languisheth all the <u>23\_ISA\_24\_07</u># The new wine mourneth, the vine languisheth, all the merryhearted do sigh.

languisheth and Carmel <u>34\_NAH\_01\_04</u> # He rebuketh the sea, and maketh it dry, and drieth up all the rivers: Bashan languisheth, and Carmel, and the flower of Lebanon languisheth.

languisheth and fadeth <u>23\_ISA\_24\_04</u># The earth mourneth [and] fadeth away, the world languisheth [and] fadeth away, the haughty people of the earth do languish.
