eaten up Jacob <u>24 JER\_10\_25</u># Pour out thy fury upon the heathen that know thee not, and upon the families that call not on thy name: for they have eaten up Jacob, and devoured him, and consumed him, and have made his habitation desolate.

eaten up the <u>26\_EZE\_34\_18</u> # [Seemeth it] a small thing unto you to have eaten up the good pasture, but ye must tread down with your feet the residue of your pastures? and to have drunk of the deep waters, but ye must foul the residue with your feet?

eaten up the <u>01\_GEN\_43\_02</u> # And it came to pass, when they had eaten up the corn which they had brought out of Egypt, their father said unto them, Go again, buy us a little food.

eaten up the <u>23\_ISA\_03\_14</u> # The LORD will enter into judgment with the ancients of his people, and the princes thereof: for ye have eaten up the vineyard; the spoil of the poor [is] in your houses.

eaten up ye <u>03\_LEV\_22\_30</u> # On the same day it shall be eaten up; ye shall leave none of it until the morrow: I [am] the LORD.

eaten upon the <u>26\_EZE\_18\_06</u> # [And] hath not eaten upon the mountains, neither hath lifted up his eyes to the idols of the house of Israel, neither hath defiled his neighbour's wife, neither hath come near to a menstruous woman,

eaten upon the <u>26\_EZE\_18\_11</u> # And that doeth not any of those [duties], but even hath eaten upon the mountains, and defiled his neighbour's wife,

eaten upon the <u>26\_EZE\_18\_15</u> # [That] hath not eaten upon the mountains, neither hath lifted up his eyes to the idols of the house of Israel, hath not defiled his neighbour's wife,

eaten were about 41\_MAR\_08\_09 # And they that had eaten were about four thousand: and he sent them away.

eaten were about 40\_MAT\_14\_21# And they that had eaten were about five thousand men, beside women and children.

eaten without salt <u>18\_JOB\_06\_06</u> # Can that which is unsavoury be eaten without salt? or is there [any] taste in the white of an egg?

eaten 05\_DEU\_14\_19 # And every creeping thing that flieth [is] unclean unto you: they shall not be eaten.

eaten <u>02\_EXO\_13\_03</u># And Moses said unto the people, Remember this day, in which ye came out from Egypt, out of the house of bondage; for by strength of hand the LORD brought you out from this [place]: there shall no leavened bread be eaten.

eaten <u>26\_EZE\_45\_21</u> # In the first [month], in the fourteenth day of the month, ye shall have the passover, a feast of seven days; unleavened bread shall be eaten.

eaten <u>01\_GEN\_31\_38</u># This twenty years [have] I [been] with thee; thy ewes and thy she goats have not cast their young, and the rams of thy flock have I not eaten.

eaten 18\_JOB\_13\_28 # And he, as a rotten thing, consumeth, as a garment that is moth eaten.

eaten <u>29\_JOE\_01\_04</u># That which the palmerworm hath left hath the locust eaten; and that which the locust hath left hath the cankerworm eaten; and that which the cankerworm hath left hath the caterpillar eaten.

eaten <u>43\_JOH\_06\_13</u> # Therefore they gathered [them] together, and filled twelve baskets with the fragments of the five barley loaves, which remained over and above unto them that had eaten.

eaten <u>03\_LEV\_06\_23</u> # For every meat offering for the priest shall be wholly burnt: it shall not be eaten.

eaten <u>03\_LEV\_07\_16</u> # But if the sacrifice of his offering [be] a vow, or a voluntary offering, it shall be eaten the same day that he offereth his sacrifice: and on the morrow also the remainder of it shall be eaten:

eaten <u>03\_LEV\_11\_41</u># And every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth [shall be] an abomination; it shall not be eaten.

motheaten 59\_JAM\_05\_02 # Your riches are corrupted, and your garments are motheaten.

threaten them that <u>44\_ACT\_04\_17</u># But that it spread no further among the people, let us straitly threaten them, that they speak henceforth to no man in this name.

threatened not but 60\_1PE\_02\_23 # Who, when he was reviled, reviled not again; when he suffered, he threatened not; but committed [himself] to him that judgeth righteously:

threatened them they <u>44\_ACT\_04\_21</u># So when they had further threatened them, they let them go, finding nothing how they might punish them, because of the people: for all [men] glorified God for that which was done.

threatening knowing that <u>49\_EPH\_06\_09</u> # And, ye masters, do the same things unto them, forbearing threatening: knowing that your Master also is in heaven; neither is there respect of persons with him.

threatenings and grant <u>44\_ACT\_04\_29</u> # And now, Lord, behold their threatenings: and grant unto thy servants, that with all boldness they may speak thy word,

threatenings and slaughter <u>44\_ACT\_09\_01</u> # And Saul, yet breathing out threatenings and slaughter against the disciples of the Lord, went unto the high priest,

wheaten flour shalt <u>02\_EXO\_29\_02</u> # And unleavened bread, and cakes unleavened tempered with oil, and wafers unleavened anointed with oil: [of] wheaten flour shalt thou make them.
