defraud and that 46_1CO_06_08 # Nay, ye do wrong, and defraud, and that [your] brethren.

defraud his brother <u>52_1TH_04_06</u> # That no [man] go beyond and defraud his brother in [any] matter: because that the Lord [is] the avenger of all such, as we also have forewarned you and testified.

Defraud not Honour <u>41_MAR_10_19</u> # Thou knowest the commandments, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Defraud not, Honour thy father and mother.

defraud thy neighbour <u>03_LEV_19_13</u># Thou shalt not defraud thy neighbour, neither rob [him]: the wages of him that is hired shall not abide with thee all night until the morning.

Defraud ye not 46_1CO_07_05 # Defraud ye not one the other, except [it be] with consent for a time, that ye may give yourselves to fasting and prayer; and come together again, that Satan tempt you not for your incontinency.

defrauded no man <u>47_2CO_07_02</u># Receive us; we have wronged no man, we have corrupted no man, we have defrauded no man.

defrauded us nor <u>09_1SA_12_04</u># And they said, Thou hast not defrauded us, nor oppressed us, neither hast thou taken ought of any man's hand.

defrauded whom have <u>09_1SA_12_03</u># Behold, here I [am]: witness against me before the LORD, and before his anointed: whose ox have I taken? or whose ass have I taken? or whom have I defrauded? whom have I oppressed? or of whose hand have I received [any] bribe to blind mine eyes therewith? and I will restore it you.

defrauded <u>46_1CO_06_07</u> # Now therefore there is utterly a fault among you, because ye go to law one with another. Why do ye not rather take wrong? why do ye not rather [suffer yourselves to] be defrauded?

fraud crieth and <u>59_JAM_05_04</u># Behold, the hire of the labourers who have reaped down your fields, which is of you kept back by fraud, crieth: and the cries of them which have reaped are entered into the ears of the Lord of sabaoth.

fraud under his 19_PSA_10_07 # His mouth is full of cursing and deceit and fraud: under his tongue [is] mischief and vanity.
