fool according to 20\_PRO\_26\_05 # Answer a fool according to his folly, lest he be wise in his own conceit.

fool also is **21\_ECC\_10\_14** # A fool also is full of words: a man cannot tell what shall be; and what shall be after him, who can tell him?

fool and have <u>09\_1SA\_26\_21</u># Then said Saul, I have sinned: return, my son David: for I will no more do thee harm, because my soul was precious in thine eyes this day: behold, I have played the fool, and have erred exceedingly.

fool and rewardeth <u>20\_PRO\_26\_10</u># The great [God] that formed all [things] both rewardeth the fool, and rewardeth transgressors.

fool and the 19\_PSA\_49\_10 # For he seeth [that] wise men die, likewise the fool and the brutish person perish, and leave their wealth to others.

fool are in <u>20\_PRO\_17\_24</u> # Wisdom [is] before him that hath understanding; but the eyes of a fool [are] in the ends of the earth.

fool but whoso 20\_PRO\_28\_26# He that trusteth in his own heart is a fool: but whoso walketh wisely, he shall be delivered.

fool cutteth off <u>20\_PRO\_26\_06</u># He that sendeth a message by the hand of a fool cutteth off the feet, [and] drinketh damage.

fool despiseth his  $20_{PRO_{15_{05}}}$ # A fool despiseth his father's instruction: but he that regardeth reproof is prudent.

fool dieth 10\_2SA\_03\_33 # And the king lamented over Abner, and said, Died Abner as a fool dieth?

fool doeth it <u>20\_PRO\_17\_21</u># He that begetteth a fool [doeth it] to his sorrow: and the father of a fool hath no joy.

fool foldeth his 21\_ECC\_04\_05 # The fool foldeth his hands together, and eateth his own flesh.

fool for ever <u>21\_ECC\_02\_16</u># For [there is] no remembrance of the wise more than of the fool for ever; seeing that which now [is] in the days to come shall all be forgotten. And how dieth the wise [man]? as the fool.

fool for he 20\_PRO\_23\_09 # Speak not in the ears of a fool: for he will despise the wisdom of thy words.

fool for I <u>47\_2CO\_12\_06</u># For though I would desire to glory, I shall not be a fool; for I will say the truth: but [now] I forbear, lest any man should think of me above that which he seeth me [to be], or [that] he heareth of me.

fool hath no <u>20\_PRO\_17\_21</u> # He that begetteth a fool [doeth it] to his sorrow: and the father of a fool hath no joy.

fool hath no <u>20\_PRO\_18\_02</u> # A fool hath no delight in understanding, but that his heart may discover itself.

fool hath said 19\_PSA\_14\_01 # To the chief Musician, [A Psalm] of David. The fool hath said in his heart, [There is] no God. They are corrupt, they have done abominable works, [there is] none that doeth good.

fool hath said 19 PSA 53 01 # To the chief Musician upon Mahalath, Maschil, [A Psalm] of David. The fool hath said in his heart, [There is] no God. Corrupt are they, and have done abominable iniquity: [there is] none that doeth good.

fool he openeth 20\_PRO\_24\_07 # Wisdom [is] too high for a fool: he openeth not his mouth in the gate.

fool I am <u>47\_2CO\_11\_23</u># Are they ministers of Christ? [I speak as a fool] I [am] more; in labours more abundant, in stripes above measure, in prisons more frequent, in deaths oft.

fool if otherwise <u>47\_2CO\_11\_16</u># I say again, Let no man think me a fool; if otherwise, yet as a fool receive me, that I may boast myself a little.

fool in a <u>20\_PRO\_27\_22</u> # Though thou shouldest bray a fool in a mortar among wheat with a pestle, [yet] will not his foolishness depart from him.

fool in glorying <u>47\_2CO\_12\_11</u># I am become a fool in glorying; ye have compelled me: for I ought to have been commended of you: for in nothing am I behind the very chiefest apostles, though I be nothing.

fool in his 20\_PRO\_17\_12 # Let a bear robbed of her whelps meet a man, rather than a fool in his folly.

fool is right <u>20\_PRO\_12\_15</u> # The way of a fool [is] right in his own eyes: but he that hearkeneth unto counsel [is] wise.

fool layeth open <u>20\_PRO\_13\_16</u> # Every prudent [man] dealeth with knowledge: but a fool layeth open [his] folly.

fool much less 20\_PRO\_17\_07 # Excellent speech becometh not a fool: much less do lying lips a prince.

fool much less <u>20\_PRO\_19\_10</u># Delight is not seemly for a fool; much less for a servant to have rule over princes.

fool rageth and <u>20\_PRO\_14\_16</u> # A wise [man] feareth, and departeth from evil: but the fool rageth, and is confident.

fool receive me <u>47\_2CO\_11\_16</u># I say again, Let no man think me a fool; if otherwise, yet as a fool receive me, that I may boast myself a little.

fool returneth to 20\_PRO\_26\_11 # As a dog returneth to his vomit, [so] a fool returneth to his folly.

fool shall be <u>40 MAT\_05\_22</u># But I say unto you, That whosoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment: and whosoever shall say to his brother, Raca, shall be in danger of the council: but whosoever shall say, Thou fool, shall be in danger of hell fire.

fool shall be <u>20\_PRO\_11\_29</u># He that troubleth his own house shall inherit the wind: and the fool [shall be] servant to the wise of heart.

fool to do 20\_PRO\_10\_23 # [It is] as sport to a fool to do mischief: but a man of understanding hath wisdom.

fool to get 20\_PRO\_17\_16# Wherefore [is there] a price in the hand of a fool to get wisdom, seeing [he hath] no heart [to it]?

fool to the <u>20\_PRO\_07\_22</u># He goeth after her straightway, as an ox goeth to the slaughter, or as a fool to the correction of the stocks;

fool understand this 19\_PSA\_92\_06 # A brutish man knoweth not; neither doth a fool understand this.

fool uttereth all 20\_PRO\_29\_11 # A fool uttereth all his mind: but a wise [man] keepeth it in till afterwards.

fool 20\_PRO\_26\_01 # As snow in summer, and as rain in harvest, so honour is not seemly for a fool.

fool 20\_PRO\_26\_08 # As he that bindeth a stone in a sling, so [is] he that giveth honour to a fool.

fool's back 20\_PRO\_26\_03 # A whip for the horse, a bridle for the ass, and a rod for the fool's back.

fool's heart at 21\_ECC\_10\_02 # A wise man's heart [is] at his right hand; but a fool's heart at his left.

fool's lips enter 20\_PRO\_18\_06 # A fool's lips enter into contention, and his mouth calleth for strokes.

fool's mouth is 20\_PRO\_18\_07 # A fool's mouth [is] his destruction, and his lips [are] the snare of his soul.

fool's voice is <u>21\_ECC\_05\_03</u># For a dream cometh through the multitude of business; and a fool's voice [is known] by multitude of words.

fool's wrath is 20\_PRO\_12\_16 # A fool's wrath is presently known: but a prudent [man] covereth shame.

fool's wrath is <u>20\_PRO\_27\_03</u># A stone [is] heavy, and the sand weighty; but a fool's wrath [is] heavier than them both.

foolish a teacher <u>45\_ROM\_02\_20</u> # An instructor of the foolish, a teacher of babes, which hast the form of knowledge and of the truth in the law.

foolish and hurtful <u>54\_1TI\_06\_09</u># But they that will be rich fall into temptation and a snare, and [into] many foolish and hurtful lusts, which drown men in destruction and perdition.

foolish and live 20\_PRO\_09\_06 # Forsake the foolish, and live; and go in the way of understanding.

foolish and unlearned <u>55\_2TI\_02\_23</u># But foolish and unlearned questions avoid, knowing that they do gender strifes.

foolish disobedient deceived <u>56\_TIT\_03\_03</u># For we ourselves also were sometimes foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving divers lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful, [and] hating one another.

foolish doeth not 20\_PRO\_15\_07 # The lips of the wise disperse knowledge: but the heart of the foolish [doeth] not so.

foolish for they <u>24\_JER\_05\_04</u> # Therefore I said, Surely these [are] poor; they are foolish: for they know not the way of the LORD, [nor] the judgment of their God.

foolish Galatians who <u>48\_GAL\_03\_01</u> # O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, crucified among you?

foolish having begun <u>48\_GAL\_03\_03</u># Are ye so foolish? having begun in the Spirit, are ye now made perfect by the flesh?

foolish heart was <u>45\_ROM\_01\_21</u> # Because that, when they knew God, they glorified [him] not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened.

foolish is a 20\_PRO\_14\_03\_# In the mouth of the foolish [is] a rod of pride: but the lips of the wise shall preserve them.

foolish is near <u>20\_PRO\_10\_14</u> # Wise [men] lay up knowledge: but the mouth of the foolish [is] near destruction.

foolish king who <u>21\_ECC\_04\_13</u># Better [is] a poor and a wise child than an old and foolish king, who will no more be admonished.

foolish man and 18\_JOB\_05\_02 # For wrath killeth the foolish man, and envy slayeth the silly one.

foolish man despiseth <u>20\_PRO\_15\_20</u># A wise son maketh a glad father: but a foolish man despiseth his mother.

foolish man reproacheth 19\_PSA\_74\_22 # Arise, O God, plead thine own cause: remember how the foolish man reproacheth thee daily.

foolish man spendeth <u>20\_PRO\_21\_20</u> # [There is] treasure to be desired and oil in the dwelling of the wise; but a foolish man spendeth it up.

foolish man when <u>20\_PRO\_14\_07</u> # Go from the presence of a foolish man, when thou perceivest not [in him] the lips of knowledge.

foolish man whether <u>20\_PRO\_29\_09</u> # [If] a wise man contendeth with a foolish man, whether he rage or laugh, [there is] no rest.

foolish man which <u>40\_MAT\_07\_26</u># And every one that heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them not, shall be likened unto a foolish man, which built his house upon the sand:

foolish men  $60\_1PE\_02\_15$  # For so is the will of God, that with well doing ye may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men:

foolish nation I <u>45\_ROM\_10\_19</u> # But I say, Did not Israel know? First Moses saith, I will provoke you to jealousy by [them that are] no people, [and] by a foolish nation I will anger you.

foolish nation <u>05\_DEU\_32\_21</u># They have moved me to jealousy with [that which is] not God; they have provoked me to anger with their vanities: and I will move them to jealousy with [those which are] not a

people; I will provoke them to anger with a foolish nation.

foolish people and <u>05\_DEU\_32\_06</u># Do ye thus requite the LORD, O foolish people and unwise? [is] not he thy father [that] hath bought thee? hath he not made thee, and established thee?

foolish people and <u>24\_JER\_05\_21</u> # Hear now this, O foolish people, and without understanding; which have eyes, and see not; which have ears, and hear not:

foolish people have 19 PSA 74 18 # Remember this, [that] the enemy hath reproached, O LORD, and [that] the foolish people have blasphemed thy name.

foolish plucketh it <u>20\_PRO\_14\_01</u># Every wise woman buildeth her house: but the foolish plucketh it down with her hands.

foolish prophets that <u>26\_EZE\_13\_03</u># Thus saith the Lord GOD; Woe unto the foolish prophets, that follow their own spirit, and have seen nothing!

foolish questions and <u>56\_TIT\_03\_09</u># But avoid foolish questions, and genealogies, and contentions, and strivings about the law; for they are unprofitable and vain.

foolish said unto 40\_MAT\_25\_08# And the foolish said unto the wise, Give us of your oil; for our lamps are gone out.

foolish shall not 19\_PSA\_05\_05 # The foolish shall not stand in thy sight: thou hatest all workers of iniquity.

foolish shepherd <u>38\_ZEC\_11\_15</u># And the LORD said unto me, Take unto thee yet the instruments of a foolish shepherd.

foolish son is <u>20\_PRO\_10\_01</u># The proverbs of Solomon. A wise son maketh a glad father: but a foolish son [is] the heaviness of his mother.

foolish son is 20\_PRO\_17\_25 # A foolish son [is] a grief to his father, and bitterness to her that bare him.

foolish son is <u>20\_PRO\_19\_13</u> # A foolish son [is] the calamity of his father: and the contentions of a wife [are] a continual dropping.

foolish taking root <u>18\_JOB\_05\_03</u># I have seen the foolish taking root: but suddenly I cursed his habitation.

foolish talking nor <u>49\_EPH\_05\_04</u> # Neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor jesting, which are not convenient: but rather giving of thanks.

foolish the stock <u>24\_JER\_10\_08</u># But they are altogether brutish and foolish: the stock [is] a doctrine of vanities.

foolish the wisdom 46\_1CO\_01\_20 # Where [is] the wise? where [is] the scribe? where [is] the disputer of this world? hath not God made foolish the wisdom of this world?

foolish they have 24\_JER\_04\_22 # For my people [is] foolish, they have not known me; they [are] sottish children, and they have none understanding: they [are] wise to do evil, but to do good they have no knowledge.

foolish things for <u>25\_LAM\_02\_14</u># Thy prophets have seen vain and foolish things for thee: and they have not discovered thine iniquity, to turn away thy captivity; but have seen for thee false burdens and causes of

banishment.

foolish things of 46\_1CO\_01\_27 # But God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; and God hath chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty;

foolish took their 40\_MAT\_25\_03 # They that [were] foolish took their lamps, and took no oil with them:

foolish was I 19\_PSA\_73\_22 # So foolish [was] I, and ignorant: I was [as] a beast before thee.

foolish wearieth every <u>21\_ECC\_10\_15</u># The labour of the foolish wearieth every one of them, because he knoweth not how to go to the city.

foolish when I 19 PSA 73 03 # For I was envious at the foolish, [when] I saw the prosperity of the wicked.

foolish why shouldest <u>21\_ECC\_07\_17</u># Be not over much wicked, neither be thou foolish: why shouldest thou die before thy time?

foolish woman is 20\_PRO\_09\_13 # A foolish woman [is] clamorous: [she is] simple, and knoweth nothing.

foolish women speaketh <u>18\_JOB\_02\_10</u> # But he said unto her, Thou speakest as one of the foolish women speaketh. What? shall we receive good at the hand of God, and shall we not receive evil? In all this did not Job sin with his lips.

foolish 23 ISA 44 25 # That frustrateth the tokens of the liars, and maketh diviners mad; that turneth wise [men] backward, and maketh their knowledge foolish;

foolish 40\_MAT\_25\_02 # And five of them were wise, and five [were] foolish.

foolish 19\_PSA\_39\_08 # Deliver me from all my transgressions: make me not the reproach of the foolish.

foolishly and a <u>20\_PRO\_14\_17</u> # [He that is] soon angry dealeth foolishly: and a man of wicked devices is hated.

foolishly and to 19\_PSA\_75\_04 # I said unto the fools, Deal not foolishly: and to the wicked, Lift not up the horn:

foolishly and wherein <u>04\_NUM\_12\_11</u># And Aaron said unto Moses, Alas, my lord, I beseech thee, lay not the sin upon us, wherein we have done foolishly, and wherein we have sinned.

foolishly I am <u>47\_2CO\_11\_21</u> # I speak as concerning reproach, as though we had been weak. Howbeit whereinsoever any is bold, [I speak foolishly,] I am bold also.

foolishly in lifting 20\_PRO\_30\_32 # If thou hast done foolishly in lifting up thyself, or if thou hast thought evil, [lay] thine hand upon thy mouth.

foolishly in so <u>01\_GEN\_31\_28</u> # And hast not suffered me to kiss my sons and my daughters? thou hast now done foolishly in [so] doing.

foolishly in this <u>47\_2CO\_11\_17</u># That which I speak, I speak [it] not after the Lord, but as it were foolishly, in this confidence of boasting.

foolishly therefore from 14\_2CH\_16\_09 # For the eyes of the LORD run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to show himself strong in the behalf of [them] whose heart [is] perfect toward him. Herein thou hast done foolishly: therefore from henceforth thou shalt have wars.

foolishly thou hast <u>09\_1SA\_13\_13</u># And Samuel said to Saul, Thou hast done foolishly: thou hast not kept the commandment of the LORD thy God, which he commanded thee: for now would the LORD have established thy kingdom upon Israel for ever.

foolishly 18\_JOB\_01\_22 # In all this Job sinned not, nor charged God foolishly.

foolishness and madness <u>21\_ECC\_07\_25</u># I applied mine heart to know, and to search, and to seek out wisdom, and the reason [of things], and to know the wickedness of folly, even of foolishness [and] madness:

foolishness and my <u>19\_PSA\_69\_05</u># O God, thou knowest my foolishness; and my sins are not hid from thee.

foolishness and the <u>21\_ECC\_10\_13</u># The beginning of the words of his mouth [is] foolishness: and the end of his talk [is] mischievous madness.

foolishness but unto  $46\_1CO\_01\_18$  # For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God.

foolishness depart from <u>20\_PRO\_27\_22</u> # Though thou shouldest bray a fool in a mortar among wheat with a pestle, [yet] will not his foolishness depart from him.

foolishness of fools <u>20\_PRO\_14\_24</u> # The crown of the wise [is] their riches: [but] the foolishness of fools [is] folly.

foolishness of God  $\underline{46\_1CO\_01\_25}$ # Because the foolishness of God is wiser than men; and the weakness of God is stronger than men.

foolishness of man <u>20\_PRO\_19\_03</u># The foolishness of man perverteth his way: and his heart fretteth against the LORD.

foolishness of preaching 46\_1CO\_01\_21 # For after that in the wisdom of God the world by wisdom knew not God, it pleased God by the foolishness of preaching to save them that believe.

foolishness unto him <u>46\_1CO\_02\_14</u> # But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know [them], because they are spiritually discerned.

foolishness with God <u>46\_1CO\_03\_19</u># For the wisdom of this world is foolishness with God. For it is written, He taketh the wise in their own craftiness.

foolishness <u>46\_1CO\_01\_23</u> # But we preach Christ crucified, unto the Jews a stumblingblock, and unto the Greeks foolishness;

foolishness 10\_2SA\_15\_31 # And [one] told David, saying, Ahithophel [is] among the conspirators with Absalom. And David said, O LORD, I pray thee, turn the counsel of Ahithophel into foolishness.

foolishness <u>20\_PRO\_15\_02</u># The tongue of the wise useth knowledge aright: but the mouth of fools poureth out foolishness.

foolishness <u>20\_PRO\_15\_14</u># The heart of him that hath understanding seeketh knowledge: but the mouth of fools feedeth on foolishness.

foolishness 19\_PSA\_38\_05 # My wounds stink [and] are corrupt because of my foolishness.

fools and blind <u>40\_MAT\_23\_17</u># [Ye] fools and blind: for whether is greater, the gold, or the temple that sanctifieth the gold?

fools and blind <u>40\_MAT\_23\_19</u># [Ye] fools and blind: for whether [is] greater, the gift, or the altar that sanctifieth the gift?

fools and slow <u>42\_LUK\_24\_25</u> # Then he said unto them, O fools, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken:

fools be ye <u>20\_PRO\_08\_05</u># O ye simple, understand wisdom: and, ye fools, be ye of an understanding heart.

Fools because of <u>19\_PSA\_107\_17</u> # Fools because of their transgression, and because of their iniquities, are afflicted.

fools but as 49\_EPH\_05\_15 # See then that ye walk circumspectly, not as fools, but as wise,
