ascendeth out of <u>66\_REV\_11\_07</u># And when they shall have finished their testimony, the beast that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them, and shall overcome them, and kill them.

ascendeth up for 66\_REV\_14\_11# And the smoke of their torment ascendeth up for ever and ever: and they have no rest day nor night, who worship the beast and his image, and whosoever receiveth the mark of his name.

bendeth his bow 19\_PSA\_58\_07 # Let them melt away as waters [which] run continually: [when] he bendeth [his bow to shoot] his arrows, let them be as cut in pieces.

bendeth let the <u>24\_JER\_51\_03</u> # Against [him that] bendeth let the archer bend his bow, and against [him that] lifteth himself up in his brigandine: and spare ye not her young men; destroy ye utterly all her host.

commendeth himself is <u>47\_2CO\_10\_18</u># For not he that commendeth himself is approved, but whom the Lord commendeth.

commendeth his love <u>45\_ROM\_05\_08</u># But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

commendeth us not <u>46\_1CO\_08\_08</u> # But meat commendeth us not to God: for neither, if we eat, are we the better; neither, if we eat not, are we the worse.

commendeth <u>47\_2CO\_10\_18</u># For not he that commendeth himself is approved, but whom the Lord commendeth.

contendeth with a <u>20\_PRO\_29\_09</u> # [If] a wise man contendeth with a foolish man, whether he rage or laugh, [there is] no rest.

contendeth with the <u>18\_JOB\_40\_02</u># Shall he that contendeth with the Almighty instruct [him]? he that reproveth God, let him answer it.

contendeth with thee <u>23\_ISA\_49\_25</u># But thus saith the LORD, Even the captives of the mighty shall be taken away, and the prey of the terrible shall be delivered: for I will contend with him that contendeth with thee, and I will save thy children.

descendeth not from <u>59\_JAM\_03\_15</u> # This wisdom descendeth not from above, but [is] earthly, sensual, devilish.

endeth the joy <u>23\_ISA\_24\_08</u># The mirth of tabrets ceaseth, the noise of them that rejoice endeth, the joy of the harp ceaseth.

extendeth not to 19 PSA 16 02 # [O my soul], thou hast said unto the LORD, Thou [art] my Lord: my goodness [extendeth] not to thee;

lendeth and his 19\_PSA\_37\_26 # [He is] ever merciful, and lendeth; and his seed [is] blessed.

lendeth he will 19\_PSA\_112\_05 # A good man showeth favour, and lendeth: he will guide his affairs with discretion.

lendeth ought unto <u>05 DEU 15 02 # And this [is]</u> the manner of the release: Every creditor that lendeth [ought] unto his neighbour shall release [it]; he shall not exact [it] of his neighbour, or of his brother; because it is called the LORD'S release.

lendeth unto the <u>20\_PRO\_19\_17</u># He that hath pity upon the poor lendeth unto the LORD; and that which he hath given will he pay him again.

sendeth a message <u>20\_PRO\_26\_06</u># He that sendeth a message by the hand of a fool cutteth off the feet, [and] drinketh damage.

sendeth ambassadors by <u>23\_ISA\_18\_02</u># That sendeth ambassadors by the sea, even in vessels of bulrushes upon the waters, [saying], Go, ye swift messengers, to a nation scattered and peeled, to a people terrible from their beginning hitherto; a nation meted out and trodden down, whose land the rivers have spoiled!

sendeth an ambassage <u>42\_LUK\_14\_32</u> # Or else, while the other is yet a great way off, he sendeth an ambassage, and desireth conditions of peace.

sendeth forth his <u>19\_PSA\_147\_15</u># He sendeth forth his commandment [upon] earth: his word runneth very swiftly.

sendeth forth the <u>22\_SON\_01\_12</u># While the king [sitteth] at his table, my spikenard sendeth forth the smell thereof.

sendeth forth two 41\_MAR\_11\_01# And when they came nigh to Jerusalem, unto Bethphage and Bethany, at the mount of Olives, he sendeth forth two of his disciples,

sendeth forth two 41\_MAR\_14\_13 # And he sendeth forth two of his disciples, and saith unto them, Go ye into the city, and there shall meet you a man bearing a pitcher of water: follow him.

sendeth greeting <u>44\_ACT\_23\_26</u> # Claudius Lysias unto the most excellent governor Felix [sendeth] greeting.

sendeth her out <u>05\_DEU\_24\_03</u># And [if] the latter husband hate her, and write her a bill of divorcement, and giveth [it] in her hand, and sendeth her out of his house; or if the latter husband die, which took her [to be] his wife;

sendeth out his <u>19\_PSA\_147\_18</u># He sendeth out his word, and melteth them: he causeth his wind to blow, [and] the waters flow.

sendeth rain on 40\_MAT\_05\_45# That ye may be the children of your Father which is in heaven: for he maketh his sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sendeth rain on the just and on the unjust.

sendeth rain upon 11\_1KI\_17\_14# For thus saith the LORD God of Israel, The barrel of meal shall not waste, neither shall the cruse of oil fail, until the day [that] the LORD sendeth rain upon the earth.

sendeth the springs 19\_PSA\_104\_10 # He sendeth the springs into the valleys, [which] run among the hills.

sendeth them out <u>18\_JOB\_12\_15</u># Behold, he withholdeth the waters, and they dry up: also he sendeth them out, and they overturn the earth.

sendeth waters upon 18\_JOB\_05\_10 # Who giveth rain upon the earth, and sendeth waters upon the fields:

spendeth as a 21\_ECC\_06\_12 # For who knoweth what [is] good for man in [this] life, all the days of his vain life which he spendeth as a shadow? for who can tell a man what shall be after him under the sun?

spendeth his substance <u>20\_PRO\_29\_03</u># Whoso loveth wisdom rejoiceth his father: but he that keepeth company with harlots spendeth [his] substance.

spendeth it up <u>20\_PRO\_21\_20</u># [There is] treasure to be desired and oil in the dwelling of the wise; but a foolish man spendeth it up.

tendeth only to 20\_PRO\_14\_23 # In all labour there is profit: but the talk of the lips [tendeth] only to penury.

tendeth to life 20\_PRO\_10\_16 # The labour of the righteous [tendeth] to life: the fruit of the wicked to sin.

tendeth to life <u>20\_PRO\_11\_19</u># As righteousness [tendeth] to life: so he that pursueth evil [pursueth it] to his own death.

tendeth to life <u>20\_PRO\_19\_23</u> # The fear of the LORD [tendeth] to life: and [he that hath it] shall abide satisfied; he shall not be visited with evil.

tendeth to poverty <u>20\_PRO\_11\_24</u># There is that scattereth, and yet increaseth; and [there is] that withholdeth more than is meet, but [it tendeth] to poverty.
