fled <u>44_ACT_16_27</u> # And the keeper of the prison awaking out of his sleep, and seeing the prison doors open, he drew out his sword, and would have killed himself, supposing that the prisoners had been fled.

fled <u>01_GEN_31_20</u># And Jacob stole away unawares to Laban the Syrian, in that he told him not that he fled.

fled 01_GEN_31_22 # And it was told Laban on the third day that Jacob was fled.

fled <u>23_ISA_10_29</u> # They are gone over the passage: they have taken up their lodging at Geba; Ramah is afraid; Gibeah of Saul is fled.

fled <u>23_ISA_21_14</u># The inhabitants of the land of Tema brought water to him that was thirsty, they prevented with their bread him that fled.

fled 24_JER_04_25 # I beheld, and, lo, [there was] no man, and all the birds of the heavens were fled.

fled <u>06_JOS_20_06</u># And he shall dwell in that city, until he stand before the congregation for judgment, [and] until the death of the high priest that shall be in those days: then shall the slayer return, and come unto his own city, and unto his own house, unto the city from whence he fled.

fled <u>07_JUD_07_21</u> # And they stood every man in his place round about the camp: and all the host ran, and cried, and fled.

fled 41_MAR_14_50 # And they all forsook him, and fled.

fled <u>40_MAT_26_56</u># But all this was done, that the scriptures of the prophets might be fulfilled. Then all the disciples forsook him, and fled.

fled <u>04_NUM_35_26</u> # But if the slayer shall at any time come without the border of the city of his refuge, whither he was fled;

fleddest from the <u>01 GEN 35_01</u># And God said unto Jacob, Arise, go up to Bethel, and dwell there: and make there an altar unto God, that appeared unto thee when thou fleddest from the face of Esau thy brother.

fleddest thou Jordan <u>19_PSA_114_05</u># What [ailed] thee, O thou sea, that thou fleddest? thou Jordan, [that] thou wast driven back?

rifled and the <u>38_ZEC_14_02</u># For I will gather all nations against Jerusalem to battle; and the city shall be taken, and the houses rifled, and the women ravished; and half of the city shall go forth into captivity, and the residue of the people shall not be cut off from the city.
