evilfavouredness for that [05 DEU 17 01](#) # Thou shalt not sacrifice unto the LORD thy God [any] bullock, or sheep, wherein is blemish, [or] any evilfavouredness: for that [is] an abomination unto the LORD thy God.

favour against him [44 ACT 25 03](#) # And desired favour against him, that he would send for him to Jerusalem, laying wait in the way to kill him.

favour and full [05 DEU 33 23](#) # And of Naphtali he said, O Naphtali, satisfied with favour, and full with the blessing of the LORD: possess thou the west and the south.

favour and good [20 PRO 03 04](#) # So shalt thou find favour and good understanding in the sight of God and man.

favour and lendeth [19 PSA 112 05](#) # A good man showeth favour, and lendeth: he will guide his affairs with discretion.

favour and tender [27 DAN 01 09](#) # Now God had brought Daniel into favour and tender love with the prince of the eunuchs.

favour and thy [18 JOB 10 12](#) # Thou hast granted me life and favour, and thy visitation hath preserved my spirit.

favour and wisdom [44 ACT 07 10](#) # And delivered him out of all his afflictions, and gave him favour and wisdom in the sight of Pharaoh king of Egypt; and he made him governor over Egypt and all his house.

favour be showed [23 ISA 26 10](#) # Let favour be showed to the wicked, [yet] will he not learn righteousness: in the land of uprightness will he deal unjustly, and will not behold the majesty of the LORD.

favour before God [44 ACT 07 46](#) # Who found favour before God, and desired to find a tabernacle for the God of Jacob.

favour both with [09 ISA 02 26](#) # And the child Samuel grew on, and was in favour both with the LORD, and also with men.

favour but every [20 PRO 29 26](#) # Many seek the ruler's favour; but [every] man's judgment [cometh] from the LORD.

favour but he [20 PRO 11 27](#) # He that diligently seeketh good procureth favour: but he that seeketh mischief, it shall come unto him.

favour but that [06 JOS 11 20](#) # For it was of the LORD to harden their hearts, that they should come against Israel in battle, that he might destroy them utterly, [and] that they might have no favour, but that he might destroy them, as the LORD commanded Moses.

favour but the [20 PRO 13 15](#) # Good understanding giveth favour: but the way of transgressors [is] hard.

favour have I [23 ISA 60 10](#) # And the sons of strangers shall build up thy walls, and their kings shall

minister unto thee: for in my wrath I smote thee, but in my favour have I had mercy on thee.

favour her yea [19\\_PSA\\_102\\_13](#) # Thou shalt arise, [and] have mercy upon Zion: for the time to favour her, yea, the set time, is come.

favour his fatherless [19\\_PSA\\_109\\_12](#) # Let there be none to extend mercy unto him: neither let there be any to favour his fatherless children.

favour in his [05\\_DEU\\_24\\_01](#) # When a man hath taken a wife, and married her, and it come to pass that she find no favour in his eyes, because he hath found some uncleanness in her: then let him write her a bill of divorcement, and give [it] in her hand, and send her out of his house.

favour in his [17\\_EST\\_02\\_17](#) # And the king loved Esther above all the women, and she obtained grace and favour in his sight more than all the virgins; so that he set the royal crown upon her head, and made her queen instead of Vashti.

favour in his [17\\_EST\\_05\\_02](#) # And it was so, when the king saw Esther the queen standing in the court, [that] she obtained favour in his sight: and the king held out to Esther the golden sceptre that [was] in his hand. So Esther drew near, and touched the top of the sceptre.

favour in his [17\\_EST\\_08\\_05](#) # And said, If it please the king, and if I have found favour in his sight, and the thing [seem] right before the king, and I [be] pleasing in his eyes, let it be written to reverse the letters devised by Haman the son of Hammedatha the Agagite, which he wrote to destroy the Jews which [are] in all the king's provinces:

favour in my [09\\_1SA\\_16\\_22](#) # And Saul sent to Jesse, saying, Let David, I pray thee, stand before me; for he hath found favour in my sight.

favour in the [11\\_1KI\\_11\\_19](#) # And Hadad found great favour in the sight of Pharaoh, so that he gave him to wife the sister of his own wife, the sister of Tahpenes the queen.

favour in the [10\\_2SA\\_15\\_25](#) # And the king said unto Zadok, Carry back the ark of God into the city: if I shall find favour in the eyes of the LORD, he will bring me again, and show me [both] it, and his habitation:

favour in the [17\\_EST\\_02\\_15](#) # Now when the turn of Esther, the daughter of Abihail the uncle of Mordecai, who had taken her for his daughter, was come to go in unto the king, she required nothing but what Hegai the king's chamberlain, the keeper of the women, appointed. And Esther obtained favour in the sight of all them that looked upon her.

favour in the [17\\_EST\\_05\\_08](#) # If I have found favour in the sight of the king, and if it please the king to grant my petition, and to perform my request, let the king and Haman come to the banquet that I shall prepare for them, and I will do to morrow as the king hath said.

favour in the [02\\_EXO\\_03\\_21](#) # And I will give this people favour in the sight of the Egyptians: and it shall come to pass, that, when ye go, ye shall not go empty:

favour in the [02\\_EXO\\_11\\_03](#) # And the LORD gave the people favour in the sight of the Egyptians. Moreover the man Moses [was] very great in the land of Egypt, in the sight of Pharaoh's servants, and in the sight of the people.

favour in thine [09\\_1SA\\_25\\_08](#) # Ask thy young men, and they will show thee. Wherefore let the young men find favour in thine eyes: for we come in a good day: give, I pray thee, whatsoever cometh to thine hand unto thy servants, and to thy son David.

favour in thine [01\\_GEN\\_30\\_27](#) # And Laban said unto him, I pray thee, if I have found favour in thine eyes, [tarry: for] I have learned by experience that the LORD hath blessed me for thy sake.

favour in thy [17\\_EST\\_07\\_03](#) # Then Esther the queen answered and said, If I have found favour in thy sight, O king, and if it please the king, let my life be given me at my petition, and my people at my request:

favour in thy [01\\_GEN\\_18\\_03](#) # And said, My Lord, if now I have found favour in thy sight, pass not away, I pray thee, from thy servant:

favour in thy [04\\_NUM\\_11\\_15](#) # And if thou deal thus with me, kill me, I pray thee, out of hand, if I have found favour in thy sight; and let me not see my wretchedness.

favour in thy [08\\_RUT\\_02\\_13](#) # Then she said, Let me find favour in thy sight, my lord; for that thou hast comforted me, and for that thou hast spoken friendly unto thine handmaid, though I be not like unto one of thine handmaidens.

favour is as [20\\_PRO\\_16\\_15](#) # In the light of the king's countenance [is] life; and his favour [is] as a cloud of the latter rain.

favour is as [20\\_PRO\\_19\\_12](#) # The king's wrath [is] as the roaring of a lion; but his favour [is] as dew upon the grass.

Favour is deceitful [20\\_PRO\\_31\\_30](#) # Favour [is] deceitful, and beauty [is] vain: [but] a woman [that] feareth the LORD, she shall be praised.

favour is life [19\\_PSA\\_30\\_05](#) # For his anger [endureth but] a moment; in his favour [is] life: weeping may endure for a night, but joy [cometh] in the morning.

favour is toward [20\\_PRO\\_14\\_35](#) # The king's favour [is] toward a wise servant: but his wrath is [against] him that causeth shame.

favour my righteous [19\\_PSA\\_35\\_27](#) # Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favour my righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, Let the LORD be magnified, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of his servant.

favour of the [20\\_PRO\\_08\\_35](#) # For whoso findeth me findeth life, and shall obtain favour of the LORD.

favour of the [20 PRO 12 02](#) # A good [man] obtaineth favour of the LORD: but a man of wicked devices will he condemn.

favour of the [20 PRO 18 22](#) # [Whoso] findeth a wife findeth a good [thing], and obtaineth favour of the LORD.

favour of the [20 PRO 19 06](#) # Many will entreat the favour of the prince: and every man [is] a friend to him that giveth gifts.

favour our horn [19 PSA 89 17](#) # For thou [art] the glory of their strength: and in thy favour our horn shall be exalted.

favour rather than [20 PRO 22 01](#) # A [good] name [is] rather to be chosen than great riches, [and] loving favour rather than silver and gold.

favour than he [20 PRO 28 23](#) # He that rebuketh a man afterwards shall find more favour than he that flattereth with the tongue.

favour that thou [19 PSA 106 04](#) # Remember me, O LORD, with the favour [that thou bearest unto] thy people: O visit me with thy salvation;

favour the dust [19 PSA 102 14](#) # For thy servants take pleasure in her stones, and favour the dust thereof.

favour thee not [09 ISA 29 06](#) # Then Achish called David, and said unto him, Surely, [as] the LORD liveth, thou hast been upright, and thy going out and thy coming in with me in the host [is] good in my sight: for I have not found evil in thee since the day of thy coming unto me unto this day: nevertheless the lords favour thee not.

favour thou hast [19 PSA 30 07](#) # LORD, by thy favour thou hast made my mountain to stand strong: thou didst hide thy face, [and] I was troubled.

favour to men [21 ECC 09 11](#) # I returned, and saw under the sun, that the race [is] not to the swift, nor the battle to the strong, neither yet bread to the wise, nor yet riches to men of understanding, nor yet favour to men of skill; but time and chance happeneth to them all.

favour to the [05 DEU 28 50](#) # A nation of fierce countenance, which shall not regard the person of the old, nor show favour to the young:

favour unto them [19 PSA 44 03](#) # For they got not the land in possession by their own sword, neither did their own arm save them: but thy right hand, and thine arm, and the light of thy countenance, because thou hadst a favour unto them.

favour wilt thou [19 PSA 05 12](#) # For thou, LORD, wilt bless the righteous; with favour wilt thou compass him as [with] a shield.

favour with all [44 ACT 02 47](#) # Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved.

favour with God [42 LUK 01 30](#) # And the angel said unto her, Fear not, Mary: for thou hast found favour with God.

favour with God [42 LUK 02 52](#) # And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favour with God and man.

favour with my [19 PSA 119 58](#) # I entreated thy favour with [my] whole heart: be merciful unto me according to thy word.

favour [23 ISA 27 11](#) # When the boughs thereof are withered, they shall be broken off: the women come, [and] set them on fire: for it [is] a people of no understanding: therefore he that made them will not have mercy on them, and he that formed them will show them no favour.

favour [24 JER 16 13](#) # Therefore will I cast you out of this land into a land that ye know not, [neither] ye nor your fathers; and there shall ye serve other gods day and night; where I will not show you favour.

favour [20 PRO 14 09](#) # Fools make a mock at sin: but among the righteous [there is] favour.

favour [19 PSA 45 12](#) # And the daughter of Tyre [shall be there] with a gift; [even] the rich among the people shall entreat thy favour.

favour [22 SON 08 10](#) # I [am] a wall, and my breasts like towers: then was I in his eyes as one that found favour.

favourable no more [19 PSA 77 07](#) # Will the Lord cast off for ever? and will he be favourable no more?

favourable unto him [18 JOB 33 26](#) # He shall pray unto God, and he will be favourable unto him: and he shall see his face with joy: for he will render unto man his righteousness.

favourable unto them [07 JUD 21 22](#) # And it shall be, when their fathers or their brethren come unto us to complain, that we will say unto them, Be favourable unto them for our sakes: because we reserved not to each man his wife in the war: for ye did not give unto them at this time, [that] ye should be guilty.

favourable unto thy [19 PSA 85 01](#) # To the chief Musician, A Psalm for the sons of Korah. LORD, thou hast been favourable unto thy land: thou hast brought back the captivity of Jacob.

favoured and fat [01 GEN 41 04](#) # And the ill favoured and leanfleshed kine did eat up the seven well favoured and fat kine. So Pharaoh awoke.

favoured and leanfleshed [01 GEN 41 03](#) # And, behold, seven other kine came up after them out of the river, ill favoured and leanfleshed; and stood by the [other] kine upon the brink of the river.

favoured and leanfleshed [01 GEN 41 04](#) # And the ill favoured and leanfleshed kine did eat up the seven well favoured and fat kine. So Pharaoh awoke.

favoured and leanfleshed [01 GEN 41 19](#) # And, behold, seven other kine came up after them, poor and very ill favoured and leanfleshed, such as I never saw in all the land of Egypt for badness:

favoured and they [01 GEN 41 18](#) # And, behold, there came up out of the river seven kine, fatfleshed and well favoured; and they fed in a meadow:

favoured as at [01 GEN 41 21](#) # And when they had eaten them up, it could not be known that they had eaten them; but they [were] still ill favoured, as at the beginning. So I awoke.

favoured kine and [01 GEN 41 02](#) # And, behold, there came up out of the river seven well favoured kine and fatfleshed; and they fed in a meadow.

**favoured kine did [01\\_GEN\\_41\\_20](#) # And the lean and the ill favoured kine did eat up the first seven fat kine:**

**favoured kine that [01\\_GEN\\_41\\_27](#) # And the seven thin and ill favoured kine that came up after them [are] seven years; and the seven empty ears blasted with the east wind shall be seven years of famine.**

**favoured not the [25\\_LAM\\_04\\_16](#) # The anger of the LORD hath divided them; he will no more regard them: they respected not the persons of the priests, they favoured not the elders.**

**favoured the Lord [42\\_LUK\\_01\\_28](#) # And the angel came in unto her, and said, Hail, [thou that art] highly favoured, the Lord [is] with thee: blessed [art] thou among women.**

**favoured [01\\_GEN\\_29\\_17](#) # Leah [was] tender eyed; but Rachel was beautiful and well favoured.**

**favoured [01\\_GEN\\_39\\_06](#) # And he left all that he had in Joseph's hand; and he knew not ought he had, save the bread which he did eat. And Joseph was [a] goodly [person], and well favoured.**

**favourest me because [19\\_PSA\\_41\\_11](#) # By this I know that thou favourest me, because mine enemy doth not triumph over me.**

**favoureth Joab and [10\\_2SA\\_20\\_11](#) # And one of Joab's men stood by him, and said, He that favoureth Joab, and he that [is] for David, [let him go] after Joab.**

**wellfavoured harlot the [34\\_NAH\\_03\\_04](#) # Because of the multitude of the whoredoms of the wellfavoured harlot, the mistress of witchcrafts, that selleth nations through her whoredoms, and families through her witchcrafts.**
