entreat for him <u>09\_1SA\_02\_25</u># If one man sin against another, the judge shall judge him: but if a man sin against the LORD, who shall entreat for him? Notwithstanding they hearkened not unto the voice of their father, because the LORD would slay them.

entreat for me <u>02\_EXO\_08\_28</u># And Pharaoh said, I will let you go, that ye may sacrifice to the LORD your God in the wilderness; only ye shall not go very far away: entreat for me.

entreat for me <u>01\_GEN\_23\_08</u># And he communed with them, saying, If it be your mind that I should bury my dead out of my sight; hear me, and entreat for me to Ephron the son of Zohar,

entreat for thee <u>02\_EXO\_08\_09</u> # And Moses said unto Pharaoh, Glory over me: when shall I entreat for thee, and for thy servants, and for thy people, to destroy the frogs from thee and thy houses, [that] they may remain in the river only?

entreat him as <u>54\_1TI\_05\_01</u># Rebuke not an elder, but entreat [him] as a father; [and] the younger men as brethren;

Entreat me not <u>08\_RUT\_01\_16</u># And Ruth said, Entreat me not to leave thee, [or] to return from following after thee: for whither thou goest, I will go; and where thou lodgest, I will lodge: thy people [shall be] my people, and thy God my God:

Entreat now the 11\_1KI\_13\_06# And the king answered and said unto the man of God, Entreat now the face of the LORD thy God, and pray for me, that my hand may be restored me again. And the man of God besought the LORD, and the king's hand was restored him again, and became as [it was] before.

entreat the favour <u>20\_PRO\_19\_06</u> # Many will entreat the favour of the prince: and every man [is] a friend to him that giveth gifts.

Entreat the LORD <u>02\_EXO\_08\_08</u># Then Pharaoh called for Moses and Aaron, and said, Entreat the LORD, that he may take away the frogs from me, and from my people; and I will let the people go, that they may do sacrifice unto the LORD.

entreat the LORD <u>02\_EXO\_08\_29</u> # And Moses said, Behold, I go out from thee, and I will entreat the LORD that the swarms [of flies] may depart from Pharaoh, from his servants, and from his people, to morrow: but let not Pharaoh deal deceitfully any more in not letting the people go to sacrifice to the LORD.

Entreat the LORD <u>02\_EXO\_09\_28</u> # Entreat the LORD [for [it is] enough] that there be no [more] mighty thunderings and hail; and I will let you go, and ye shall stay no longer.

entreat the LORD <u>02\_EXO\_10\_17</u> # Now therefore forgive, I pray thee, my sin only this once, and entreat the LORD your God, that he may take away from me this death only.

entreat thee also <u>50\_PHP\_04\_03</u> # And I entreat thee also, true yokefellow, help those women which laboured with me in the gospel, with Clement also, and [with] other my fellowlabourers, whose names [are] in the book of life.

entreat thee well <u>24\_JER\_15\_11</u># The LORD said, Verily it shall be well with thy remnant; verily I will cause the enemy to entreat thee [well] in the time of evil and in the time of affliction.

entreat them evil <u>44\_ACT\_07\_06</u># And God spake on this wise, That his seed should sojourn in a strange land; and that they should bring them into bondage, and entreat [them] evil four hundred years.

entreat thy favour 19 PSA 45 12 # And the daughter of Tyre [shall be there] with a gift; [even] the rich among the people shall entreat thy favour.

entreat we are <u>46\_1CO\_04\_13</u> # Being defamed, we entreat: we are made as the filth of the world, [and are] the offscouring of all things unto this day.

entreated Abram well <u>01\_GEN\_12\_16</u># And he entreated Abram well for her sake: and he had sheep, and oxen, and he asses, and menservants, and maidservants, and she asses, and camels.

entreated and spitted <u>42\_LUK\_18\_32</u> # For he shall be delivered unto the Gentiles, and shall be mocked, and spittedly entreated, and spitted on:

entreated as ye <u>52\_1TH\_02\_02</u> # But even after that we had suffered before, and were shamefully entreated, as ye know, at Philippi, we were bold in our God to speak unto you the gospel of God with much contention.

entreated for the <u>10\_2SA\_21\_14</u># And the bones of Saul and Jonathan his son buried they in the country of Benjamin in Zelah, in the sepulchre of Kish his father: and they performed all that the king commanded. And after that God was entreated for the land.

entreated for the <u>10\_2SA\_24\_25</u> # And David built there an altar unto the LORD, and offered burnt offerings and peace offerings. So the LORD was entreated for the land, and the plague was stayed from Israel.

entreated for the <u>18\_JOB\_19\_17</u> # My breath is strange to my wife, though I entreated for the children's [sake] of mine own body.

entreated full of <u>59\_JAM\_03\_17</u># But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, [and] easy to be entreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy.

entreated him shamefully <u>42\_LUK\_20\_11</u># And again he sent another servant: and they beat him also, and entreated [him] shamefully, and sent [him] away empty.

entreated him with <u>18\_JOB\_19\_16</u># I called my servant, and he gave [me] no answer; I entreated him with my mouth.

entreated him <u>42\_LUK\_15\_28</u> # And he was angry, and would not go in: therefore came his father out, and entreated him.

entreated of him <u>14\_2CH\_33\_13</u> # And prayed unto him: and he was entreated of him, and heard his supplication, and brought him again to Jerusalem into his kingdom. Then Manasseh knew that the LORD he [was] God.

entreated of him <u>14\_2CH\_33\_19</u> # His prayer also, and [how God] was entreated of him, and all his sins, and his trespass, and the places wherein he built high places, and set up groves and graven images, before he was humbled: behold, they [are] written among the sayings of the seers.

entreated of him <u>01\_GEN\_25\_21</u># And Isaac entreated the LORD for his wife, because she [was] barren: and the LORD was entreated of him, and Rebekah his wife conceived.

entreated of them <u>13\_1CH\_05\_20</u># And they were helped against them, and the Hagarites were delivered into their hand, and all that [were] with them: for they cried to God in the battle, and he was entreated of

them; because they put their trust in him.

entreated of them <u>23\_ISA\_19\_22</u> # And the LORD shall smite Egypt: he shall smite and heal [it]: and they shall return [even] to the LORD, and he shall be entreated of them, and shall heal them.

entreated of us 15\_EZR\_08\_23 # So we fasted and besought our God for this: and he was entreated of us.

entreated our fathers <u>44\_ACT\_07\_19</u> # The same dealt subtly with our kindred, and evil entreated our fathers, so that they cast out their young children, to the end they might not live.

entreated Paul and 44\_ACT\_27\_03 # And the next [day] we touched at Sidon. And Julius courteously entreated Paul, and gave [him] liberty to go unto his friends to refresh himself.

entreated that the <u>58\_HEB\_12\_19</u># And the sound of a trumpet, and the voice of words; which [voice] they that heard entreated that the word should not be spoken to them any more:

entreated the LORD 02\_EXO\_08\_30 # And Moses went out from Pharaoh, and entreated the LORD.

entreated the LORD 02\_EXO\_10\_18 # And he went out from Pharaoh, and entreated the LORD.

entreated the LORD <u>01\_GEN\_25\_21</u> # And Isaac entreated the LORD for his wife, because she [was] barren: and the LORD was entreated of him, and Rebekah his wife conceived.

entreated the LORD <u>07\_JUD\_13\_08</u># Then Manoah entreated the LORD, and said, O my Lord, let the man of God which thou didst send come again unto us, and teach us what we shall do unto the child that shall be born.

entreated them spitefully <u>40\_MAT\_22\_06</u># And the remnant took his servants, and entreated [them] spitefully, and slew [them].

entreated this people <u>02\_EXO\_05\_22</u> # And Moses returned unto the LORD, and said, Lord, wherefore hast thou [so] evil entreated this people? why [is] it [that] thou hast sent me?

entreated thy favour 19\_PSA\_119\_58# I entreated thy favour with [my] whole heart: be merciful unto me according to thy word.

entreated us and <u>05\_DEU\_26\_06</u># And the Egyptians evil entreated us, and afflicted us, and laid upon us hard bondage:

entreateth the barren 18\_JOB\_24\_21 # He evil entreateth the barren [that] beareth not: and doeth not good to the widow.

entreaties but the 20\_PRO\_18\_23 # The poor useth entreaties; but the rich answereth roughly.

entreaty that we <u>47\_2CO\_08\_04</u> # Praying us with much entreaty that we would receive the gift, and [take upon us] the fellowship of the ministering to the saints.
