leavened; because they were thrust out of Egypt, and could not tarry, neither had they prepared for themselves any victual.

Egypt for lo 26\_EZE\_30\_09 # In that day shall messengers go forth from me in ships to make the careless

Ethiopians afraid, and great pain shall come upon them, as in the day of Egypt: for, lo, it cometh.

Egypt for Pharaoh <u>01\_GEN\_47\_20</u> # And Joseph bought all the land of Egypt for Pharaoh; for the Egyptians sold every man his field, because the famine prevailed over them: so the land became Pharaoh's.

Egypt for six 11 1KI 10 29 # And a chariot came up and went out of Egypt for six hundred [shekels] of silver, and an horse for an hundred and fifty: and so for all the kings of the Hittites, and for the kings of Syria, did they bring [them] out by their means.

Egypt for the <u>02\_EXO\_10\_12</u># And the LORD said unto Moses, Stretch out thine hand over the land of Egypt for the locusts, that they may come up upon the land of Egypt, and eat every herb of the land, [even] all that the hail hath left.

Egypt for there <u>02\_EXO\_12\_30</u> # And Pharaoh rose up in the night, he, and all his servants, and all the Egyptians; and there was a great cry in Egypt; for [there was] not a house where [there was] not one dead.

Egypt for they 12\_2KI\_25\_26 # And all the people, both small and great, and the captains of the armies, arose, and came to Egypt: for they were afraid of the Chaldees.

Egypt for they <u>23\_ISA\_19\_20</u># And it shall be for a sign and for a witness unto the LORD of hosts in the land of Egypt: for they shall cry unto the LORD because of the oppressors, and he shall send them a saviour, and a great one, and he shall deliver them.

Egypt for they <u>24\_JER\_43\_07</u># So they came into the land of Egypt: for they obeyed not the voice of the LORD: thus came they [even] to Tahpanhes.

Egypt for thy <u>23\_ISA\_43\_03</u># For I [am] the LORD thy God, the Holy One of Israel, thy Saviour: I gave Egypt [for] thy ransom, Ethiopia and Seba for thee.

Egypt for your <u>01\_GEN\_45\_19</u># Now thou art commanded, this do ye; take you wagons out of the land of Egypt for your little ones, and for your wives, and bring your father, and come.

Egypt freely the <u>04\_NUM\_11\_05</u># We remember the fish, which we did eat in Egypt freely; the cucumbers, and the melons, and the leeks, and the onions, and the garlic:

Egypt from Arnon <u>07\_JUD\_11\_13</u># And the king of the children of Ammon answered unto the messengers of Jephthah, Because Israel took away my land, when they came up out of Egypt, from Arnon even unto Jabbok, and unto Jordan: now therefore restore those [lands] again peaceably.

Egypt from off <u>06\_JOS\_05\_09</u> # And the LORD said unto Joshua, This day have I rolled away the reproach of Egypt from off you. Wherefore the name of the place is called Gilgal unto this day.

Egypt from the <u>11\_1KI\_08\_51</u># For they [be] thy people, and thine inheritance, which thou broughtest forth out of Egypt, from the midst of the furnace of iron:

Egypt from the <u>10\_2SA\_07\_23</u> # And what one nation in the earth [is] like thy people, [even] like Israel, whom God went to redeem for a people to himself, and to make him a name, and to do for you great things and terrible, for thy land, before thy people, which thou redeemedst to thee from Egypt, [from] the nations and their gods?

Egypt from whence <u>05\_DEU\_11\_10</u># For the land, whither thou goest in to possess it, [is] not as the land of Egypt, from whence ye came out, where thou sowedst thy seed, and wateredst [it] with thy foot, as a garden of herbs:

Egypt furnish thyself <u>24\_JER\_46\_19</u> # O thou daughter dwelling in Egypt, furnish thyself to go into captivity: for Noph shall be waste and desolate without an inhabitant.

Egypt get you <u>01\_GEN\_42\_02</u> # And he said, Behold, I have heard that there is corn in Egypt: get you down thither, and buy for us from thence; that we may live, and not die.

Egypt go not <u>38\_ZEC\_14\_18</u> # And if the family of Egypt go not up, and come not, that [have] no [rain]; there shall be the plague, wherewith the LORD will smite the heathen that come not up to keep the feast of tabernacles.

Egypt had gone <u>11\_1KI\_09\_16</u># [For] Pharaoh king of Egypt had gone up, and taken Gezer, and burnt it with fire, and slain the Canaanites that dwelt in the city, and given it [for] a present unto his daughter, Solomon's wife.

Egypt Hadad being 11\_1KI\_11\_17# That Hadad fled, he and certain Edomites of his father's servants with

him, to go into Egypt; Hadad [being] yet a little child.

Egypt hast thou <u>02 EXO 14\_11</u># And they said unto Moses, Because [there were] no graves in Egypt, hast thou taken us away to die in the wilderness? wherefore hast thou dealt thus with us, to carry us forth out of Egypt?

Egypt have corrupted <u>05 DEU\_09\_12</u> # And the LORD said unto me, Arise, get thee down quickly from hence; for thy people which thou hast brought forth out of Egypt have corrupted [themselves]; they are quickly turned aside out of the way which I commanded them; they have made them a molten image.

Egypt have corrupted <u>02\_EXO\_32\_07</u> # And the LORD said unto Moses, Go, get thee down; for thy people, which thou broughtest out of the land of Egypt, have corrupted [themselves]:

Egypt have I <u>40\_MAT\_02\_15</u># And was there until the death of Herod: that it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord by the prophet, saying, Out of Egypt have I called my son.

Egypt he and <u>01\_GEN\_13\_01</u> # And Abram went up out of Egypt, he, and his wife, and all that he had, and Lot with him, into the south.

Egypt he and <u>01\_GEN\_50\_14</u># And Joseph returned into Egypt, he, and his brethren, and all that went up with him to bury his father, after he had buried his father.

Egypt he and <u>01\_GEN\_50\_22</u># And Joseph dwelt in Egypt, he, and his father's house: and Joseph lived an hundred and ten years.

Egypt he hath <u>04\_NUM\_23\_22</u># God brought them out of Egypt; he hath as it were the strength of an unicorn.

Egypt he hath <u>04\_NUM\_24\_08</u># God brought him forth out of Egypt; he hath as it were the strength of an unicorn: he shall eat up the nations his enemies, and shall break their bones, and pierce [them] through with his arrows.

Egypt he sent <u>44\_ACT\_07\_12</u># But when Jacob heard that there was corn in Egypt, he sent out our fathers first.

Egypt he shall 23\_ISA\_19\_22 # And the LORD shall smite Egypt: he shall smite and heal [it]: and they shall return [even] to the LORD, and he shall be entreated of them, and shall heal them.

Egypt heard of 11\_1KI\_12\_02# And it came to pass, when Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who was yet in Egypt, heard [of it], [for he was fled from the presence of king Solomon, and Jeroboam dwelt in Egypt;]

Egypt I am <u>26\_EZE\_20\_07</u># Then said I unto them, Cast ye away every man the abominations of his eyes, and defile not yourselves with the idols of Egypt: I [am] the LORD your God.

Egypt I am <u>03\_LEV\_19\_34</u> # [But] the stranger that dwelleth with you shall be unto you as one born among you, and thou shalt love him as thyself; for ye were strangers in the land of Egypt: I [am] the LORD your God.

Egypt I am <u>03\_LEV\_23\_43</u> # That your generations may know that I made the children of Israel to dwell in booths, when I brought them out of the land of Egypt: I [am] the LORD your God.

Egypt I am <u>03\_LEV\_25\_55</u> # For unto me the children of Israel [are] servants; they [are] my servants whom I brought forth out of the land of Egypt: I [am] the LORD your God.

Egypt I chose 11\_1KI\_08\_16 # Since the day that I brought forth my people Israel out of Egypt, I chose no

city out of all the tribes of Israel to build an house, that my name might be therein; but I chose David to be over my people Israel.

Egypt I chose <u>14\_2CH\_06\_05</u># Since the day that I brought forth my people out of the land of Egypt I chose no city among all the tribes of Israel to build an house in, that my name might be there; neither chose I any man to be a ruler over my people Israel:

Egypt I hallowed <u>04\_NUM\_03\_13</u># Because all the firstborn [are] mine; [for] on the day that I smote all the firstborn in the land of Egypt I hallowed unto me all the firstborn in Israel, both man and beast: mine shall they be: I [am] the LORD.

Egypt I sanctified <u>04\_NUM\_08\_17</u> # For all the firstborn of the children of Israel [are] mine, [both] man and beast: on the day that I smote every firstborn in the land of Egypt I sanctified them for myself.

Egypt I will <u>02\_EXO\_12\_12</u> # For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I [am] the LORD.

Egypt in haste <u>05\_DEU\_16\_03</u># Thou shalt eat no leavened bread with it; seven days shalt thou eat unleavened bread therewith, [even] the bread of affliction: for thou camest forth out of the land of Egypt in haste: that thou mayest remember the day when thou camest forth out of the land of Egypt all the days of thy life.

Egypt in Pathros 24\_JER\_44\_15 # Then all the men which knew that their wives had burned incense unto other gods, and all the women that stood by, a great multitude, even all the people that dwelt in the land of Egypt, in Pathros, answered Jeremiah, saying,

Egypt in Pharaoh's <u>09\_1SA\_02\_27</u># And there came a man of God unto Eli, and said unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Did I plainly appear unto the house of thy father, when they were in Egypt in Pharaoh's house?

Egypt in the <u>11\_1KI\_06\_01</u># And it came to pass in the four hundred and eightieth year after the children of Israel were come out of the land of Egypt, in the fourth year of Solomon's reign over Israel, in the month Zif, which [is] the second month, that he began to build the house of the LORD.

Egypt in the <u>02\_EXO\_11\_03</u># And the LORD gave the people favour in the sight of the Egyptians. Moreover the man Moses [was] very great in the land of Egypt, in the sight of Pharaoh's servants, and in the sight of the people.

Egypt into a <u>26\_EZE\_20\_06</u># In the day [that] I lifted up mine hand unto them, to bring them forth of the land of Egypt into a land that I had espied for them, flowing with milk and honey, which [is] the glory of all lands:

Egypt into the 24\_JER\_44\_28 # Yet a small number that escape the sword shall return out of the land of Egypt into the land of Judah, and all the remnant of Judah, that are gone into the land of Egypt to sojourn there, shall know whose words shall stand, mine, or theirs.

Egypt into the 24\_JER\_44\_30 # Thus saith the LORD; Behold, I will give Pharaohhophra king of Egypt into the hand of his enemies, and into the hand of them that seek his life; as I gave Zedekiah king of Judah into the hand of Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon, his enemy, and that sought his life.

Egypt into their 24\_JER\_37\_07 # Thus saith the LORD, the God of Israel; Thus shall ye say to the king of Judah, that sent you unto me to inquire of me; Behold, Pharaoh's army, which is come forth to help you, shall return to Egypt into their own land.

Egypt is before <u>01\_GEN\_47\_06</u># The land of Egypt [is] before thee; in the best of the land make thy father and brethren to dwell; in the land of Goshen let them dwell: and if thou knowest [any] men of activity among them, then make them rulers over my cattle.

Egypt is but 24\_JER\_46\_17\_# They did cry there, Pharaoh king of Egypt [is but] a noise; he hath passed the time appointed.

Egypt is destroyed <u>02\_EXO\_10\_07</u> # And Pharaoh's servants said unto him, How long shall this man be a snare unto us? let the men go, that they may serve the LORD their God: knowest thou not yet that Egypt is destroyed?

Egypt is like <u>24\_JER\_46\_20</u> # Egypt [is like] a very fair heifer, [but] destruction cometh; it cometh out of the north.

Egypt is yours 01\_GEN\_45\_20 # Also regard not your stuff; for the good of all the land of Egypt [is] yours.

Egypt Jacob and <u>01\_GEN\_46\_06</u># And they took their cattle, and their goods, which they had gotten in the land of Canaan, and came into Egypt, Jacob, and all his seed with him:

Egypt Jacob and <u>01\_GEN\_46\_08</u># And these [are] the names of the children of Israel, which came into Egypt, Jacob and his sons: Reuben, Jacob's firstborn.

Egypt Jacob said <u>01\_GEN\_42\_01</u># Now when Jacob saw that there was corn in Egypt, Jacob said unto his sons, Why do ye look one upon another?

Egypt know certainly 24\_JER\_42\_19 # The LORD hath said concerning you, O ye remnant of Judah; Go ye not into Egypt: know certainly that I have admonished you this day.

Egypt made Eliakim <u>14\_2CH\_36\_04</u> # And the king of Egypt made Eliakim his brother king over Judah and Jerusalem, and turned his name to Jehoiakim. And Necho took Jehoahaz his brother, and carried him

to Egypt.

Egypt my people <u>23\_ISA\_19\_25</u># Whom the LORD of hosts shall bless, saying, Blessed [be] Egypt my people, and Assyria the work of my hands, and Israel mine inheritance.

Egypt namely Elnathan 24\_JER\_26\_22 # And Jehoiakim the king sent men into Egypt, [namely], Elnathan the son of Achbor, and [certain] men with him into Egypt.

Egypt not fearing <u>58\_HEB\_11\_27</u># By faith he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king: for he endured, as seeing him who is invisible.

Egypt O Lord 11 1KI 08 53 # For thou didst separate them from among all the people of the earth, [to be] thine inheritance, as thou spakest by the hand of Moses thy servant, when thou broughtest our fathers out of Egypt, O Lord GOD.

Egypt on which 12\_2KI\_18\_21 # Now, behold, thou trustest upon the staff of this bruised reed, [even] upon Egypt, on which if a man lean, it will go into his hand, and pierce it: so [is] Pharaoh king of Egypt unto all that trust on him.

Egypt open thy 19\_PSA\_81\_10 # I [am] the LORD thy God, which brought thee out of the land of Egypt: open thy mouth wide, and I will fill it.

Egypt or would <u>04\_NUM\_14\_02</u># And all the children of Israel murmured against Moses and against Aaron: and the whole congregation said unto them, Would God that we had died in the land of Egypt! or would God we had died in this wilderness!

Egypt out of <u>02\_EXO\_13\_03</u># And Moses said unto the people, Remember this day, in which ye came out from Egypt, out of the house of bondage; for by strength of hand the LORD brought you out from this [place]: there shall no leavened bread be eaten.

Egypt out of <u>02\_EXO\_20\_02</u> # I [am] the LORD thy God, which have brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage.

Egypt out of <u>24\_JER\_34\_13</u> # Thus saith the LORD, the God of Israel; I made a covenant with your fathers in the day that I brought them forth out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondmen, saying,

Egypt put him 14\_2CH\_36\_03 # And the king of Egypt put him down at Jerusalem, and condemned the land in an hundred talents of silver and a talent of gold.

Egypt riseth up 24\_JER\_46\_08 # Egypt riseth up like a flood, and [his] waters are moved like the rivers; and he saith, I will go up, [and] will cover the earth; I will destroy the city and the inhabitants thereof.

Egypt said unto <u>02\_EXO\_05\_04</u> # And the king of Egypt said unto them, Wherefore do ye, Moses and Aaron, let the people from their works? get you unto your burdens.

Egypt saying Let <u>02\_EXO\_14\_12</u> # [Is] not this the word that we did tell thee in Egypt, saying, Let us alone, that we may serve the Egyptians? For [it had been] better for us to serve the Egyptians, than that we should die in the wilderness.

Egypt saying The 24\_JER\_44\_26 # Therefore hear ye the word of the LORD, all Judah that dwell in the land of Egypt; Behold, I have sworn by my great name, saith the LORD, that my name shall no more be named in the mouth of any man of Judah in all the land of Egypt, saying, The Lord GOD liveth.

Egypt saying 30\_AMO\_03\_01 # Hear this word that the LORD hath spoken against you, O children of Israel, against the whole family which I brought up from the land of Egypt, saying,

Egypt saying <u>02\_EXO\_12\_01</u># And the LORD spake unto Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt, saying,

Egypt saying <u>04\_NUM\_01\_01</u># And the LORD spake unto Moses in the wilderness of Sinai, in the tabernacle of the congregation, on the first [day] of the second month, in the second year after they were come out of the land of Egypt, saying,

Egypt saying <u>04\_NUM\_09\_01</u> # And the LORD spake unto Moses in the wilderness of Sinai, in the first month of the second year after they were come out of the land of Egypt, saying,

Egypt see that <u>02\_EXO\_04\_21</u> # And the LORD said unto Moses, When thou goest to return into Egypt, see that thou do all those wonders before Pharaoh, which I have put in thine hand: but I will harden his heart, that he shall not let the people go.

Egypt servant to <u>09\_1SA\_30\_13</u> # And David said unto him, To whom [belongest] thou? and whence [art] thou? And he said, I [am] a young man of Egypt, servant to an Amalekite; and my master left me, because three days ago I fell sick.

Egypt seventeen years <u>01\_GEN\_47\_28</u># And Jacob lived in the land of Egypt seventeen years: so the whole age of Jacob was an hundred forty and seven years.

Egypt shall be <u>26\_EZE\_29\_09</u> # And the land of Egypt shall be desolate and waste; and they shall know that I [am] the LORD: because he hath said, The river [is] mine, and I have made [it].

Egypt shall be <u>23\_ISA\_19\_01</u># The burden of Egypt. Behold, the LORD rideth upon a swift cloud, and shall come into Egypt: and the idols of Egypt shall be moved at his presence, and the heart of Egypt shall melt in the midst of it.

Egypt shall be 24\_JER\_44\_27 # Behold, I will watch over them for evil, and not for good: and all the men of Judah that [are] in the land of Egypt shall be consumed by the sword and by the famine, until there be an end of them.

Egypt shall be 29\_JOE\_03\_19 # Egypt shall be a desolation, and Edom shall be a desolate wilderness, for the violence [against] the children of Judah, because they have shed innocent blood in their land.

Egypt shall depart <u>38\_ZEC\_10\_11</u># And he shall pass through the sea with affliction, and shall smite the waves in the sea, and all the deeps of the river shall dry up: and the pride of Assyria shall be brought down, and the sceptre of Egypt shall depart away.

Egypt shall die <u>02\_EXO\_11\_05</u># And all the firstborn in the land of Egypt shall die, from the firstborn of Pharaoh that sitteth upon his throne, even unto the firstborn of the maidservant that [is] behind the mill; and all the firstborn of beasts.

Egypt shall fail 23\_ISA\_19\_03 # And the spirit of Egypt shall fail in the midst thereof; and I will destroy the counsel thereof: and they shall seek to the idols, and to the charmers, and to them that have familiar spirits, and to the wizards.

Egypt shall melt <u>23\_ISA\_19\_01</u># The burden of Egypt. Behold, the LORD rideth upon a swift cloud, and shall come into Egypt: and the idols of Egypt shall be moved at his presence, and the heart of Egypt shall melt in the midst of it.

Egypt shall not <u>27\_DAN\_11\_42</u># He shall stretch forth his hand also upon the countries: and the land of Egypt shall not escape.

Egypt Sin shall <u>26\_EZE\_30\_16</u> # And I will set fire in Egypt: Sin shall have great pain, and No shall be rent asunder, and Noph [shall have] distresses daily.

Egypt since it <u>02\_EXO\_09\_24</u> # So there was hail, and fire mingled with the hail, very grievous, such as there was none like it in all the land of Egypt since it became a nation.

Egypt since the <u>02\_EXO\_09\_18</u># Behold, to morrow about this time I will cause it to rain a very grievous hail, such as hath not been in Egypt since the foundation thereof even until now.

Egypt so my <u>37\_HAG\_02\_05</u># [According to] the word that I covenanted with you when ye came out of Egypt, so my spirit remaineth among you: fear ye not.

Egypt so shall <u>23\_ISA\_23\_05</u># As at the report concerning Egypt, [so] shall they be sorely pained at the report of Tyre.

Egypt so that <u>26\_EZE\_23\_27</u># Thus will I make thy lewdness to cease from thee, and thy whoredom [brought] from the land of Egypt: so that thou shalt not lift up thine eyes unto them, nor remember Egypt any more.

Egypt So the <u>09\_1SA\_15\_06</u># And Saul said unto the Kenites, Go, depart, get you down from among the Amalekites, lest I destroy you with them: for ye showed kindness to all the children of Israel, when they came up out of Egypt. So the Kenites departed from among the Amalekites.

Egypt so will 26\_EZE\_20\_36 # Like as I pleaded with your fathers in the wilderness of the land of Egypt, so will I plead with you, saith the Lord GOD.

Egypt spake to <u>02\_EXO\_01\_15</u># And the king of Egypt spake to the Hebrew midwives, of which the name of the one [was] Shiphrah, and the name of the other Puah:

Egypt that David 11\_1KI\_11\_21# And when Hadad heard in Egypt that David slept with his fathers, and that Joab the captain of the host was dead, Hadad said to Pharaoh, Let me depart, that I may go to mine own country.

Egypt that he <u>02\_EXO\_06\_11</u># Go in, speak unto Pharaoh king of Egypt, that he let the children of Israel go out of his land.

Egypt that he <u>01\_GEN\_12\_11</u># And it came to pass, when he was come near to enter into Egypt, that he said unto Sarai his wife, Behold now, I know that thou [art] a fair woman to look upon:

Egypt that I <u>02\_EXO\_29\_46</u># And they shall know that I [am] the LORD their God, that brought them forth out of the land of Egypt, that I may dwell among them: I [am] the LORD their God.

Egypt that were <u>06\_JOS\_05\_04</u> # And this [is] the cause why Joshua did circumcise: All the people that came out of Egypt, [that were] males, [even] all the men of war, died in the wilderness by the way, after they came out of Egypt.

Egypt that ye <u>03\_LEV\_26\_13</u> # I [am] the LORD your God, which brought you forth out of the land of Egypt, that ye should not be their bondmen; and I have broken the bands of your yoke, and made you go upright.

Egypt the chief 19\_PSA\_78\_51 # And smote all the firstborn in Egypt; the chief of [their] strength in the tabernacles of Ham:

Egypt the Egyptians <u>01\_GEN\_12\_14</u># And it came to pass, that, when Abram was come into Egypt, the Egyptians beheld the woman that she [was] very fair.

Egypt the great 26\_EZE\_29\_03 # Speak, and say, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I [am] against thee, Pharaoh king of Egypt, the great dragon that lieth in the midst of his rivers, which hath said, My river [is] mine own, and I have made [it] for myself.

Egypt the house 19\_PSA\_114\_01# When Israel went out of Egypt, the house of Jacob from a people of strange language;

Egypt the land <u>02\_EXO\_08\_24</u> # And the LORD did so; and there came a grievous swarm [of flies] into the house of Pharaoh, and [into] his servants' houses, and into all the land of Egypt: the land was corrupted by reason of the swarm [of flies].

Egypt the Lubims <u>14\_2CH\_12\_03</u># With twelve hundred chariots, and threescore thousand horsemen: and the people [were] without number that came with him out of Egypt; the Lubims, the Sukkiims, and the Ethiopians.

Egypt they brought 11\_1KI\_04\_21# And Solomon reigned over all kingdoms from the river unto the land of the Philistines, and unto the border of Egypt: they brought presents, and served Solomon all the days of his life.

Egypt they committed <u>26\_EZE\_23\_03</u># And they committed whoredoms in Egypt; they committed whoredoms in their youth: there were their breasts pressed, and there they bruised the teats of their virginity.

Egypt they go <u>28\_HOS\_07\_11</u># Ephraim also is like a silly dove without heart: they call to Egypt, they go to Assyria.

Egypt they remembered 19\_PSA\_106\_07 # Our fathers understood not thy wonders in Egypt; they remembered not the multitude of thy mercies; but provoked [him] at the sea, [even] at the Red sea.

Egypt to be <u>05\_DEU\_04\_20</u> # But the LORD hath taken you, and brought you forth out of the iron furnace, [even] out of Egypt, to be unto him a people of inheritance, as [ye are] this day.

Egypt to be <u>03\_LEV\_11\_45</u># For I [am] the LORD that bringeth you up out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: ye shall therefore be holy, for I [am] holy.

Egypt to be 03\_LEV\_22\_33 # That brought you out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: I [am] the LORD.

Egypt to be <u>04\_NUM\_15\_41</u> # I [am] the LORD your God, which brought you out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: I [am] the LORD your God.

Egypt to bring <u>02\_EXO\_06\_13</u># And the LORD spake unto Moses and unto Aaron, and gave them a charge unto the children of Israel, and unto Pharaoh king of Egypt, to bring the children of Israel out of the land of Egypt.

Egypt unto Shishak 11\_1KI\_11\_40# Solomon sought therefore to kill Jeroboam. And Jeroboam arose, and fled into Egypt, unto Shishak king of Egypt, and was in Egypt until the death of Solomon.

Egypt unto the 12\_2KI\_24\_07 # And the king of Egypt came not again any more out of his land: for the king of Babylon had taken from the river of Egypt unto the river Euphrates all that pertained to the king of Egypt.

Egypt unto the <u>02\_EXO\_03\_17</u># And I have said, I will bring you up out of the affliction of Egypt unto the land of the Canaanites, and the Hittites, and the Amorites, and the Perizzites, and the Hivites, and the Jebusites, unto a land flowing with milk and honey.

Egypt we wot 44\_ACT\_07\_40 # Saying unto Aaron, Make us gods to go before us: for [as for] this Moses, which brought us out of the land of Egypt, we wot not what is become of him.

Egypt with a 05\_DEU\_06\_21 # Then thou shalt say unto thy son, We were Pharaoh's bondmen in Egypt;

and the LORD brought us out of Egypt with a mighty hand:

Egypt with a <u>05\_DEU\_09\_26</u># I prayed therefore unto the LORD, and said, O Lord GOD, destroy not thy people and thine inheritance, which thou hast redeemed through thy greatness, which thou hast brought forth out of Egypt with a mighty hand.

Egypt with a <u>05\_DEU\_26\_08</u># And the LORD brought us forth out of Egypt with a mighty hand, and with an outstretched arm, and with great terribleness, and with signs, and with wonders:

Egypt with all <u>02\_EXO\_03\_20</u> # And I will stretch out my hand, and smite Egypt with all my wonders which I will do in the midst thereof: and after that he will let you go.

Egypt with great 12\_2KI\_17\_36 # But the LORD, who brought you up out of the land of Egypt with great power and a stretched out arm, him shall ye fear, and him shall ye worship, and to him shall ye do sacrifice.

Egypt with great <u>02\_EXO\_32\_11</u># And Moses besought the LORD his God, and said, LORD, why doth thy wrath wax hot against thy people, which thou hast brought forth out of the land of Egypt with great power, and with a mighty hand?

Egypt with signs 24\_JER\_32\_21 # And hast brought forth thy people Israel out of the land of Egypt with signs, and with wonders, and with a strong hand, and with a stretched out arm, and with great terror;

Egypt with their <u>24\_JER\_46\_25</u> # The LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, saith; Behold, I will punish the multitude of No, and Pharaoh, and Egypt, with their gods, and their kings; even Pharaoh, and [all] them that trust in him:

Egypt with their <u>04\_NUM\_33\_01</u> # These [are] the journeys of the children of Israel, which went forth out of the land of Egypt with their armies under the hand of Moses and Aaron.

Egypt with threescore <u>05\_DEU\_10\_22</u># Thy fathers went down into Egypt with threescore and ten persons; and now the LORD thy God hath made thee as the stars of heaven for multitude.

Egypt ye shall <u>02\_EXO\_03\_12</u> # And he said, Certainly I will be with thee; and this [shall be] a token unto thee, that I have sent thee: When thou hast brought forth the people out of Egypt, ye shall serve God upon this mountain.

Egypt your confusion <u>23\_ISA\_30\_03</u># Therefore shall the strength of Pharaoh be your shame, and the trust in the shadow of Egypt [your] confusion.

Egypt your young <u>30\_AMO\_04\_10</u> # I have sent among you the pestilence after the manner of Egypt: your young men have I slain with the sword, and have taken away your horses; and I have made the stink of your camps to come up unto your nostrils: yet have ye not returned unto me, saith the LORD.

Egypt <u>13\_1CH\_17\_21</u> # And what one nation in the earth [is] like thy people Israel, whom God went to redeem [to be] his own people, to make thee a name of greatness and terribleness, by driving out nations from before thy people, whom thou hast redeemed out of Egypt?

Egypt <u>11\_1KI\_04\_30</u># And Solomon's wisdom excelled the wisdom of all the children of the east country, and all the wisdom of Egypt.

Egypt <u>11\_1KI\_08\_09</u># [There was] nothing in the ark save the two tables of stone, which Moses put there at Horeb, when the LORD made [a covenant] with the children of Israel, when they came out of the land of Egypt.

Egypt 11\_1KI\_08\_21 # And I have set there a place for the ark, wherein [is] the covenant of the LORD,

which he made with our fathers, when he brought them out of the land of Egypt.

Egypt <u>11\_1KI\_12\_02</u># And it came to pass, when Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who was yet in Egypt, heard [of it], [for he was fled from the presence of king Solomon, and Jeroboam dwelt in Egypt;]

Egypt <u>11\_1KI\_12\_28</u># Whereupon the king took counsel, and made two calves [of] gold, and said unto them, It is too much for you to go up to Jerusalem: behold thy gods, O Israel, which brought thee up out of the land of Egypt.

Egypt <u>09\_1SA\_12\_06</u> # And Samuel said unto the people, [It is] the LORD that advanced Moses and Aaron, and that brought your fathers up out of the land of Egypt.

Egypt <u>09\_1SA\_15\_02</u> # Thus saith the LORD of hosts, I remember [that] which Amalek did to Israel, how he laid [wait] for him in the way, when he came up from Egypt.

Egypt <u>09\_1SA\_15\_07</u># And Saul smote the Amalekites from Havilah [until] thou comest to Shur, that [is] over against Egypt.

Egypt <u>09 1SA 27 08 </u># And David and his men went up, and invaded the Geshurites, and the Gezrites, and the Amalekites: for those [nations were] of old the inhabitants of the land, as thou goest to Shur, even unto the land of Egypt.

Egypt <u>14\_2CH\_05\_10</u> # [There was] nothing in the ark save the two tables which Moses put [therein] at Horeb, when the LORD made [a covenant] with the children of Israel, when they came out of Egypt.

Egypt <u>14\_2CH\_07\_08</u># Also at the same time Solomon kept the feast seven days, and all Israel with him, a very great congregation, from the entering in of Hamath unto the river of Egypt.

Egypt <u>14\_2CH\_09\_26</u> # And he reigned over all the kings from the river even unto the land of the Philistines, and to the border of Egypt.

Egypt <u>14\_2CH\_10\_02</u> # And it came to pass, when Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who [was] in Egypt, whither he had fled from the presence of Solomon the king, heard [it], that Jeroboam returned out of Egypt.

Egypt <u>14\_2CH\_36\_04</u> # And the king of Egypt made Eliakim his brother king over Judah and Jerusalem, and turned his name to Jehoiakim. And Necho took Jehoahaz his brother, and carried him to Egypt.

Egypt <u>12\_2KI\_24\_07</u> # And the king of Egypt came not again any more out of his land: for the king of Babylon had taken from the river of Egypt unto the river Euphrates all that pertained to the king of Egypt.

Egypt 44\_ACT\_07\_17 # But when the time of the promise drew nigh, which God had sworn to Abraham, the people grew and multiplied in Egypt,

Egypt <u>44\_ACT\_07\_34</u># I have seen, I have seen the affliction of my people which is in Egypt, and I have heard their groaning, and am come down to deliver them. And now come, I will send thee into Egypt.

Egypt <u>44\_ACT\_07\_39</u> # To whom our fathers would not obey, but thrust [him] from them, and in their hearts turned back again into Egypt,

Egypt <u>30\_AMO\_08\_08</u> # Shall not the land tremble for this, and every one mourn that dwelleth therein? and it shall rise up wholly as a flood; and it shall be cast out and drowned, as [by] the flood of Egypt.

Egypt <u>30\_AMO\_09\_05</u> # And the Lord GOD of hosts [is] he that toucheth the land, and it shall melt, and all that dwell therein shall mourn: and it shall rise up wholly like a flood; and shall be drowned, as [by] the flood of Egypt.

Egypt <u>05\_DEU\_04\_37</u> # And because he loved thy fathers, therefore he chose their seed after them, and brought thee out in his sight with his mighty power out of Egypt;

Egypt <u>05\_DEU\_04\_45</u> # These [are] the testimonies, and the statutes, and the judgments, which Moses spake unto the children of Israel, after they came forth out of Egypt,

Egypt <u>05\_DEU\_04\_46</u> # On this side Jordan, in the valley over against Bethpeor, in the land of Sihon king of the Amorites, who dwelt at Heshbon, whom Moses and the children of Israel smote, after they were come forth out of Egypt:

Egypt <u>05\_DEU\_07\_08</u># But because the LORD loved you, and because he would keep the oath which he had sworn unto your fathers, hath the LORD brought you out with a mighty hand, and redeemed you out of the house of bondmen, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt.

Egypt <u>05\_DEU\_07\_18</u> # Thou shalt not be afraid of them: [but] shalt well remember what the LORD thy God did unto Pharaoh, and unto all Egypt;

Egypt <u>05\_DEU\_10\_19</u> # Love ye therefore the stranger: for ye were strangers in the land of Egypt.

Egypt <u>05 DEU 16 06 #</u> But at the place which the LORD thy God shall choose to place his name in, there thou shalt sacrifice the passover at even, at the going down of the sun, at the season that thou camest forth out of Egypt.

Egypt <u>05 DEU 20 01</u> # When thou goest out to battle against thine enemies, and seest horses, and chariots, [and] a people more than thou, be not afraid of them: for the LORD thy God [is] with thee, which brought thee up out of the land of Egypt.

Egypt <u>05\_DEU\_24\_09</u> # Remember what the LORD thy God did unto Miriam by the way, after that ye were come forth out of Egypt.

Egypt <u>05\_DEU\_25\_17</u> # Remember what Amalek did unto thee by the way, when ye were come forth out of Egypt;

Egypt <u>05\_DEU\_29\_25</u> # Then men shall say, Because they have forsaken the covenant of the LORD God of their fathers, which he made with them when he brought them forth out of the land of Egypt:

Egypt <u>02\_EXO\_03\_10</u> # Come now therefore, and I will send thee unto Pharaoh, that thou mayest bring forth my people the children of Israel out of Egypt.

Egypt <u>02\_EXO\_03\_11</u># And Moses said unto God, Who [am] I, that I should go unto Pharaoh, and that I should bring forth the children of Israel out of Egypt?

Egypt <u>02\_EXO\_03\_16</u> # Go, and gather the elders of Israel together, and say unto them, The LORD God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, of Isaac, and of Jacob, appeared unto me, saying, I have surely visited you, and [seen] that which is done to you in Egypt:

Egypt <u>02\_EXO\_06\_13</u> # And the LORD spake unto Moses and unto Aaron, and gave them a charge unto the children of Israel, and unto Pharaoh king of Egypt, to bring the children of Israel out of the land of Egypt.

Egypt <u>02\_EXO\_06\_28</u># And it came to pass on the day [when] the LORD spake unto Moses in the land of Egypt,

Egypt 02\_EXO\_07\_03 # And I will harden Pharaoh's heart, and multiply my signs and my wonders in the

land of Egypt.

Egypt <u>02\_EXO\_07\_21</u> # And the fish that [was] in the river died; and the river stank, and the Egyptians could not drink of the water of the river; and there was blood throughout all the land of Egypt.

Egypt <u>02 EXO 08 05 #</u> And the LORD spake unto Moses, Say unto Aaron, Stretch forth thine hand with thy rod over the streams, over the rivers, and over the ponds, and cause frogs to come up upon the land of Egypt.

Egypt <u>02\_EXO\_08\_06</u> # And Aaron stretched out his hand over the waters of Egypt; and the frogs came up, and covered the land of Egypt.

Egypt <u>02\_EXO\_08\_07</u> # And the magicians did so with their enchantments, and brought up frogs upon the land of Egypt.

Egypt <u>02\_EXO\_08\_16</u> # And the LORD said unto Moses, Say unto Aaron, Stretch out thy rod, and smite the dust of the land, that it may become lice throughout all the land of Egypt.

Egypt <u>02\_EXO\_08\_17</u># And they did so; for Aaron stretched out his hand with his rod, and smote the dust of the earth, and it became lice in man, and in beast; all the dust of the land became lice throughout all the land of Egypt.

Egypt <u>02\_EXO\_09\_09</u> # And it shall become small dust in all the land of Egypt, and shall be a boil breaking forth [with] blains upon man, and upon beast, throughout all the land of Egypt.

Egypt <u>02\_EXO\_09\_22</u> # And the LORD said unto Moses, Stretch forth thine hand toward heaven, that there may be hail in all the land of Egypt, upon man, and upon beast, and upon every herb of the field, throughout the land of Egypt.

Egypt <u>02\_EXO\_09\_23</u> # And Moses stretched forth his rod toward heaven: and the LORD sent thunder and hail, and the fire ran along upon the ground; and the LORD rained hail upon the land of Egypt.

Egypt <u>02\_EXO\_10\_15</u># For they covered the face of the whole earth, so that the land was darkened; and they did eat every herb of the land, and all the fruit of the trees which the hail had left: and there remained not any green thing in the trees, or in the herbs of the field, through all the land of Egypt.

Egypt <u>02\_EXO\_10\_19</u># And the LORD turned a mighty strong west wind, which took away the locusts, and cast them into the Red sea; there remained not one locust in all the coasts of Egypt.

Egypt <u>02\_EXO\_11\_04</u># And Moses said, Thus saith the LORD, About midnight will I go out into the midst of Egypt:

Egypt <u>02\_EXO\_11\_09</u># And the LORD said unto Moses, Pharaoh shall not hearken unto you; that my wonders may be multiplied in the land of Egypt.

Egypt <u>02\_EXO\_12\_13</u> # And the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye [are]: and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy [you], when I smite the land of Egypt.

Egypt <u>02\_EXO\_12\_41</u> # And it came to pass at the end of the four hundred and thirty years, even the selfsame day it came to pass, that all the hosts of the LORD went out from the land of Egypt.

Egypt <u>02\_EXO\_13\_08</u># And thou shalt show thy son in that day, saying, [This is done] because of that [which] the LORD did unto me when I came forth out of Egypt.

- Egypt <u>02 EXO 13 09</u> # And it shall be for a sign unto thee upon thine hand, and for a memorial between thine eyes, that the LORD's law may be in thy mouth: for with a strong hand hath the LORD brought thee out of Egypt.
- Egypt <u>02\_EXO\_13\_16</u># And it shall be for a token upon thine hand, and for frontlets between thine eyes: for by strength of hand the LORD brought us forth out of Egypt.
- Egypt <u>02 EXO 13 17 # And it came to pass</u>, when Pharaoh had let the people go, that God led them not [through] the way of the land of the Philistines, although that [was] near; for God said, Lest peradventure the people repent when they see war, and they return to Egypt:
- Egypt <u>02\_EXO\_13\_18</u># But God led the people about, [through] the way of the wilderness of the Red sea: and the children of Israel went up harnessed out of the land of Egypt.
- Egypt <u>02\_EXO\_14\_11</u># And they said unto Moses, Because [there were] no graves in Egypt, hast thou taken us away to die in the wilderness? wherefore hast thou dealt thus with us, to carry us forth out of Egypt?
- Egypt <u>02\_EXO\_16\_01</u> # And they took their journey from Elim, and all the congregation of the children of Israel came unto the wilderness of Sin, which [is] between Elim and Sinai, on the fifteenth day of the second month after their departing out of the land of Egypt.
- Egypt <u>02\_EXO\_16\_06</u># And Moses and Aaron said unto all the children of Israel, At even, then ye shall know that the LORD hath brought you out from the land of Egypt:
- Egypt <u>02\_EXO\_16\_32</u> # And Moses said, This [is] the thing which the LORD commandeth, Fill an omer of it to be kept for your generations; that they may see the bread wherewith I have fed you in the wilderness, when I brought you forth from the land of Egypt.
- Egypt <u>02\_EXO\_18\_01</u> # When Jethro, the priest of Midian, Moses' father in law, heard of all that God had done for Moses, and for Israel his people, [and] that the LORD had brought Israel out of Egypt;
- Egypt <u>02\_EXO\_22\_21</u> # Thou shalt neither vex a stranger, nor oppress him: for ye were strangers in the land of Egypt.
- Egypt <u>02\_EXO\_23\_09</u> # Also thou shalt not oppress a stranger: for ye know the heart of a stranger, seeing ye were strangers in the land of Egypt.
- Egypt <u>02\_EXO\_32\_04</u> # And he received [them] at their hand, and fashioned it with a graving tool, after he had made it a molten calf: and they said, These [be] thy gods, O Israel, which brought thee up out of the land of Egypt.
- Egypt <u>02\_EXO\_32\_08</u># They have turned aside quickly out of the way which I commanded them: they have made them a molten calf, and have worshipped it, and have sacrificed thereunto, and said, These [be] thy gods, O Israel, which have brought thee up out of the land of Egypt.
- Egypt <u>02\_EXO\_34\_18</u># The feast of unleavened bread shalt thou keep. Seven days thou shalt eat unleavened bread, as I commanded thee, in the time of the month Abib: for in the month Abib thou camest out from Egypt.
- Egypt <u>26\_EZE\_19\_04</u> # The nations also heard of him; he was taken in their pit, and they brought him with chains unto the land of Egypt.
- Egypt <u>26\_EZE\_20\_08</u># But they rebelled against me, and would not hearken unto me: they did not every man cast away the abominations of their eyes, neither did they forsake the idols of Egypt: then I said, I will

pour out my fury upon them, to accomplish my anger against them in the midst of the land of Egypt.

Egypt <u>26\_EZE\_20\_09</u> # But I wrought for my name's sake, that it should not be polluted before the heathen, among whom they [were], in whose sight I made myself known unto them, in bringing them forth out of the land of Egypt.

Egypt <u>26\_EZE\_23\_19</u> # Yet she multiplied her whoredoms, in calling to remembrance the days of her youth, wherein she had played the harlot in the land of Egypt.

Egypt <u>26\_EZE\_29\_02</u># Son of man, set thy face against Pharaoh king of Egypt, and prophesy against him, and against all Egypt:

Egypt <u>26\_EZE\_30\_13</u> # Thus saith the Lord GOD; I will also destroy the idols, and I will cause [their] images to cease out of Noph; and there shall be no more a prince of the land of Egypt: and I will put a fear in the land of Egypt.

Egypt <u>26\_EZE\_30\_25</u> # But I will strengthen the arms of the king of Babylon, and the arms of Pharaoh shall fall down; and they shall know that I [am] the LORD, when I shall put my sword into the hand of the king of Babylon, and he shall stretch it out upon the land of Egypt.

Egypt <u>01\_GEN\_21\_21</u> # And he dwelt in the wilderness of Paran: and his mother took him a wife out of the land of Egypt.

Egypt <u>01\_GEN\_37\_25</u># And they sat down to eat bread: and they lifted up their eyes and looked, and, behold, a company of Ishmeelites came from Gilead with their camels bearing spicery and balm and myrrh, going to carry [it] down to Egypt.

Egypt <u>01 GEN 37 28</u> # Then there passed by Midianites merchantmen; and they drew and lifted up Joseph out of the pit, and sold Joseph to the Ishmeelites for twenty [pieces] of silver: and they brought Joseph into Egypt.

Egypt <u>01\_GEN\_40\_01</u># And it came to pass after these things, [that] the butler of the king of Egypt and [his] baker had offended their lord the king of Egypt.

Egypt 01\_GEN\_41\_29 # Behold, there come seven years of great plenty throughout all the land of Egypt:

Egypt <u>01\_GEN\_41\_33</u> # Now therefore let Pharaoh look out a man discreet and wise, and set him over the land of Egypt.

Egypt 01\_GEN\_41\_41 # And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, See, I have set thee over all the land of Egypt.

Egypt <u>01\_GEN\_41\_43</u># And he made him to ride in the second chariot which he had; and they cried before him, Bow the knee: and he made him [ruler] over all the land of Egypt.

Egypt <u>01\_GEN\_41\_44</u># And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, I [am] Pharaoh, and without thee shall no man lift up his hand or foot in all the land of Egypt.

Egypt <u>01\_GEN\_41\_45</u># And Pharaoh called Joseph's name Zaphnathpaaneah; and he gave him to wife Asenath the daughter of Potipherah priest of On. And Joseph went out over [all] the land of Egypt.

Egypt <u>01\_GEN\_41\_46</u># And Joseph [was] thirty years old when he stood before Pharaoh king of Egypt. And Joseph went out from the presence of Pharaoh, and went throughout all the land of Egypt.

Egypt <u>01\_GEN\_41\_56</u># And the famine was over all the face of the earth: And Joseph opened all the storehouses, and sold unto the Egyptians; and the famine waxed sore in the land of Egypt.

- Egypt 01\_GEN\_42\_03 # And Joseph's ten brethren went down to buy corn in Egypt.
- Egypt <u>01\_GEN\_45\_04</u> # And Joseph said unto his brethren, Come near to me, I pray you. And they came near. And he said, I [am] Joseph your brother, whom ye sold into Egypt.
- Egypt <u>01\_GEN\_45\_08</u># So now [it was] not you [that] sent me hither, but God: and he hath made me a father to Pharaoh, and lord of all his house, and a ruler throughout all the land of Egypt.
- Egypt <u>01\_GEN\_46\_07</u> # His sons, and his sons' sons with him, his daughters, and his sons' daughters, and all his seed brought he with him into Egypt.
- Egypt <u>01\_GEN\_47\_29</u># And the time drew nigh that Israel must die: and he called his son Joseph, and said unto him, If now I have found grace in thy sight, put, I pray thee, thy hand under my thigh, and deal kindly and truly with me; bury me not, I pray thee, in Egypt:
- Egypt <u>01\_GEN\_50\_07</u># And Joseph went up to bury his father: and with him went up all the servants of Pharaoh, the elders of his house, and all the elders of the land of Egypt,
- Egypt <u>01\_GEN\_50\_26</u> # So Joseph died, [being] an hundred and ten years old: and they embalmed him, and he was put in a coffin in Egypt.
- Egypt <u>28\_HOS\_02\_15</u># And I will give her her vineyards from thence, and the valley of Achor for a door of hope: and she shall sing there, as in the days of her youth, and as in the day when she came up out of the land of Egypt.
- Egypt <u>28\_HOS\_07\_16</u> # They return, [but] not to the most High: they are like a deceitful bow: their princes shall fall by the sword for the rage of their tongue: this [shall be] their derision in the land of Egypt.
- Egypt <u>28\_HOS\_08\_13</u> # They sacrifice flesh [for] the sacrifices of mine offerings, and eat [it; but] the LORD accepteth them not; now will he remember their iniquity, and visit their sins: they shall return to Egypt.
- Egypt 28\_HOS\_11\_01 # When Israel [was] a child, then I loved him, and called my son out of Egypt.
- Egypt <u>28\_HOS\_12\_01</u># Ephraim feedeth on wind, and followeth after the east wind: he daily increaseth lies and desolation; and they do make a covenant with the Assyrians, and oil is carried into Egypt.
- Egypt <u>23\_ISA\_10\_24</u> # Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD of hosts, O my people that dwellest in Zion, be not afraid of the Assyrian: he shall smite thee with a rod, and shall lift up his staff against thee, after the manner of Egypt.
- Egypt 23\_ISA\_10\_26 # And the LORD of hosts shall stir up a scourge for him according to the slaughter of Midian at the rock of Oreb: and [as] his rod [was] upon the sea, so shall he lift it up after the manner of Egypt.
- Egypt <u>23\_ISA\_11\_16</u># And there shall be an highway for the remnant of his people, which shall be left, from Assyria; like as it was to Israel in the day that he came up out of the land of Egypt.
- Egypt 23\_ISA\_19\_12 # Where [are] they? where [are] thy wise [men]? and let them tell thee now, and let them know what the LORD of hosts hath purposed upon Egypt.
- Egypt <u>23\_ISA\_20\_04</u> # So shall the king of Assyria lead away the Egyptians prisoners, and the Ethiopians captives, young and old, naked and barefoot, even with [their] buttocks uncovered, to the shame of Egypt.

Egypt <u>23\_ISA\_30\_02</u># That walk to go down into Egypt, and have not asked at my mouth; to strengthen themselves in the strength of Pharaoh, and to trust in the shadow of Egypt!

Egypt <u>24\_JER\_16\_14</u># Therefore, behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that it shall no more be said, The LORD liveth, that brought up the children of Israel out of the land of Egypt;

Egypt <u>24\_JER\_23\_07</u># Therefore, behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that they shall no more say, The LORD liveth, which brought up the children of Israel out of the land of Egypt;

Egypt 24\_JER\_24\_08 # And as the evil figs, which cannot be eaten, they are so evil; surely thus saith the LORD, So will I give Zedekiah the king of Judah, and his princes, and the residue of Jerusalem, that remain in this land, and them that dwell in the land of Egypt:

Egypt 24 JER 26 21 # And when Jehoiakim the king, with all his mighty men, and all the princes, heard his words, the king sought to put him to death: but when Urijah heard it, he was afraid, and fled, and went into Egypt;

Egypt 24\_JER\_26\_22 # And Jehoiakim the king sent men into Egypt, [namely], Elnathan the son of Achbor, and [certain] men with him into Egypt.

Egypt <u>24\_JER\_41\_17</u> # And they departed, and dwelt in the habitation of Chimham, which is by Bethlehem, to go to enter into Egypt,

Egypt <u>06\_JOS\_05\_04</u> # And this [is] the cause why Joshua did circumcise: All the people that came out of Egypt, [that were] males, [even] all the men of war, died in the wilderness by the way, after they came out of Egypt.

Egypt <u>06\_JOS\_09\_09</u> # And they said unto him, From a very far country thy servants are come because of the name of the LORD thy God: for we have heard the fame of him, and all that he did in Egypt,

Egypt <u>06\_JOS\_24\_04</u> # And I gave unto Isaac Jacob and Esau: and I gave unto Esau mount Seir, to possess it; but Jacob and his children went down into Egypt.

Egypt <u>03\_LEV\_19\_36</u># Just balances, just weights, a just ephah, and a just hin, shall ye have: I [am] the LORD your God, which brought you out of the land of Egypt.

Egypt <u>40\_MAT\_02\_14</u># When he arose, he took the young child and his mother by night, and departed into Egypt:

Egypt <u>40\_MAT\_02\_19</u># But when Herod was dead, behold, an angel of the Lord appeareth in a dream to Joseph in Egypt,

Egypt <u>04\_NUM\_11\_20</u># [But] even a whole month, until it come out at your nostrils, and it be loathsome unto you: because that ye have despised the LORD which [is] among you, and have wept before him, saying, Why came we forth out of Egypt?

Egypt <u>04\_NUM\_13\_22</u> # And they ascended by the south, and came unto Hebron; where Ahiman, Sheshai, and Talmai, the children of Anak, [were]. [Now Hebron was built seven years before Zoan in Egypt.]

Egypt <u>04\_NUM\_14\_03</u> # And wherefore hath the LORD brought us unto this land, to fall by the sword, that our wives and our children should be a prey? were it not better for us to return into Egypt?

Egypt 04\_NUM\_14\_04 # And they said one to another, Let us make a captain, and let us return into Egypt.

Egypt <u>04\_NUM\_26\_04</u> # [Take the sum of the people], from twenty years old and upward; as the LORD commanded Moses and the children of Israel, which went forth out of the land of Egypt.

Egypt <u>20\_PRO\_07\_16</u># I have decked my bed with coverings of tapestry, with carved [works], with fine linen of Egypt.

Egypt 19\_PSA\_106\_21 # They forgat God their saviour, which had done great things in Egypt;

Egyptian a goodly <u>10\_2SA\_23\_21</u># And he slew an Egyptian, a goodly man: and the Egyptian had a spear in his hand; but he went down to him with a staff, and plucked the spear out of the Egyptian's hand, and slew him with his own spear.

Egyptian a man 13 1CH 11 23 # And he slew an Egyptian, a man of [great] stature, five cubits high; and in the Egyptian's hand [was] a spear like a weaver's beam; and he went down to him with a staff, and plucked the spear out of the Egyptian's hand, and slew him with his own spear.

Egyptian after Abram <u>01\_GEN\_16\_03</u> # And Sarai Abram's wife took Hagar her maid the Egyptian, after Abram had dwelt ten years in the land of Canaan, and gave her to her husband Abram to be his wife.

Egyptian and hid <u>02\_EXO\_02\_12</u># And he looked this way and that way, and when he saw that [there was] no man, he slew the Egyptian, and hid him in the sand.

Egyptian delivered us <u>02\_EXO\_02\_19</u> # And they said, An Egyptian delivered us out of the hand of the shepherds, and also drew [water] enough for us, and watered the flock.

Egyptian had a 10\_2SA\_23\_21 # And he slew an Egyptian, a goodly man: and the Egyptian had a spear in his hand; but he went down to him with a staff, and plucked the spear out of the Egyptian's hand, and slew him with his own spear.

Egyptian in the <u>09\_1SA\_30\_11</u># And they found an Egyptian in the field, and brought him to David, and gave him bread, and he did eat; and they made him drink water;

Egyptian into Assyria 23 ISA 19 23 # In that day shall there be a highway out of Egypt to Assyria, and the Assyrian shall come into Egypt, and the Egyptian into Assyria, and the Egyptians shall serve with the Assyrians.

Egyptian Sarah's handmaid <u>01\_GEN\_25\_12</u> # Now these [are] the generations of Ishmael, Abraham's son, whom Hagar the Egyptian, Sarah's handmaid, bare unto Abraham:

Egyptian sea and 23 ISA 11 15 # And the LORD shall utterly destroy the tongue of the Egyptian sea; and with his mighty wind shall he shake his hand over the river, and shall smite it in the seven streams, and make [men] go over dryshod.

Egyptian smiting an <u>02\_EXO\_02\_11</u># And it came to pass in those days, when Moses was grown, that he went out unto his brethren, and looked on their burdens: and he spied an Egyptian smiting an Hebrew, one of his brethren.

Egyptian whose name 13\_1CH\_02\_34 # Now Sheshan had no sons, but daughters. And Sheshan had a servant, an Egyptian, whose name [was] Jarha.

Egyptian whose name <u>01\_GEN\_16\_01</u> # Now Sarai Abram's wife bare him no children: and she had an handmaid, an Egyptian, whose name [was] Hagar.

Egyptian women for <u>02\_EXO\_01\_19</u># And the midwives said unto Pharaoh, Because the Hebrew women [are] not as the Egyptian women; for they [are] lively, and are delivered ere the midwives come in unto them.

Egyptian yesterday 44\_ACT\_07\_28 # Wilt thou kill me, as thou diddest the Egyptian yesterday?

Egyptian <u>44\_ACT\_07\_24</u> # And seeing one [of them] suffer wrong, he defended [him], and avenged him that was oppressed, and smote the Egyptian:

Egyptian <u>01\_GEN\_39\_02</u># And the LORD was with Joseph, and he was a prosperous man; and he was in the house of his master the Egyptian.

Egyptians buried all <u>04\_NUM\_33\_04</u> # For the Egyptians buried all [their] firstborn, which the LORD had smitten among them: upon their gods also the LORD executed judgments.

Egyptians came unto <u>01\_GEN\_47\_15</u># And when money failed in the land of Egypt, and in the land of Canaan, all the Egyptians came unto Joseph, and said, Give us bread: for why should we die in thy presence? for the money faileth.

Egyptians could not <u>02\_EXO\_07\_21</u> # And the fish that [was] in the river died; and the river stank, and the Egyptians could not drink of the water of the river; and there was blood throughout all the land of Egypt.

Egyptians dead upon <u>02\_EXO\_14\_30</u># Thus the LORD saved Israel that day out of the hand of the Egyptians; and Israel saw the Egyptians dead upon the sea shore.

Egyptians may know <u>02\_EXO\_14\_04</u># And I will harden Pharaoh's heart, that he shall follow after them; and I will be honoured upon Pharaoh, and upon all his host; that the Egyptians may know that I [am] the LORD. And they did so.

Egyptians shall he <u>24\_JER\_43\_13</u># He shall break also the images of Bethshemesh, that [is] in the land of Egypt; and the houses of the gods of the Egyptians shall he burn with fire.

Egyptians shall hear <u>04\_NUM\_14\_13</u> # And Moses said unto the LORD, Then the Egyptians shall hear [it], [for thou broughtest up this people in thy might from among them;]

Egyptians shall help 23\_ISA\_30\_07 # For the Egyptians shall help in vain, and to no purpose: therefore

have I cried concerning this, Their strength [is] to sit still.

Egyptians shall know <u>02\_EXO\_07\_05</u> # And the Egyptians shall know that I [am] the LORD, when I stretch forth mine hand upon Egypt, and bring out the children of Israel from among them.

Egyptians shall know <u>02\_EXO\_14\_18</u># And the Egyptians shall know that I [am] the LORD, when I have gotten me honour upon Pharaoh, upon his chariots, and upon his horsemen.

Egyptians shall know 23\_ISA\_19\_21 # And the LORD shall be known to Egypt, and the Egyptians shall know the LORD in that day, and shall do sacrifice and oblation; yea, they shall vow a vow unto the LORD, and perform [it].

Egyptians shall loathe <u>02\_EXO\_07\_18</u># And the fish that [is] in the river shall die, and the river shall stink; and the Egyptians shall loathe to drink of the water of the river.

Egyptians vexed us <u>04\_NUM\_20\_15</u># How our fathers went down into Egypt, and we have dwelt in Egypt a long time; and the Egyptians vexed us, and our fathers:

Egyptians were urgent <u>02\_EXO\_12\_33</u># And the Egyptians were urgent upon the people, that they might send them out of the land in haste; for they said, We [be] all dead [men].

Egyptians wherefore the <u>01\_GEN\_50\_11</u># And when the inhabitants of the land, the Canaanites, saw the mourning in the floor of Atad, they said, This [is] a grievous mourning to the Egyptians: wherefore the name of it was called Abelmizraim, which [is] beyond Jordan.

Egyptians which did <u>01\_GEN\_43\_32</u># And they set on for him by himself, and for them by themselves, and for the Egyptians, which did eat with him, by themselves: because the Egyptians might not eat bread with the Hebrews; for that [is] an abomination unto the Egyptians.

Egyptians which neither <u>02\_EXO\_10\_06</u># And they shall fill thy houses, and the houses of all thy servants, and the houses of all the Egyptians; which neither thy fathers, nor thy fathers' fathers have seen, since the day that they were upon the earth unto this day. And he turned himself, and went out from Pharaoh.

Egyptians whom ye <u>02\_EXO\_14\_13</u># And Moses said unto the people, Fear ye not, stand still, and see the salvation of the LORD, which he will show to you to day: for the Egyptians whom ye have seen to day, ye shall see them again no more for ever.

Egyptians will I <u>23\_ISA\_19\_04</u> # And the Egyptians will I give over into the hand of a cruel lord; and a fierce king shall rule over them, saith the Lord, the LORD of hosts.

Egyptians with all <u>09\_1SA\_04\_08</u># Woe unto us! who shall deliver us out of the hand of these mighty Gods? these [are] the Gods that smote the Egyptians with all the plagues in the wilderness.

Egyptians <u>02\_EXO\_03\_22</u># But every woman shall borrow of her neighbour, and of her that sojourneth in her house, jewels of silver, and jewels of gold, and raiment: and ye shall put [them] upon your sons, and upon your daughters; and ye shall spoil the Egyptians.

Egyptians <u>02\_EXO\_06\_07</u># And I will take you to me for a people, and I will be to you a God: and ye shall know that I [am] the LORD your God, which bringeth you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians.

Egyptians <u>02\_EXO\_09\_11</u># And the magicians could not stand before Moses because of the boils; for the boil was upon the magicians, and upon all the Egyptians.

Egyptians <u>02\_EXO\_12\_36</u># And the LORD gave the people favour in the sight of the Egyptians, so that they lent unto them [such things as they required]. And they spoiled the Egyptians.

Egyptians <u>02\_EXO\_14\_24</u># And it came to pass, that in the morning watch the LORD looked unto the host of the Egyptians through the pillar of fire and of the cloud, and troubled the host of the Egyptians,

Egyptians <u>02\_EXO\_14\_25</u> # And took off their chariot wheels, that they drave them heavily: so that the Egyptians said, Let us flee from the face of Israel; for the LORD fighteth for them against the Egyptians.

Egyptians <u>02\_EXO\_18\_09</u> # And Jethro rejoiced for all the goodness which the LORD had done to Israel, whom he had delivered out of the hand of the Egyptians.

Egyptians <u>02\_EXO\_18\_10</u> # And Jethro said, Blessed [be] the LORD, who hath delivered you out of the hand of the Egyptians, and out of the hand of Pharaoh, who hath delivered the people from under the hand of the Egyptians.

Egyptians <u>01\_GEN\_43\_32</u># And they set on for him by himself, and for them by themselves, and for the Egyptians, which did eat with him, by themselves: because the Egyptians might not eat bread with the Hebrews; for that [is] an abomination unto the Egyptians.

Egyptians <u>01\_GEN\_46\_34</u># That ye shall say, Thy servants' trade hath been about cattle from our youth even until now, both we, [and] also our fathers: that ye may dwell in the land of Goshen; for every shepherd

[is] an abomination unto the Egyptians.

Egyptians <u>04\_NUM\_33\_03</u># And they departed from Rameses in the first month, on the fifteenth day of the first month; on the morrow after the passover the children of Israel went out with an high hand in the sight of all the Egyptians.
