edges of a [07 JUD 03 16](#) # But Ehud made him a dagger which had two edges, of a cubit length; and he did gird it under his raiment upon his right thigh.

edges thereof and [02 EXO 28 07](#) # It shall have the two shoulder pieces thereof joined at the two edges thereof; and [so] it shall be joined together.

edges was it [02 EXO 39 04](#) # They made shoulderpieces for it, to couple [it] together: by the two edges was it coupled together.

edges [66 REV 02 12](#) # And to the angel of the church in Pergamos write; These things saith he which hath the sharp sword with two edges;

hedges and compel [42 LUK 14 23](#) # And the lord said unto the servant, Go out into the highways and hedges, and compel [them] to come in, that my house may be filled.

hedges for their [24 JER 49 03](#) # Howl, O Heshbon, for Ai is spoiled: cry, ye daughters of Rabbah, gird you with sackcloth; lament, and run to and fro by the hedges; for their king shall go into captivity, [and] his priests and his princes together.

hedges there they [13 1CH 04 23](#) # These [were] the potters, and those that dwelt among plants and hedges: there they dwelt with the king for his work.

hedges thou hast [19 PSA 89 40](#) # Thou hast broken down all his hedges; thou hast brought his strong holds to ruin.
