feared above all <u>13\_1CH\_16\_25</u># For great [is] the LORD, and greatly to be praised: he also [is] to be feared above all gods.

feared above all <u>19\_PSA\_96\_04</u># For the LORD [is] great, and greatly to be praised: he [is] to be feared above all gods.

feared and said <u>02\_EXO\_02\_14</u># And he said, Who made thee a prince and a judge over us? intendest thou to kill me, as thou killedst the Egyptian? And Moses feared, and said, Surely this thing is known.

feared and set 14\_2CH\_20\_03 # And Jehoshaphat feared, and set himself to seek the LORD, and proclaimed a fast throughout all Judah.

feared and was 19\_PSA\_76\_08 # Thou didst cause judgment to be heard from heaven; the earth feared, and was still,

feared and who 19\_PSA\_76\_07 # Thou, [even] thou, [art] to be feared: and who may stand in thy sight when once thou art angry?

feared as they <u>42\_LUK\_09\_34</u> # While he thus spake, there came a cloud, and overshadowed them: and they feared as they entered into the cloud.

feared because he <u>07\_JUD\_08\_20</u> # And he said unto Jether his firstborn, Up, [and] slay them. But the youth drew not his sword: for he feared, because he [was] yet a youth.

feared because of <u>11\_1KI\_01\_50</u># And Adonijah feared because of Solomon, and arose, and went, and caught hold on the horns of the altar.

feared before him <u>27\_DAN\_05\_19</u> # And for the majesty that he gave him, all people, nations, and languages, trembled and feared before him: whom he would he slew; and whom he would he kept alive; and whom he would he set up; and whom he would he put down.

feared continually every 23 ISA 51 13 # And forgettest the LORD thy maker, that hath stretched forth the heavens, and laid the foundations of the earth; and hast feared continually every day because of the fury of the oppressor, as if he were ready to destroy? and where [is] the fury of the oppressor?

feared exceedingly and 41\_MAR\_04\_41 # And they feared exceedingly, and said one to another, What manner of man is this, that even the wind and the sea obey him?

feared God above 16\_NEH\_07\_02 # That I gave my brother Hanani, and Hananiah the ruler of the palace, charge over Jerusalem: for he [was] a faithful man, and feared God above many.

feared God and <u>02\_EXO\_01\_17</u> # But the midwives feared God, and did not as the king of Egypt commanded them, but saved the men children alive.

feared God and 18\_JOB\_01\_01 # There was a man in the land of Uz, whose name [was] Job; and that man was perfect and upright, and one that feared God, and eschewed evil.

feared God that 02\_EXO\_01\_21 # And it came to pass, because the midwives feared God, that he made

them houses.

feared God with 44\_ACT\_10\_02 # [A] devout [man], and one that feared God with all his house, which gave much alms to the people, and prayed to God alway.

feared greatly because <u>06\_JOS\_10\_02</u> # That they feared greatly, because Gibeon [was] a great city, as one of the royal cities, and because it [was] greater than Ai, and all the men thereof [were] mighty.

feared greatly saying <u>40\_MAT\_27\_54</u># Now when the centurion, and they that were with him, watching Jesus, saw the earthquake, and those things that were done, they feared greatly, saying, Truly this was the Son of God.

feared him as <u>06\_JOS\_04\_14</u># On that day the LORD magnified Joshua in the sight of all Israel; and they feared him, as they feared Moses, all the days of his life.

feared him because 41\_MAR\_11\_18# And the scribes and chief priests heard [it], and sought how they might destroy him: for they feared him, because all the people was astonished at his doctrine.

feared him 10\_2SA\_03\_11 # And he could not answer Abner a word again, because he feared him.

feared his father's <u>07\_JUD\_06\_27</u># Then Gideon took ten men of his servants, and did as the LORD had said unto him: and [so] it was, because he feared his father's household, and the men of the city, that he could not do [it] by day, that he did [it] by night.

feared in the 19\_PSA\_89\_07 # God is greatly to be feared in the assembly of the saints, and to be had in reverence of all [them that are] about him.

feared is come <u>18\_JOB\_03\_25</u># For the thing which I greatly feared is come upon me, and that which I was afraid of is come unto me.

feared John knowing 41\_MAR\_06\_20 # For Herod feared John, knowing that he was a just man and an holy, and observed him; and when he heard him, he did many things, and heard him gladly.

feared me and <u>39\_MAL\_02\_05</u> # My covenant was with him of life and peace; and I gave them to him [for] the fear wherewith he feared me, and was afraid before my name.

feared Moses all <u>06\_JOS\_04\_14</u># On that day the LORD magnified Joshua in the sight of all Israel; and they feared him, as they feared Moses, all the days of his life.

feared nor walked <u>24\_JER\_44\_10</u> # They are not humbled [even] unto this day, neither have they feared, nor walked in my law, nor in my statutes, that I set before you and before your fathers.

feared not but 24\_JER\_03\_08 # And I saw, when for all the causes whereby backsliding Israel committed adultery I had put her away, and given her a bill of divorce; yet her treacherous sister Judah feared not, but went and played the harlot also.

feared not but 19\_PSA\_78\_53 # And he led them on safely, so that they feared not: but the sea overwhelmed their enemies.

feared not God <u>05\_DEU\_25\_18</u> # How he met thee by the way, and smote the hindmost of thee, [even] all [that were] feeble behind thee, when thou [wast] faint and weary; and he feared not God.

feared not God <u>42\_LUK\_18\_02</u># Saying, There was in a city a judge, which feared not God, neither regarded man:

feared not the 12 2KI 17 25 # And [so] it was at the beginning of their dwelling there, [that] they feared not the LORD: therefore the LORD sent lions among them, which slew [some] of them.

feared other gods 12\_2KI\_17\_07 # For [so] it was, that the children of Israel had sinned against the LORD their God, which had brought them up out of the land of Egypt, from under the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt, and had feared other gods,

feared shall overtake 24\_JER\_42\_16 # Then it shall come to pass, [that] the sword, which ye feared, shall overtake you there in the land of Egypt, and the famine, whereof ye were afraid, shall follow close after you there in Egypt; and there ye shall die.

feared that thou <u>23\_ISA\_57\_11</u># And of whom hast thou been afraid or feared, that thou hast lied, and hast not remembered me, nor laid [it] to thy heart? have not I held my peace even of old, and thou fearest me not?

feared the LORD <u>11\_1KI\_18\_03</u># And Ahab called Obadiah, which [was] the governor of [his] house. [Now Obadiah feared the LORD greatly:

feared the people <u>09\_1SA\_15\_24</u> # And Saul said unto Samuel, I have sinned: for I have transgressed the commandment of the LORD, and thy words: because I feared the people, and obeyed their voice.

feared the people <u>44\_ACT\_05\_26</u> # Then went the captain with the officers, and brought them without violence: for they feared the people, lest they should have been stoned.

feared the people <u>41\_MAR\_12\_12</u> # And they sought to lay hold on him, but feared the people: for they knew that he had spoken the parable against them: and they left him, and went their way.

feared the sword <u>26\_EZE\_11\_08</u># Ye have feared the sword; and I will bring a sword upon you, saith the Lord GOD.

feared the word <u>02\_EXO\_09\_20</u> # He that feared the word of the LORD among the servants of Pharaoh made his servants and his cattle flee into the houses:

feared the wrath <u>05\_DEU\_32\_27</u># Were it not that I feared the wrath of the enemy, lest their adversaries should behave themselves strangely, [and] lest they should say, Our hand [is] high, and the LORD hath not done all this.

feared thee because <u>42\_LUK\_19\_21</u># For I feared thee, because thou art an austere man: thou takest up that thou layedst not down, and reapest that thou didst not sow.

feared to ask <u>42\_LUK\_09\_45</u> # But they understood not this saying, and it was hid from them, that they perceived it not: and they feared to ask him of that saying.

feared to dwell <u>01\_GEN\_19\_30</u> # And Lot went up out of Zoar, and dwelt in the mountain, and his two daughters with him; for he feared to dwell in Zoar: and he dwelt in a cave, he and his two daughters.

feared to help <u>10\_2SA\_10\_19</u># And when all the kings [that were] servants to Hadarezer saw that they were smitten before Israel, they made peace with Israel, and served them. So the Syrians feared to help the children of Ammon any more.

feared to say <u>01\_GEN\_26\_07</u> # And the men of the place asked [him] of his wife; and he said, She [is] my sister: for he feared to say, [She is] my wife; lest, [said he], the men of the place should kill me for Rebekah; because she [was] fair to look upon.

feared to show <u>09\_1SA\_03\_15</u> # And Samuel lay until the morning, and opened the doors of the house of the LORD. And Samuel feared to show Eli the vision.

feared to tell <u>10\_2SA\_12\_18</u># And it came to pass on the seventh day, that the child died. And the servants of David feared to tell him that the child was dead: for they said, Behold, while the child was yet alive, we spake unto him, and he would not hearken unto our voice: how will he then vex himself, if we tell him that the child is dead?

feared when they <u>44\_ACT\_16\_38</u># And the serjeants told these words unto the magistrates: and they feared, when they heard that they were Romans.

feared 19\_PSA\_76\_11 # Vow, and pay unto the LORD your God: let all that be round about him bring presents unto him that ought to be feared.
