Elishama and Jehoram 14\_2CH\_17\_08 # And with them [he sent] Levites, [even] Shemaiah, and Nethaniah, and Zebadiah, and Asahel, and Shemiramoth, and Jehonathan, and Adonijah, and Tobijah, and Tobadonijah, Levites; and with them Elishama and Jehoram, priests.

Elishama his son 13\_1CH\_07\_26 # Laadan his son, Ammihud his son, Elishama his son,

Elishama of the 12\_2KI\_25\_25# But it came to pass in the seventh month, that Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, the son of Elishama, of the seed royal, came, and ten men with him, and smote Gedaliah, that he died, and the Jews and the Chaldees that were with him at Mizpah.
