changeable suits of <u>23\_ISA\_03\_22</u> # The changeable suits of apparel, and the mantles, and the wimples, and the crisping pins,

hang any vessel <u>26\_EZE\_15\_03</u># Shall wood be taken thereof to do any work? or will [men] take a pin of it to hang any vessel thereon?

hang down and 58\_HEB\_12\_12 # Wherefore lift up the hands which hang down, and the feeble knees;

hang down their <u>25\_LAM\_02\_10</u> # The elders of the daughter of Zion sit upon the ground, [and] keep silence: they have cast up dust upon their heads; they have girded themselves with sackcloth: the virgins of Jerusalem hang down their heads to the ground.

hang him on <u>05\_DEU\_21\_22</u> # And if a man have committed a sin worthy of death, and he be to be put to death, and thou hang him on a tree:

Hang him thereon <u>17\_EST\_07\_09</u># And Harbonah, one of the chamberlains, said before the king, Behold also, the gallows fifty cubits high, which Haman had made for Mordecai, who had spoken good for the king, standeth in the house of Haman. Then the king said, Hang him thereon.

hang in doubt <u>05\_DEU\_28\_66</u># And thy life shall hang in doubt before thee; and thou shalt fear day and night, and shalt have none assurance of thy life:

hang it upon <u>02\_EXO\_26\_32</u> # And thou shalt hang it upon four pillars of shittim [wood] overlaid with gold: their hooks [shall be of] gold, upon the four sockets of silver.

hang Mordecai on 17 EST 06 04 # And the king said, Who [is] in the court? Now Haman was come into the outward court of the king's house, to speak unto the king to hang Mordecai on the gallows that he had prepared for him.

hang on his <u>44\_ACT\_28\_04</u> # And when the barbarians saw the [venomous] beast hang on his hand, they said among themselves, No doubt this man is a murderer, whom, though he hath escaped the sea, yet vengeance suffereth not to live.

hang over the <u>02\_EXO\_26\_12</u> # And the remnant that remaineth of the curtains of the tent, the half curtain that remaineth, shall hang over the backside of the tabernacle.

hang over the <u>02\_EXO\_26\_13</u># And a cubit on the one side, and a cubit on the other side of that which remaineth in the length of the curtains of the tent, it shall hang over the sides of the tabernacle on this side and on that side, to cover it.

hanged Haman on <u>17\_EST\_07\_10</u># So they hanged Haman on the gallows that he had prepared for Mordecai. Then was the king's wrath pacified.

hanged Haman's ten <u>17\_EST\_09\_14</u> # And the king commanded it so to be done: and the decree was given at Shushan; and they hanged Haman's ten sons.

hanged himself and <u>10\_2SA\_17\_23</u># And when Ahithophel saw that his counsel was not followed, he saddled [his] ass, and arose, and gat him home to his house, to his city, and put his household in order, and hanged himself, and died, and was buried in the sepulchre of his father.

hanged himself <u>40\_MAT\_27\_05</u># And he cast down the pieces of silver in the temple, and departed, and went and hanged himself.

hanged in an <u>10\_2SA\_18\_10</u># And a certain man saw [it], and told Joab, and said, Behold, I saw Absalom hanged in an oak.

hanged is accursed <u>05\_DEU\_21\_23</u># His body shall not remain all night upon the tree, but thou shalt in any wise bury him that day; [for he that is hanged [is] accursed of God;] that thy land be not defiled, which the LORD thy God giveth thee [for] an inheritance.

hanged on a 44\_ACT\_05\_30 # The God of our fathers raised up Jesus, whom ye slew and hanged on a tree.

hanged on a <u>44\_ACT\_10\_39</u> # And we are witnesses of all things which he did both in the land of the Jews, and in Jerusalem; whom they slew and hanged on a tree:

hanged on a <u>17\_EST\_02\_23</u> # And when inquisition was made of the matter, it was found out; therefore they were both hanged on a tree: and it was written in the book of the chronicles before the king.

hanged on a <u>06\_JOS\_08\_29</u># And the king of Ai he hanged on a tree until eventide: and as soon as the sun was down, Joshua commanded that they should take his carcase down from the tree, and cast it at the entering of the gate of the city, and raise thereon a great heap of stones, [that remaineth] unto this day.

hanged railed on <u>42\_LUK\_23\_39</u> # And one of the malefactors which were hanged railed on him, saying, If thou be Christ, save thyself and us.

hanged the chief 01\_GEN\_40\_22 # But he hanged the chief baker: as Joseph had interpreted to them.

hanged the shield <u>26\_EZE\_27\_10</u> # They of Persia and of Lud and of Phut were in thine army, thy men of war: they hanged the shield and helmet in thee; they set forth thy comeliness.

hanged their shields <u>26\_EZE\_27\_11</u># The men of Arvad with thine army [were] upon thy walls round about, and the Gammadims were in thy towers: they hanged their shields upon thy walls round about; they have made thy beauty perfect.

hanged them in 10\_2SA\_21\_09 # And he delivered them into the hands of the Gibeonites, and they hanged them in the hill before the LORD: and they fell [all] seven together, and were put to death in the days of harvest, in the first [days], in the beginning of barley harvest.

hanged them on <u>06\_JOS\_10\_26</u> # And afterward Joshua smote them, and slew them, and hanged them on five trees: and they were hanging upon the trees until the evening.

hanged them up 10\_2SA\_04\_12# And David commanded his young men, and they slew them, and cut off their hands and their feet, and hanged [them] up over the pool in Hebron. But they took the head of Ishbosheth, and buried [it] in the sepulchre of Abner in Hebron.

hanged them when <u>10\_2SA\_21\_12</u># And David went and took the bones of Saul and the bones of Jonathan his son from the men of Jabeshgilead, which had stolen them from the street of Bethshan, where the Philistines had hanged them, when the Philistines had slain Saul in Gilboa:

hanged thereon and 15 EZR 06 11 # Also I have made a decree, that whosoever shall alter this word, let timber be pulled down from his house, and being set up, let him be hanged thereon; and let his house be made a dunghill for this.

hanged thereon then <u>17\_EST\_05\_14</u># Then said Zeresh his wife and all his friends unto him, Let a gallows be made of fifty cubits high, and to morrow speak thou unto the king that Mordecai may be hanged thereon: then go thou in merrily with the king unto the banquet. And the thing pleased Haman; and he caused the gallows to be made.

hanged up by <u>25\_LAM\_05\_12</u># Princes are hanged up by their hand: the faces of elders were not honoured.

hanged upon the <u>17\_EST\_08\_07</u># Then the king Ahasuerus said unto Esther the queen and to Mordecai the Jew, Behold, I have given Esther the house of Haman, and him they have hanged upon the gallows, because he laid his hand upon the Jews.

hanged upon the <u>17\_EST\_09\_13</u> # Then said Esther, If it please the king, let it be granted to the Jews which [are] in Shushan to do to morrow also according unto this day's decree, and let Haman's ten sons be hanged upon the gallows.

hanged <u>10\_2SA\_21\_13</u> # And he brought up from thence the bones of Saul and the bones of Jonathan his son; and they gathered the bones of them that were hanged.
