gold a thousand <u>15_EZR_01_09</u># And this [is] the number of them: thirty chargers of gold, a thousand chargers of silver, nine and twenty knives,

gold about his <u>27_DAN_05_07</u># The king cried aloud to bring in the astrologers, the Chaldeans, and the soothsayers. [And] the king spake, and said to the wise [men] of Babylon, Whosoever shall read this writing, and show me the interpretation thereof, shall be clothed with scarlet, and [have] a chain of gold about his neck, and shall be the third ruler in the kingdom.

gold about his <u>27_DAN_05_29</u># Then commanded Belshazzar, and they clothed Daniel with scarlet, and [put] a chain of gold about his neck, and made a proclamation concerning him, that he should be the third ruler in the kingdom.

gold about thy <u>27_DAN_05_16</u># And I have heard of thee, that thou canst make interpretations, and dissolve doubts: now if thou canst read the writing, and make known to me the interpretation thereof, thou shalt be clothed with scarlet, and [have] a chain of gold about thy neck, and shalt be the third ruler in the kingdom.

gold according to <u>11_1KI_09_11</u># [[Now] Hiram the king of Tyre had furnished Solomon with cedar trees and fir trees, and with gold, according to all his desire,] that then king Solomon gave Hiram twenty cities in the land of Galilee.

gold according to 14_2CH_04_07 # And he made ten candlesticks of gold according to their form, and set [them] in the temple, five on the right hand, and five on the left.

gold amounting to <u>14_2CH_03_08</u> # And he made the most holy house, the length whereof [was] according to the breadth of the house, twenty cubits, and the breadth thereof twenty cubits: and he overlaid it with fine gold, [amounting] to six hundred talents.

gold an hundred <u>15_EZR_08_26</u> # I even weighed unto their hand six hundred and fifty talents of silver, and silver vessels an hundred talents, [and] of gold an hundred talents;

gold and a <u>13_1CH_22_14</u># Now, behold, in my trouble I have prepared for the house of the LORD an hundred thousand talents of gold, and a thousand thousand talents of silver; and of brass and iron without weight; for it is in abundance: timber also and stone have I prepared; and thou mayest add thereto.

gold and an <u>20_PRO_25_12</u> # [As] an earring of gold, and an ornament of fine gold, [so is] a wise reprover upon an obedient ear.

gold and blue <u>02_EXO_28_05</u># And they shall take gold, and blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine linen.

gold and brought <u>14_2CH_08_18</u># And Huram sent him by the hands of his servants ships, and servants that had knowledge of the sea; and they went with the servants of Solomon to Ophir, and took thence four hundred and fifty talents of gold, and brought [them] to king Solomon.

gold and casteth <u>23_ISA_40_19</u># The workman melteth a graven image, and the goldsmith spreadeth it over with gold, and casteth silver chains.

gold and couple <u>02_EXO_26_06</u># And thou shalt make fifty taches of gold, and couple the curtains together with the taches: and it shall be one tabernacle.

gold and coupled <u>02_EXO_36_13</u># And he made fifty taches of gold, and coupled the curtains one unto another with the taches: so it became one tabernacle.

gold and every <u>02_EXO_35_22</u># And they came, both men and women, as many as were willing hearted, [and] brought bracelets, and earrings, and rings, and tablets, all jewels of gold: and every man that offered [offered] an offering of gold unto the LORD.

gold and five 15 EZR 02 69 # They gave after their ability unto the treasure of the work threescore and one thousand drams of gold, and five thousand pound of silver, and one hundred priests' garments.

gold and for <u>13_1CH_28_15</u># Even the weight for the candlesticks of gold, and for their lamps of gold, by weight for every candlestick, and for the lamps thereof: and for the candlesticks of silver by weight, [both] for the candlestick, and [also] for the lamps thereof, according to the use of every candlestick.

gold and for <u>14_2CH_32_27</u> # And Hezekiah had exceeding much riches and honour: and he made himself treasuries for silver, and for gold, and for precious stones, and for spices, and for shields, and for all manner of pleasant jewels;

gold and for 23_ISA_60_17 # For brass I will bring gold, and for iron I will bring silver, and for wood brass, and for stones iron: I will also make thy officers peace, and thine exactors righteousness.

gold and frankincense <u>40_MAT_02_11</u># And when they were come into the house, they saw the young child with Mary his mother, and fell down, and worshipped him: and when they had opened their treasures, they presented unto him gifts; gold, and frankincense, and myrrh.

gold and garments <u>11_1KI_10_25</u># And they brought every man his present, vessels of silver, and vessels of gold, and garments, and armour, and spices, horses, and mules, a rate year by year.

gold and grave <u>02_EXO_28_36</u> # And thou shalt make a plate [of] pure gold, and grave upon it, [like] the engravings of a signet, HOLINESS TO THE LORD.

gold and graved <u>14_2CH_03_07</u> # He overlaid also the house, the beams, the posts, and the walls thereof, and the doors thereof, with gold; and graved cherubims on the walls.

gold and have <u>29_JOE_03_05</u># Because ye have taken my silver and my gold, and have carried into your temples my goodly pleasant things:

gold and he 11_1KI_06_21 # So Solomon overlaid the house within with pure gold: and he made a partition

by the chains of gold before the oracle; and he overlaid it with gold.

gold And he 14_2CH_03_09 # And the weight of the nails [was] fifty shekels of gold. And he overlaid the upper chambers with gold.

gold and he <u>27_DAN_11_08</u># And shall also carry captives into Egypt their gods, with their princes, [and] with their precious vessels of silver and of gold; and he shall continue [more] years than the king of the north.

gold and he <u>02_EXO_36_36</u> # And he made thereunto four pillars [of] shittim [wood], and overlaid them with gold: their hooks [were of] gold; and he cast for them four sockets of silver.

gold and his <u>06_JOS_07_24</u># And Joshua, and all Israel with him, took Achan the son of Zerah, and the silver, and the garment, and the wedge of gold, and his sons, and his daughters, and his oxen, and his asses, and his sheep, and his tent, and all that he had: and they brought them unto the valley of Achor.

gold and I <u>11_1KI_20_07</u># Then the king of Israel called all the elders of the land, and said, Mark, I pray you, and see how this [man] seeketh mischief: for he sent unto me for my wives, and for my children, and for my silver, and for my gold; and I denied him not.

gold and incense <u>23_ISA_60_06</u># The multitude of camels shall cover thee, the dromedaries of Midian and Ephah; all they from Sheba shall come: they shall bring gold and incense; and they shall show forth the praises of the LORD.

gold and made <u>02_EXO_36_34</u> # And he overlaid the boards with gold, and made their rings [of] gold [to be] places for the bars, and overlaid the bars with gold.

gold and made <u>02_EXO_37_11</u># And he overlaid it with pure gold, and made thereunto a crown of gold round about.

gold and make <u>02_EXO_25_24</u># And thou shalt overlay it with pure gold, and make thereto a crown of gold round about.

gold and make <u>02_EXO_26_29</u> # And thou shalt overlay the boards with gold, and make their rings [of] gold [for] places for the bars: and thou shalt overlay the bars with gold.

gold and make <u>38_ZEC_06_11</u> # Then take silver and gold, and make crowns, and set [them] upon the head of Joshua the son of Josedech, the high priest;

gold and menservants <u>01_GEN_24_35</u># And the LORD hath blessed my master greatly; and he is become great: and he hath given him flocks, and herds, and silver, and gold, and menservants, and maidservants, and camels, and asses.

gold and my <u>20_PRO_08_19</u> # My fruit [is] better than gold, yea, than fine gold; and my revenue than choice silver.

gold and of <u>11_1KI_10_10</u># And she gave the king an hundred and twenty talents of gold, and of spices very great store, and precious stones: there came no more such abundance of spices as these which the queen of Sheba gave to king Solomon.

gold and of <u>14_2CH_09_09</u># And she gave the king an hundred and twenty talents of gold, and of spices great abundance, and precious stones: neither was there any such spice as the queen of Sheba gave king Solomon.

gold and of 14_2CH_21_03 # And their father gave them great gifts of silver, and of gold, and of precious things, with fenced cities in Judah: but the kingdom gave he to Jehoram; because he [was] the firstborn.

gold and of 12_2KI_25_15 # And the firepans, and the bowls, [and] such things as [were] of gold, [in] gold, and of silver, [in] silver, the captain of the guard took away.

gold and of <u>55_2TI_02_20</u># But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and of silver, but also of wood and of earth; and some to honour, and some to dishonour.

gold and of <u>27_DAN_05_04</u># They drank wine, and praised the gods of gold, and of silver, of brass, of iron, of wood, and of stone.

gold and put 02_EXO_39_25 # And they made bells [of] pure gold, and put the bells between the

pomegranates upon the hem of the robe, round about between the pomegranates;

gold and raiment <u>14_2CH_09_24</u> # And they brought every man his present, vessels of silver, and vessels of gold, and raiment, harness, and spices, horses, and mules, a rate year by year.

gold and raiment 12_2KI_07_08 # And when these lepers came to the uttermost part of the camp, they went into one tent, and did eat and drink, and carried thence silver, and gold, and raiment, and went and hid [it]; and came again, and entered into another tent, and carried thence [also], and went and hid [it].

gold and raiment <u>02_EXO_03_22</u> # But every woman shall borrow of her neighbour, and of her that sojourneth in her house, jewels of silver, and jewels of gold, and raiment: and ye shall put [them] upon your sons, and upon your daughters; and ye shall spoil the Egyptians.

gold and silver <u>13_1CH_29_03</u># Moreover, because I have set my affection to the house of my God, I have of mine own proper good, of gold and silver, [which] I have given to the house of my God, over and above all that I have prepared for the holy house,

gold and silver 11_1KI_10_22 # For the king had at sea a navy of Tharshish with the navy of Hiram: once in three years came the navy of Tharshish, bringing gold, and silver, ivory, and apes, and peacocks.

gold and silver 14_2CH_09_14 # Beside [that which] chapmen and merchants brought. And all the kings of Arabia and governors of the country brought gold and silver to Solomon.

gold and silver 14_2CH_09_21 # For the king's ships went to Tarshish with the servants of Huram: every three years once came the ships of Tarshish bringing gold, and silver, ivory, and apes, and peacocks.

gold and silver 14_2CH_24_14 # And when they had finished [it], they brought the rest of the money before the king and Jehoiada, whereof were made vessels for the house of the LORD, [even] vessels to minister, and to offer [withal], and spoons, and vessels of gold and silver. gold and silver <u>26_EZE_28_04</u> # With thy wisdom and with thine understanding thou hast gotten thee riches, and hast gotten gold and silver into thy treasures:

gold and silver 15 EZR 05 14 # And the vessels also of gold and silver of the house of God, which Nebuchadnezzar took out of the temple that [was] in Jerusalem, and brought them into the temple of Babylon, those did Cyrus the king take out of the temple of Babylon, and they were delivered unto [one], whose name [was] Sheshbazzar, whom he had made governor;

gold and silver 66_REV_09_20 # And the rest of the men which were not killed by these plagues yet repented not of the works of their hands, that they should not worship devils, and idols of gold, and silver, and brass, and stone, and of wood: which neither can see, nor hear, nor walk:

gold and silver <u>66_REV_18_12</u> # The merchandise of gold, and silver, and precious stones, and of pearls, and fine linen, and purple, and silk, and scarlet, and all thyine wood, and all manner vessels of ivory, and all manner vessels of most precious wood, and of brass, and iron, and marble,

gold and the <u>13_1CH_29_02</u># Now I have prepared with all my might for the house of my God the gold for [things to be made] of gold, and the silver for [things] of silver, and the brass for [things] of brass, the iron for [things] of iron, and wood for [things] of wood; onyx stones, and [stones] to be set, glistering stones, and of divers colours, and all manner of precious stones, and marble stones in abundance.

gold and their 66_REV_09_07 # And the shapes of the locusts [were] like unto horses prepared unto battle; and on their heads [were] as it were crowns like gold, and their faces [were] as the faces of men.

gold and there 13_1CH_20_02 # And David took the crown of their king from off his head, and found it to weigh a talent of gold, and [there were] precious stones in it; and it was set upon David's head: and he brought also exceeding much spoil out of the city.

gold and there 19 PSA 105 37 # He brought them forth also with silver and gold: and [there was] not one feeble [person] among their tribes.

gold and thou <u>02_EXO_26_37</u> # And thou shalt make for the hanging five pillars [of] shittim [wood], and overlay them with gold, [and] their hooks [shall be of] gold: and thou shalt cast five sockets of brass for them.

gold went to 11 1KI 10 17 # And [he made] three hundred shields [of] beaten gold; three pound of gold went to one shield: and the king put them in the house of the forest of Lebanon.

gold went to 14_2CH_09_15 # And king Solomon made two hundred targets [of] beaten gold: six hundred [shekels] of beaten gold went to one target.

gold which Solomon 11 1KI 14 26 # And he took away the treasures of the house of the LORD, and the treasures of the king's house; he even took away all: and he took away all the shields of gold which Solomon had made.

gold which Solomon 14_2CH_12_09 # So Shishak king of Egypt came up against Jerusalem, and took away the treasures of the house of the LORD, and the treasures of the king's house; he took all: he carried away also the shields of gold which Solomon had made.

gold which Solomon 12 2KI 24 13 # And he carried out thence all the treasures of the house of the LORD, and the treasures of the king's house, and cut in pieces all the vessels of gold which Solomon king of Israel had made in the temple of the LORD, as the LORD had said.

golden calves which <u>14_2CH_13_08</u># And now ye think to withstand the kingdom of the LORD in the hand of the sons of David; and ye [be] a great multitude, and [there are] with you golden calves, which Jeroboam made you for gods.

golden candlesticks The <u>66_REV_01_20</u># The mystery of the seven stars which thou sawest in my right hand, and the seven golden candlesticks. The seven stars are the angels of the seven churches: and the seven candlesticks which thou sawest are the seven churches.

golden candlesticks <u>66_REV_01_12</u># And I turned to see the voice that spake with me. And being turned, I saw seven golden candlesticks;

golden earrings because <u>07_JUD_08_24</u># And Gideon said unto them, I would desire a request of you, that ye would give me every man the earrings of his prey. [For they had golden earrings, because they [were] Ishmaelites.]

golden earrings that <u>07_JUD_08_26</u># And the weight of the golden earrings that he requested was a thousand and seven hundred [shekels] of gold; beside ornaments, and collars, and purple raiment that [was] on the kings of Midian, and beside the chains that [were] about their camels' necks.

golden earrings which <u>02_EXO_32_02</u># And Aaron said unto them, Break off the golden earrings, which [are] in the ears of your wives, of your sons, and of your daughters, and bring [them] unto me.

golden earrings which 02_{203} # And all the people brake off the golden earrings which [were] in their ears, and brought [them] unto Aaron.
