Herod and from 44\_ACT\_12\_11 # And when Peter was come to himself, he said, Now I know of a surety, that the Lord hath sent his angel, and hath delivered me out of the hand of Herod, and [from] all the expectation of the people of the Jews.

Herod and Pontius 44\_ACT\_04\_27 # For of a truth against thy holy child Jesus, whom thou hast anointed, both Herod, and Pontius Pilate, with the Gentiles, and the people of Israel, were gathered together,

Herod being tetrarch <u>42\_LUK\_03\_01</u># Now in the fifteenth year of the reign of Tiberius Caesar, Pontius Pilate being governor of Judaea, and Herod being tetrarch of Galilee, and his brother Philip tetrarch of Ituraea and of the region of Trachonitis, and Lysanias the tetrarch of Abilene,

Herod feared John <u>41\_MAR\_06\_20</u> # For Herod feared John, knowing that he was a just man and an holy, and observed him; and when he heard him, he did many things, and heard him gladly.

Herod for I <u>42\_LUK\_23\_15</u> # No, nor yet Herod: for I sent you to him; and, lo, nothing worthy of death is done unto him.

Herod had done <u>42\_LUK\_03\_19</u># But Herod the tetrarch, being reproved by him for Herodias his brother Philip's wife, and for all the evils which Herod had done,

Herod the king <u>44\_ACT\_12\_01</u> # Now about that time Herod the king stretched forth [his] hands to vex certain of the church.

Herod the king <u>42 LUK\_01\_05</u># There was in the days of Herod, the king of Judaea, a certain priest named Zacharias, of the course of Abia: and his wife [was] of the daughters of Aaron, and her name [was] Elisabeth.

Herod will kill <u>42\_LUK\_13\_31</u> # The same day there came certain of the Pharisees, saying unto him, Get thee out, and depart hence: for Herod will kill thee.

Herod will seek <u>40\_MAT\_02\_13</u># And when they were departed, behold, the angel of the Lord appeareth to Joseph in a dream, saying, Arise, and take the young child and his mother, and flee into Egypt, and be thou there until I bring thee word: for Herod will seek the young child to destroy him.

Herod with his <u>42\_LUK\_23\_11</u># And Herod with his men of war set him at nought, and mocked [him], and arrayed him in a gorgeous robe, and sent him again to Pilate.
