Hebrew and Greek 43\_JOH\_19\_20# This title then read many of the Jews: for the place where Jesus was crucified was night to the city: and it was written in Hebrew, [and] Greek, [and] Latin.

Hebrew and I <u>32\_JON\_01\_09</u> # And he said unto them, I [am] an Hebrew; and I fear the LORD, the God of heaven, which hath made the sea and the dry [land].
