apprehended but this <u>50\_PHP\_03\_13</u># Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but [this] one thing [I do], forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before,

apprehended him he <u>44\_ACT\_12\_04</u># And when he had apprehended him, he put [him] in prison, and delivered [him] to four quaternions of soldiers to keep him; intending after Easter to bring him forth to the people.

apprehended of Christ 50\_PHP\_03\_12 # Not as though I had already attained, either were already perfect: but I follow after, if that I may apprehend that for which also I am apprehended of Christ Jesus.

ascended as the <u>02\_EXO\_19\_18</u># And mount Sinai was altogether on a smoke, because the LORD descended upon it in fire: and the smoke thereof ascended as the smoke of a furnace, and the whole mount quaked greatly.

ascended from Gilgal <u>06\_JOS\_10\_07</u> # So Joshua ascended from Gilgal, he, and all the people of war with him, and all the mighty men of valour.

ascended in the <u>07\_JUD\_13\_20</u># For it came to pass, when the flame went up toward heaven from off the altar, that the angel of the LORD ascended in the flame of the altar. And Manoah and his wife looked on [it], and fell on their faces to the ground.

ascended up far <u>49\_EPH\_04\_10</u># He that descended is the same also that ascended up far above all heavens, that he might fill all things.]

ascended up into 20\_PRO\_30\_04 # Who hath ascended up into heaven, or descended? who hath gathered the wind in his fists? who hath bound the waters in a garment? who hath established all the ends of the earth? what [is] his name, and what [is] his son's name, if thou canst tell?

ascended up on 49\_EPH\_04\_08 # Wherefore he saith, When he ascended up on high, he led captivity captive, and gave gifts unto men.

ascended up on <u>06\_JOS\_15\_03</u># And it went out to the south side to Maalehacrabbim, and passed along to Zin, and ascended up on the south side unto Kadeshbarnea, and passed along to Hezron, and went up to Adar, and fetched a compass to Karkaa:

commended her before <u>01\_GEN\_12\_15</u> # The princes also of Pharaoh saw her, and commended her before Pharaoh: and the woman was taken into Pharaoh's house.

commended mirth because <u>21\_ECC\_08\_15</u># Then I commended mirth, because a man hath no better thing under the sun, than to eat, and to drink, and to be merry: for that shall abide with him of his labour the days of his life, which God giveth him under the sun.

commended of you <u>47\_2CO\_12\_11</u># I am become a fool in glorying; ye have compelled me: for I ought to have been commended of you: for in nothing am I behind the very chiefest apostles, though I be nothing.

commended the unjust <u>42\_LUK\_16\_08</u># And the lord commended the unjust steward, because he had done wisely: for the children of this world are in their generation wiser than the children of light.

commended them to <u>44\_ACT\_14\_23</u> # And when they had ordained them elders in every church, and had prayed with fasting, they commended them to the Lord, on whom they believed.

comprehended in this <u>45\_ROM\_13\_09</u># For this, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not kill, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Thou shalt not covet; and if [there be] any other commandment, it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

contended I with <u>16\_NEH\_13\_11</u># Then contended I with the rulers, and said, Why is the house of God forsaken? And I gathered them together, and set them in their place.

contended with him <u>44\_ACT\_11\_02</u># And when Peter was come up to Jerusalem, they that were of the circumcision contended with him,

contended with me <u>18\_JOB\_31\_13</u> # If I did despise the cause of my manservant or of my maidservant, when they contended with me;

descended with the <u>44\_ACT\_24\_01</u># And after five days Ananias the high priest descended with the elders, and [with] a certain orator [named] Tertullus, who informed the governor against Paul.

ended all his <u>42\_LUK\_07\_01</u># Now when he had ended all his sayings in the audience of the people, he entered into Capernaum.

ended all my <u>08\_RUT\_02\_21</u> # And Ruth the Moabitess said, He said unto me also, Thou shalt keep fast by my young men, until they have ended all my harvest.

ended all the <u>11\_1KI\_07\_51</u># So was ended all the work that king Solomon made for the house of the LORD. And Solomon brought in the things which David his father had dedicated; [even] the silver, and the

ended all the <u>42\_LUK\_04\_13</u># And when the devil had ended all the temptation, he departed from him for a season.

ended and until 14\_2CH\_29\_34 # But the priests were too few, so that they could not flay all the burnt offerings: wherefore their brethren the Levites did help them, till the work was ended, and until the [other] priests had sanctified themselves: for the Levites [were] more upright in heart to sanctify themselves than the priests.

ended and we 24\_JER\_08\_20 # The harvest is past, the summer is ended, and we are not saved.

ended he afterward <u>42\_LUK\_04\_02</u># Being forty days tempted of the devil. And in those days he did eat nothing: and when they were ended, he afterward hungered.

ended his work <u>01\_GEN\_02\_02</u># And on the seventh day God ended his work which he had made; and he rested on the seventh day from all his work which he had made.

ended Paul purposed <u>44\_ACT\_19\_21</u># After these things were ended, Paul purposed in the spirit, when he had passed through Macedonia and Achaia, to go to Jerusalem, saying, After I have been there, I must also see Rome.

ended the days <u>26\_EZE\_04\_08</u># And, behold, I will lay bands upon thee, and thou shalt not turn thee from one side to another, till thou hast ended the days of thy siege.

ended <u>18\_JOB\_31\_40</u># Let thistles grow instead of wheat, and cockle instead of barley. The words of Job are ended.

ended 19\_PSA\_72\_20 # The prayers of David the son of Jesse are ended.

extended mercy unto <u>15 EZR 07 28 #</u> And hath extended mercy unto me before the king, and his counsellors, and before all the king's mighty princes. And I was strengthened as the hand of the LORD my God [was] upon me, and I gathered together out of Israel chief men to go up with me.

extended mercy unto <u>15\_EZR\_09\_09</u># For we [were] bondmen; yet our God hath not forsaken us in our bondage, but hath extended mercy unto us in the sight of the kings of Persia, to give us a reviving, to set up the house of our God, and to repair the desolations thereof, and to give us a wall in Judah and in Jerusalem.

intended evil against 19 PSA 21 11 # For they intended evil against thee: they imagined a mischievous device, [which] they are not able [to perform].

offended after they <u>40\_MAT\_15\_12</u># Then came his disciples, and said unto him, Knowest thou that the Pharisees were offended, after they heard this saying?

offended against the <u>14\_2CH\_28\_13</u># And said unto them, Ye shall not bring in the captives hither: for whereas we have offended against the LORD [already], ye intend to add [more] to our sins and to our trespass: for our trespass is great, and [there is] fierce wrath against Israel.

offended against thee <u>24\_JER\_37\_18</u> # Moreover Jeremiah said unto king Zedekiah, What have I offended against thee, or against thy servants, or against this people, that ye have put me in prison?

offended and I 47\_2CO\_11\_29 # Who is weak, and I am not weak? who is offended, and I burn not?

offended and revenged <u>26\_EZE\_25\_12</u># Thus saith the Lord GOD; Because that Edom hath dealt against the house of Judah by taking vengeance, and hath greatly offended, and revenged himself upon them;

offended and shall <u>40\_MAT\_24\_10</u># And then shall many be offended, and shall betray one another, and shall hate one another.

offended any thing 44\_ACT\_25\_08 # While he answered for himself, Neither against the law of the Jews, neither against the temple, nor yet against Caesar, have I offended any thing at all.

offended at him <u>41\_MAR\_06\_03</u># Is not this the carpenter, the son of Mary, the brother of James, and Joses, and of Juda, and Simon? and are not his sisters here with us? And they were offended at him.

offended because of 41\_MAR\_14\_27 # And Jesus saith unto them, All ye shall be offended because of me this night: for it is written, I will smite the shepherd, and the sheep shall be scattered.

offended because of 40\_MAT\_26\_31# Then saith Jesus unto them, All ye shall be offended because of me this night: for it is written, I will smite the shepherd, and the sheep of the flock shall be scattered abroad.

offended because of <u>40\_MAT\_26\_33</u># Peter answered and said unto him, Though all [men] shall be offended because of thee, [yet] will I never be offended.

offended in Baal <u>28\_HOS\_13\_01</u> # When Ephraim spake trembling, he exalted himself in Israel; but when he offended in Baal, he died.

offended in him <u>40\_MAT\_13\_57</u># And they were offended in him. But Jesus said unto them, A prophet is not without honour, save in his own country, and in his own house.

offended in me 42\_LUK\_07\_23 # And blessed is [he], whosoever shall not be offended in me.

offended in me 40\_MAT\_11\_06# And blessed is [he], whosoever shall not be offended in me.

offended is harder <u>20\_PRO\_18\_19</u> # A brother offended [is harder to be won] than a strong city: and [their] contentions [are] like the bars of a castle.

offended or is <u>45\_ROM\_14\_21</u> # [It is] good neither to eat flesh, nor to drink wine, nor [any thing] whereby thy brother stumbleth, or is offended, or is made weak.

offended return from 12\_2KI\_18\_14 # And Hezekiah king of Judah sent to the king of Assyria to Lachish, saying, I have offended; return from me: that which thou puttest on me will I bear. And the king of Assyria appointed unto Hezekiah king of Judah three hundred talents of silver and thirty talents of gold.

offended thee that <u>01\_GEN\_20\_09</u> # Then Abimelech called Abraham, and said unto him, What hast thou done unto us? and what have I offended thee, that thou hast brought on me and on my kingdom a great sin? thou hast done deeds unto me that ought not to be done.

offended their lord <u>01\_GEN\_40\_01</u> # And it came to pass after these things, [that] the butler of the king of Egypt and [his] baker had offended their lord the king of Egypt.

offended yet will 41\_MAR\_14\_29 # But Peter said unto him, Although all shall be offended, yet [will] not I.

offended 43\_JOH\_16\_01 # These things have I spoken unto you, that ye should not be offended.

offended <u>41\_MAR\_04\_17</u> # And have no root in themselves, and so endure but for a time: afterward, when affliction or persecution ariseth for the word's sake, immediately they are offended.

offended <u>40\_MAT\_13\_21</u># Yet hath he not root in himself, but dureth for a while: for when tribulation or persecution ariseth because of the word, by and by he is offended.

offended <u>40\_MAT\_26\_33</u># Peter answered and said unto him, Though all [men] shall be offended because of thee, [yet] will I never be offended.

recommended by the <u>44\_ACT\_15\_40</u># And Paul chose Silas, and departed, being recommended by the brethren unto the grace of God.

recommended to the <u>44\_ACT\_14\_26</u># And thence sailed to Antioch, from whence they had been recommended to the grace of God for the work which they fulfilled.
