exercise profiteth little 54 1TI 04 08 # For bodily exercise profiteth little: but godliness is profitable unto all things, having promise of the life that now is, and of that which is to come.

exercise thyself rather 54 1TI 04 07 #But refuse profane and old wives' fables, and exercise thyself [rather] unto godliness.

exercised in it 21 ECC 03 10 # I have seen the travail, which God hath given to the sons of men to be exercised in it.

exercised robbery and 26 EZE 22 29 # The people of the land have used oppression, and exercised robbery, and have vexed the poor and needy: yea, they have oppressed the stranger wrongfully.

exercised thereby 58 HEB 12 11 # Now no chastening for the present seemeth to be joyous, but grievous: nevertheless afterward it yieldeth the peaceable fruit of righteousness unto them which are exercised thereby.

exercised therewith 21 ECC 01 13 #And I gave my heart to seek and search out by wisdom concerning all [things] that are done under heaven: this sore travail hath God given to the sons of man to be exercised therewith.

exercised to discern 58 HEB 05 14# But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, [even] those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

exercised with covetous 61 2PE 02 14# Having eyes full of adultery, and that cannot cease from sin; beguiling unstable souls: an heart they have exercised with covetous practices; cursed children:
