

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

feeble among them 38 ZEC 12 08 # In that day shall the LORD defend the inhabitants of Jerusalem; and he that is feeble among them at that day shall be as David; and the house of David [shall be] as God, as the angel of the LORD before them.

feeble and all 10 2SA 04 01 # And when Saul's son heard that Abner was dead in Hebron, his hands were feeble, and all the Israelites were troubled.

feeble and all 26 EZE 07 17 # All hands shall be feeble, and all knees shall be weak [as] water

feeble and every 26 EZE 21 07 # And it shall be, when they say unto thee, Wherefore sighest thou? that thou shalt answer, For the tidings; because it cometh: and every heart shall melt, and all hands shall be feeble, and every spirit shall faint, and all knees shall be weak [as] water: behold, it cometh, and shall be brought to pass, saith the Lord GOD.

feeble and sore 19 PSA 38 08 # I am feeble and sore broken: I have roared by reason of the disquietness of my heart.

feeble and turneth 24 JER 49 24 # Damascus is waxed feeble, [and] turneth herself to flee, and fear hath seized on [her]: anguish and sorrows have taken her, as a woman in travail.

feeble anguish hath 24 JER 06 24 # We have heard the fame thereof: our hands wax feeble: anguish hath taken hold of us, [and] pain, as of a woman in travail.

feeble anguish took 24 JER 50 43 # The king of Babylon hath heard the report of them, and his hands waxed feeble: anguish took hold of him, [and] pangs as of a woman in travail.

feeble are necessary 46 1CO 12 22 # Nay, much more those members of the body, which seem to be more feeble, are necessary:

feeble behind thee 05 DEU 25 18# How he met thee by the way, and smote the hindmost of thee, [even] all [that were] feeble behind thee, when thou [wast] faint and weary; and he feared not God.

feeble folk yet 20 PRO 30 26 # The conies [are but] a feeble folk, yet make they their houses in the rocks;

feeble he put 01 GEN 30 42 # But when the cattle were feeble, he put [them] not in: so the feebler were Laban's, and the stronger Jacob's.

feeble Jews will 16 NEH 04 02 # And he spake before his brethren and the army of Samaria, and said, What do these feeble Jews? will they fortify themselves? will they sacrifice? will they make an end in a day? will they revive the stones out of the heaps of the rubbish which are burned?

feeble knees 23 ISA 35 03 # Strengthen ye the weak hands, and confirm the feeble knees.

feeble knees 18 JOB 04 04 # Thy words have upholden him that was falling, and thou hast strengthened the feeble knees.

feeble of them 14 2CH 28 15 # And the men which were expressed by name rose up, and took the captives, and with the spoil clothed all that were naked among them, and arrayed them, and shod them, and gave them to eat and to drink, and anointed them, and carried all the feeble of them upon asses, and brought them to Jericho, the city of palm trees, to their brethren: then they returned to Samaria.

feeble person among 19 PSA 105 37 # He brought them forth also with silver and gold: and [there was] not one feeble [person] among their tribes.

feeble 09 1SA 02 05 # [They that were] full have hired out themselves for bread; and [they that were] hungry ceased: so that the barren hath born seven; and she that hath many children is waxed feeble.

feeble 23 ISA 16 14 # But now the LORD hath spoken, saying, Within three years, as the years of an hireling, and the glory of Moab shall be contemned, with all that great multitude; and the remnant [shall be] very small [and] feeble.

feebleminded support the 52 1TH 05 14 # Now we exhort you, brethren, warn them that are unruly, comfort the feebleminded, support the weak, be patient toward all [men].

feebleness of hands 24 JER 47 03 # At the noise of the stamping of the hoofs of his strong [horses], at the rushing of his chariots, [and at] the rumbling of his wheels, the fathers shall not look back to [their] children for feebleness of hands:

 $feebler \ were \ Laban's \ \underline{01 \ GEN \ 30 \ 42} \# \ But \ when \ the \ cattle \ were \ feeble, he \ put \ [them] \ not \ in: so \ the \ feebler \ were \ Laban's, and \ the \ stronger \ Jacob's.$
