glass darkly but [46 1CO 13 12](#) # For now we see through a glass, darkly; but then face to face: now I know in part; but then shall I know even as also I am known.

glass having the [66 REV 15 02](#) # And I saw as it were a sea of glass mingled with fire: and them that had gotten the victory over the beast, and over his image, and over his mark, [and] over the number of his name, stand on the sea of glass, having the harps of God.
