foul spirit and <u>66\_REV\_18\_02</u># And he cried mightily with a strong voice, saying, Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen, and is become the habitation of devils, and the hold of every foul spirit, and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird.

foul spirit saying <u>41\_MAR\_09\_25</u># When Jesus saw that the people came running together, he rebuked the foul spirit, saying unto him, [Thou] dumb and deaf spirit, I charge thee, come out of him, and enter no more into him.

foul the residue <u>26\_EZE\_34\_18</u> # [Seemeth it] a small thing unto you to have eaten up the good pasture, but ye must tread down with your feet the residue of your pastures? and to have drunk of the deep waters, but ye must foul the residue with your feet?

foul weather to <u>40\_MAT\_16\_03</u># And in the morning, [It will be] foul weather to day: for the sky is red and lowering. O [ye] hypocrites, ye can discern the face of the sky; but can ye not [discern] the signs of the times?

foul with weeping <u>18\_JOB\_16\_16</u> # My face is foul with weeping, and on my eyelids [is] the shadow of death;

fouled with your <u>26\_EZE\_34\_19</u> # And [as for] my flock, they eat that which ye have trodden with your feet; and they drink that which ye have fouled with your feet.

fouledst their rivers 26 EZE 32 02 # Son of man, take up a lamentation for Pharaoh king of Egypt, and say unto him, Thou art like a young lion of the nations, and thou [art] as a whale in the seas: and thou camest forth with thy rivers, and troubledst the waters with thy feet, and fouledst their rivers.
