chew the cud [05 DEU 14 07](#) # Nevertheless these ye shall not eat of them that chew the cud, or of them that divide the cloven hoof; [as] the camel, and the hare, and the coney: for they chew the cud, but divide not the hoof; [therefore] they [are] unclean unto you.

chewed the wrath [04 NUM 11 33](#) # And while the flesh [was] yet between their teeth, ere it was chewed, the wrath of the LORD was kindled against the people, and the LORD smote the people with a very great plague.

cheweth not the [05 DEU 14 08](#) # And the swine, because it divideth the hoof, yet cheweth not the cud, it [is] unclean unto you: ye shall not eat of their flesh, nor touch their dead carcase.

cheweth not the [03 LEV 11 07](#) # And the swine, though he divide the hoof, and be clovenfooted, yet he cheweth not the cud; he [is] unclean to you.

cheweth the cud [05 DEU 14 06](#) # And every beast that parteth the hoof, and cleaveth the cleft into two claws, [and] cheweth the cud among the beasts, that ye shall eat.

cheweth the cud [03 LEV 11 03](#) # Whatsoever parteth the hoof, and is clovenfooted, [and] cheweth the cud, among the beasts, that shall ye eat.

cheweth the cud [03 LEV 11 04](#) # Nevertheless these shall ye not eat of them that chew the cud, or of them that divide the hoof: [as] the camel, because he cheweth the cud, but divideth not the hoof; he [is] unclean unto you.

cheweth the cud [03 LEV 11 05](#) # And the coney, because he cheweth the cud, but divideth not the hoof; he [is] unclean unto you.

cheweth the cud [03 LEV 11 06](#) # And the hare, because he cheweth the cud, but divideth not the hoof; he [is] unclean unto you.

cheweth the cud [03 LEV 11 26](#) # [The carcasses] of every beast which divideth the hoof, and [is] not clovenfooted, nor cheweth the cud, [are] unclean unto you: every one that toucheth them shall be unclean.

eschew evil and [60 1PE 03 11](#) # Let him eschew evil, and do good; let him seek peace, and ensue it.

eschewed evil [18 JOB 01 01](#) # There was a man in the land of Uz, whose name [was] Job; and that man was perfect and upright, and one that feared God, and eschewed evil.

escheweth evil and [18 JOB 02 03](#) # And the LORD said unto Satan, Hast thou considered my servant Job, that [there is] none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth God, and

escheweth evil? and still he holdeth fast his integrity, although thou movedst me against him, to destroy him without cause.

escheweth evil [18 JOB 01 08](#) # And the LORD said unto Satan, Hast thou considered my servant Job, that [there is] none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth God, and escheweth evil?

Hew down the [27 DAN 04 14](#) # He cried aloud, and said thus, Hew down the tree, and cut off his branches, shake off his leaves, and scatter his fruit: let the beasts get away from under it, and the fowls from his branches:

hew down the [05 DEU 12 03](#) # And ye shall overthrow their altars, and break their pillars, and burn their groves with fire; and ye shall hew down the graven images of their gods, and destroy the names of them out of that place.

hew in the [14 2CH 02 02](#) # And Solomon told out threescore and ten thousand men to bear burdens, and fourscore thousand to hew in the mountain, and three thousand and six hundred to oversee them.

hew me cedar [11 1KI 05 06](#) # Now therefore command thou that they hew me cedar trees out of Lebanon; and my servants shall be with thy servants: and unto thee will I give hire for thy servants according to all that thou shalt appoint: for thou knowest that [there is] not among us any that can skill to hew timber like unto the Sidonians.

Hew the tree [27 DAN 04 23](#) # And whereas the king saw a watcher and an holy one coming down from heaven, and saying, Hew the tree down, and destroy it; yet leave the stump of the roots thereof in the earth, even with a band of iron and brass, in the tender grass of the field; and let it be wet with the dew of heaven, and [let] his portion [be] with the beasts of the field, till seven times pass over him;

Hew thee two [05 DEU 10 01](#) # At that time the LORD said unto me, Hew thee two tables of stone like unto the first, and come up unto me into the mount, and make thee an ark of wood.

Hew thee two [02 EXO 34 01](#) # And the LORD said unto Moses, Hew thee two tables of stone like unto the first: and I will write upon [these] tables the words that were in the first tables, which thou brakest.

hew them and [11 1KI 05 18](#) # And Solomon's builders and Hiram's builders did hew [them], and the stonesquarers: so they prepared timber and stones to build the house.

hew wood and [05 DEU 19 05](#) # As when a man goeth into the wood with his neighbour to hew wood, and his hand fetcheth a stroke with the ax to cut down the tree, and the head slippeth from the helve, and lighteth upon his neighbour, that he die; he shall flee unto one of those cities, and live:

hew wrought stones [13 1CH 22 02](#) # And David commanded to gather together the strangers that [were] in the land of Israel; and he set masons to hew wrought stones to build the house of God.

Hew ye down [24 JER 06 06](#) # For thus hath the LORD of hosts said, Hew ye down trees, and cast a mount against Jerusalem: this [is] the city to be visited; she [is] wholly oppression in the midst of her.

hewed Agag in [09 ISA 15 33](#) # And Samuel said, As thy sword hath made women childless, so shall thy mother be childless among women. And Samuel hewed Agag in pieces before the LORD in Gilgal.

hewed stone and [11\\_1KI\\_06\\_36](#) # And he built the inner court with three rows of hewed stone, and a row of cedar beams.

hewed stone to [12\\_2KI\\_12\\_12](#) # And to masons, and hewers of stone, and to buy timber and hewed stone to repair the breaches of the house of the LORD, and for all that was laid out for the house to repair [it].

hewed stones and [11\\_1KI\\_07\\_11](#) # And above [were] costly stones, after the measures of hewed stones, and cedars.

hewed stones and [11\\_1KI\\_07\\_12](#) # And the great court round about [was] with three rows of hewed stones, and a row of cedar beams, both for the inner court of the house of the LORD, and for the porch of the house.

hewed stones sawed [11\\_1KI\\_07\\_09](#) # All these [were of] costly stones, according to the measures of hewed stones, sawed with saws, within and without, even from the foundation unto the coping, and [so] on the outside toward the great court.

hewed stones to [11\\_1KI\\_05\\_17](#) # And the king commanded, and they brought great stones, costly stones, [and] hewed stones, to lay the foundation of the house.

hewed thee out [23\\_ISA\\_22\\_16](#) # What hast thou here? and whom hast thou here, that thou hast hewed thee out a sepulchre here, [as] he that heweth him out a sepulchre on high, [and] that graveth an habitation for himself in a rock?

hewed them by [28\\_HOS\\_06\\_05](#) # Therefore have I hewed [them] by the prophets; I have slain them by the words of my mouth: and thy judgments [are as] the light [that] goeth forth.

hewed two tables [02\\_EXO\\_34\\_04](#) # And he hewed two tables of stone like unto the first; and Moses rose up early in the morning, and went up unto mount Sinai, as the LORD had commanded him, and took in his hand the two tables of stone.

hewer of thy [05\\_DEU\\_29\\_11](#) # Your little ones, your wives, and thy stranger that [is] in thy camp, from the hewer of thy wood unto the drawer of thy water:

hewers and workers [13\\_1CH\\_22\\_15](#) # Moreover [there are] workmen with thee in abundance, hewers and workers of stone and timber, and all manner of cunning men for every manner of work.

hewers in the [11\\_1KI\\_05\\_15](#) # And Solomon had threescore and ten thousand that bare burdens, and fourscore thousand hewers in the mountains;

hewers in the [14\\_2CH\\_02\\_18](#) # And he set threescore and ten thousand of them [to be] bearers of burdens, and fourscore thousand [to be] hewers in the mountain, and three thousand and six hundred overseers to set the people a work.

hewers of stone [12\\_2KI\\_12\\_12](#) # And to masons, and hewers of stone, and to buy timber and hewed stone to repair the breaches of the house of the LORD, and for all that was laid out for the house to repair [it].

hewers of wood [24\\_JER\\_46\\_22](#) # The voice thereof shall go like a serpent; for they shall march with an army, and come against her with axes, as hewers of wood.

hewers of wood [06\\_JOS\\_09\\_21](#) # And the princes said unto them, Let them live; but let them be hewers of wood and drawers of water unto all the congregation; as the princes had promised them.

hewers of wood [06\\_JOS\\_09\\_23](#) # Now therefore ye [are] cursed, and there shall none of you be freed from being bondmen, and hewers of wood and drawers of water for the house of my God.

hewers of wood [06\\_JOS\\_09\\_27](#) # And Joshua made them that day hewers of wood and drawers of water for the congregation, and for the altar of the LORD, even unto this day, in the place which he should choose.

hewers that cut [14\\_2CH\\_02\\_10](#) # And, behold, I will give to thy servants, the hewers that cut timber, twenty thousand measures of beaten wheat, and twenty thousand measures of barley, and twenty thousand baths of wine, and twenty thousand baths of oil.

heweth him down [23\\_ISA\\_44\\_14](#) # He heweth him down cedars, and taketh the cypress and the oak, which he strengtheneth for himself among the trees of the forest: he planteth an ash, and the rain doth nourish [it].

heweth him out [23\\_ISA\\_22\\_16](#) # What hast thou here? and whom hast thou here, that thou hast hewed thee out a sepulchre here, [as] he that heweth him out a sepulchre on high, [and] that graveth an habitation for himself in a rock?

heweth therewith or [23\\_ISA\\_10\\_15](#) # Shall the ax boast itself against him that heweth therewith? [or] shall the saw magnify itself against him that shaketh it? as if the rod should shake [itself] against them that lift it up, [or] as if the staff should lift up [itself, as if it were] no wood.

hewn and to [23\\_ISA\\_51\\_01](#) # Harken to me, ye that follow after righteousness, ye that seek the LORD: look unto the rock [whence] ye are hewn, and to the hole of the pit [whence] ye are digged.

hewn down and [23\\_ISA\\_10\\_33](#) # Behold, the Lord, the LORD of hosts, shall lop the bough with terror: and the high ones of stature [shall be] hewn down, and the haughty shall be humbled.

hewn down and [42\\_LUK\\_03\\_09](#) # And now also the ax is laid unto the root of the trees: every tree therefore which bringeth not forth good fruit is hewn down, and cast into the fire.

hewn down and [40\\_MAT\\_03\\_10](#) # And now also the ax is laid unto the root of the trees: therefore every tree which bringeth not forth good fruit is hewn down, and cast into the fire.

hewn down and [40\\_MAT\\_07\\_19](#) # Every tree that bringeth not forth good fruit is hewn down, and cast into the fire.

hewn down Sharon [23\\_ISA\\_33\\_09](#) # The earth mourneth [and] languisheth: Lebanon is ashamed [and] hewn down: Sharon is like a wilderness; and Bashan and Carmel shake off [their fruits].

hewn in stone [42\\_LUK\\_23\\_53](#) # And he took it down, and wrapped it in linen, and laid it in a sepulchre that was hewn in stone, wherein never man before was laid.

hewn out her [20\\_PRO\\_09\\_01](#) # Wisdom hath builded her house, she hath hewn out her seven pillars:

hewn out in [40\\_MAT\\_27\\_60](#) # And laid it in his own new tomb, which he had hewn out in the rock: and he

rolled a great stone to the door of the sepulchre, and departed.

hewn out of [41 MAR 15 46](#) # And he bought fine linen, and took him down, and wrapped him in the linen, and laid him in a sepulchre which was hewn out of a rock, and rolled a stone unto the door of the sepulchre.

hewn stone and [14 2CH 34 11](#) # Even to the artificers and builders gave they [it], to buy hewn stone, and timber for couplings, and to floor the houses which the kings of Judah had destroyed.

hewn stone but [30 AMO 05 11](#) # Forasmuch therefore as your treading [is] upon the poor, and ye take from him burdens of wheat: ye have built houses of hewn stone, but ye shall not dwell in them; ye have planted pleasant vineyards, but ye shall not drink wine of them.

hewn stone for [26 EZE 40 42](#) # And the four tables [were] of hewn stone for the burnt offering, of a cubit and an half long, and a cubit and an half broad, and one cubit high: whereupon also they laid the instruments wherewith they slew the burnt offering and the sacrifice.

hewn stone he [25 LAM 03 09](#) # He hath enclosed my ways with hewn stone, he hath made my paths crooked.

hewn stone to [12 2KI 22 06](#) # Unto carpenters, and builders, and masons, and to buy timber and hewn stone to repair the house.

hewn stones the [23 ISA 09 10](#) # The bricks are fallen down, but we will build with hewn stones: the sycamores are cut down, but we will change [them into] cedars.

Matthew and Thomas [42 LUK 06 15](#) # Matthew and Thomas, James the [son] of Alphaeus, and Simon called Zelotes,

nephew among his [18 JOB 18 19](#) # He shall neither have son nor nephew among his people, nor any remaining in his dwellings.

nephew saith the [23 ISA 14 22](#) # For I will rise up against them, saith the LORD of hosts, and cut off from Babylon the name, and remnant, and son, and nephew, saith the LORD.

nephews let them [54 1TI 05 04](#) # But if any widow have children or nephews, let them learn first to show piety at home, and to requite their parents: for that is good and acceptable before God.

nephews that rode [07 JUD 12 14](#) # And he had forty sons and thirty nephews, that rode on threescore and

**ten ass colts: and he judged Israel eight years.**
