groaning all the [19_PSA_06_06](#) # I am weary with my groaning; all the night make I my bed to swim; I water my couch with my tears.

groaning and am [44_ACT_07_34](#) # I have seen, I have seen the affliction of my people which is in Egypt, and I have heard their groaning, and am come down to deliver them. And now come, I will send thee into Egypt.

groaning and God [02_EXO_02_24](#) # And God heard their groaning, and God remembered his covenant with Abraham, with Isaac, and with Jacob.

groaning in himself [43_JOH_11_38](#) # Jesus therefore again groaning in himself cometh to the grave. It was a cave, and a stone lay upon it.
