benefit done unto 14\_2CH\_32\_25 # But Hezekiah rendered not again according to the benefit [done] unto him; for his heart was lifted up: therefore there was wrath upon him, and upon Judah and Jerusalem.

benefit should not <u>57\_PHM\_01\_14</u># But without thy mind would I do nothing; that thy benefit should not be as it were of necessity, but willingly.

benefit them <u>24\_JER\_18\_10</u># If it do evil in my sight, that it obey not my voice, then I will repent of the good, wherewith I said I would benefit them.
