Gad a portion <u>26\_EZE\_48\_27</u> # And by the border of Zebulun, from the east side unto the west side, Gad a [portion].

Gad a troop <u>01\_GEN\_49\_19</u> # Gad, a troop shall overcome him: but he shall overcome at the last.

Gad according to <u>06\_JOS\_13\_24</u># And Moses gave [inheritance] unto the tribe of Gad, [even] unto the children of Gad according to their families.

Gad according to <a>04\_NUM\_26\_18</a># These [are] the families of the children of Gad according to those that were numbered of them, forty thousand and five hundred.

Gadi to reign 12 2KI 15 17 # In the nine and thirtieth year of Azariah king of Judah began Menahem the son of Gadi to reign over Israel, [and reigned] ten years in Samaria.

Gadi went up 12 2KI 15 14 # For Menahem the son of Gadi went up from Tirzah, and came to Samaria, and smote Shallum the son of Jabesh in Samaria, and slew him, and reigned in his stead.
