condescend to men <u>45\_ROM\_12\_16</u> # [Be] of the same mind one toward another. Mind not high things, but condescend to men of low estate. Be not wise in your own conceits.

contend by fire 30\_AMO\_07\_04 # Thus hath the Lord GOD showed unto me: and, behold, the Lord GOD called to contend by fire, and it devoured the great deep, and did eat up a part.

contend for ever <u>23\_ISA\_57\_16</u> # For I will not contend for ever, neither will I be always wroth: for the spirit should fail before me, and the souls [which] I have made.

contend for God 18\_JOB\_13\_08 # Will ye accept his person? will ye contend for God?

contend for the <u>65\_JDE\_01\_03</u># Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort [you] that ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints.

send the multitude <u>40\_MAT\_14\_15</u># And when it was evening, his disciples came to him, saying, This is a desert place, and the time is now past; send the multitude away, that they may go into the villages, and buy themselves victuals.

send the pestilence <u>03\_LEV\_26\_25</u> # And I will bring a sword upon you, that shall avenge the quarrel of [my] covenant: and when ye are gathered together within your cities, I will send the pestilence among you; and ye shall be delivered into the hand of the enemy.

send the promise <u>42\_LUK\_24\_49</u># And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high.

send thee and <u>09\_1SA\_21\_02</u># And David said unto Ahimelech the priest, The king hath commanded me a business, and hath said unto me, Let no man know any thing of the business whereabout I send thee, and what I have commanded thee: and I have appointed [my] servants to such and such a place.

send thee and 24\_JER\_01\_07 # But the LORD said unto me, Say not, I [am] a child: for thou shalt go to all that I shall send thee, and whatsoever I command thee thou shalt speak.

send thee away 11 1KI 20 34 # And [Benhadad] said unto him, The cities, which my father took from thy father, I will restore; and thou shalt make streets for thee in Damascus, as my father made in Samaria. Send thou men <u>04\_NUM\_13\_02</u> # Send thou men, that they may search the land of Canaan, which I give unto the children of Israel: of every tribe of their fathers shall ye send a man, every one a ruler among them.

send thunder and <u>09\_1SA\_12\_17</u> # [Is it] not wheat harvest to day? I will call unto the LORD, and he shall send thunder and rain; that ye may perceive and see that your wickedness [is] great, which ye have done in the sight of the LORD, in asking you a king.

send thy messengers <u>23\_ISA\_57\_09</u> # And thou wentest to the king with ointment, and didst increase thy perfumes, and didst send thy messengers far off, and didst debase [thyself even] unto hell.

send unto him 41\_MAR\_12\_13# And they send unto him certain of the Pharisees and of the Herodians, to catch him in [his] words.

send you Elijah <u>39\_MAL\_04\_05</u> # Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the LORD:

send you forth 42\_LUK\_10\_03 # Go your ways: behold, I send you forth as lambs among wolves.

send you forth <u>40\_MAT\_10\_16</u># Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore wise as serpents, and harmless as doves.

send <u>09 18A 25 25</u> # Let not my lord, I pray thee, regard this man of Belial, [even] Nabal: for as his name [is], so [is] he; Nabal [is] his name, and folly [is] with him: but I thine handmaid saw not the young men of my lord, whom thou didst send.

sendeth an ambassage <u>42\_LUK\_14\_32</u> # Or else, while the other is yet a great way off, he sendeth an ambassage, and desireth conditions of peace.

sendeth forth his <u>19\_PSA\_147\_15</u># He sendeth forth his commandment [upon] earth: his word runneth very swiftly.

sendeth forth the <u>22\_SON\_01\_12</u># While the king [sitteth] at his table, my spikenard sendeth forth the smell thereof.

sendeth forth two 41\_MAR\_11\_01# And when they came nigh to Jerusalem, unto Bethphage and Bethany, at the mount of Olives, he sendeth forth two of his disciples,

sendeth greeting <u>44\_ACT\_23\_26</u> # Claudius Lysias unto the most excellent governor Felix [sendeth] greeting.

sendeth her out <u>05\_DEU\_24\_03</u> # And [if] the latter husband hate her, and write her a bill of divorcement, and giveth [it] in her hand, and sendeth her out of his house; or if the latter husband die, which took her [to be] his wife;

spend our years 19\_PSA\_90\_09 # For all our days are passed away in thy wrath: we spend our years as a tale [that is told].

spend the time 44\_ACT\_20\_16 # For Paul had determined to sail by Ephesus, because he would not spend the time in Asia: for he hasted, if it were possible for him, to be at Jerusalem the day of Pentecost.

spend their days 18\_JOB\_21\_13 # They spend their days in wealth, and in a moment go down to the grave.

spend their days <u>18\_JOB\_36\_11</u># If they obey and serve [him], they shall spend their days in prosperity, and their years in pleasures.

spendest more when <u>42 LUK 10 35 #</u> And on the morrow when he departed, he took out two pence, and gave [them] to the host, and said unto him, Take care of him; and whatsoever thou spendest more, when I come again, I will repay thee.

spendeth as a 21\_ECC\_06\_12 # For who knoweth what [is] good for man in [this] life, all the days of his vain life which he spendeth as a shadow? for who can tell a man what shall be after him under the sun?

spendeth his substance <u>20\_PRO\_29\_03</u># Whoso loveth wisdom rejoiceth his father: but he that keepeth company with harlots spendeth [his] substance.

spendeth it up <u>20\_PRO\_21\_20</u> # [There is] treasure to be desired and oil in the dwelling of the wise; but a foolish man spendeth it up.

tender among you <u>05 DEU 28\_54</u> # [So that] the man [that is] tender among you, and very delicate, his eye shall be evil toward his brother, and toward the wife of his bosom, and toward the remnant of his children which he shall leave:

tender and delicate <u>05\_DEU\_28\_56</u># The tender and delicate woman among you, which would not adventure to set the sole of her foot upon the ground for delicateness and tenderness, her eye shall be evil toward the husband of her bosom, and toward her son, and toward her daughter,

tender and delicate <u>23\_ISA\_47\_01</u> # Come down, and sit in the dust, O virgin daughter of Babylon, sit on the ground: [there is] no throne, O daughter of the Chaldeans: for thou shalt no more be called tender and delicate.

tender eyed but 01\_GEN\_29\_17 # Leah [was] tender eyed; but Rachel was beautiful and well favoured.

tender grape appear 22\_SON\_07\_12 # Let us get up early to the vineyards; let us see if the vine flourish, [whether] the tender grape appear, [and] the pomegranates bud forth: there will I give thee my loves.

tender grape give <u>22\_SON\_02\_13</u> # The fig tree putteth forth her green figs, and the vines [with] the tender grape give a [good] smell. Arise, my love, my fair one, and come away.

tender mercies O <u>19\_PSA\_119\_156</u># Great [are] thy tender mercies, O LORD: quicken me according to thy judgments.

tendeth to life <u>20\_PRO\_11\_19</u> # As righteousness [tendeth] to life: so he that pursueth evil [pursueth it] to his own death.

tendeth to life 20\_PRO\_19\_23 # The fear of the LORD [tendeth] to life: and [he that hath it] shall abide satisfied; he shall not be visited with evil.

tendeth to poverty <u>20\_PRO\_11\_24</u># There is that scattereth, and yet increaseth; and [there is] that withholdeth more than is meet, but [it tendeth] to poverty.
