granted him all [15 EZR 07 06](#) # This Ezra went up from Babylon; and he [was] a ready scribe in the law of Moses, which the LORD God of Israel had given; and the king granted him all his request, according to the hand of the LORD his God upon him.

granted him that [13 1CH 04 10](#) # And Jabez called on the God of Israel, saying, Oh that thou wouldest bless me indeed, and enlarge my coast, and that thine hand might be with me, and that thou wouldest keep [me] from evil, that it may not grieve me! And God granted him that which he requested.

granted me according [16 NEH 02 08](#) # And a letter unto Asaph the keeper of the king's forest, that he may give me timber to make beams for the gates of the palace which [appertained] to the house, and for the wall of the city, and for the house that I shall enter into. And the king granted me, according to the good hand of my God upon me.

granted me life [18 JOB 10 12](#) # Thou hast granted me life and favour, and thy visitation hath preserved my spirit.

granted repentance unto [44 ACT 11 18](#) # When they heard these things, they held their peace, and glorified God, saying, Then hath God also to the Gentiles granted repentance unto life.

granted signs and [44 ACT 14 03](#) # Long time therefore abode they speaking boldly in the Lord, which gave testimony unto the word of his grace, and granted signs and wonders to be done by their hands.

granted that she [66 REV 19 08](#) # And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints.

granted the Jews [17 EST 08 11](#) # Wherein the king granted the Jews which [were] in every city to gather themselves together, and to stand for their life, to destroy, to slay, and to cause to perish, all the power of the people and province that would assault them, [both] little ones and women, and [to take] the spoil of them for a prey,

granted thee and [17 EST 05 06](#) # And the king said unto Esther at the banquet of wine, What [is] thy petition? and it shall be granted thee: and what [is] thy request? even to the half of the kingdom it shall be performed.

granted thee and [17 EST 07 02](#) # And the king said again unto Esther on the second day at the banquet of wine, What [is] thy petition, queen Esther? and it shall be granted thee: and what [is] thy request? and it shall be performed, [even] to the half of the kingdom.

granted thee or [17 EST 09 12](#) # And the king said unto Esther the queen, The Jews have slain and destroyed five hundred men in Shushan the palace, and the ten sons of Haman; what have they done in the rest of the king's provinces? now what [is] thy petition? and it shall be granted thee: or what [is] thy request further? and it shall be done.

granted to the [17 EST 09 13](#) # Then said Esther, If it please the king, let it be granted to the Jews which [are] in Shushan to do to morrow also according unto this day's decree, and let Haman's ten sons be hanged upon the gallows.

granted unto thee [14 2CH 01 12](#) # Wisdom and knowledge [is] granted unto thee; and I will give thee riches, and wealth, and honour, such as none of the kings have had that [have been] before thee, neither shall there any after thee have the like.

granted unto you [44 ACT 03 14](#) # But ye denied the Holy One and the Just, and desired a murderer to be granted unto you;

granted [20 PRO 10 24](#) # The fear of the wicked, it shall come upon him: but the desire of the righteous shall be granted.
