changed according to [27_DAN_06_08](#) # Now, O king, establish the decree, and sign the writing, that it be not changed, according to the law of the Medes and Persians, which altereth not.

changed against Shadrach [27_DAN_03_19](#) # Then was Nebuchadnezzar full of fury, and the form of his visage was changed against Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego: [therefore] he spake, and commanded that they should heat the furnace one seven times more than it was wont to be heated.

changed and his [27_DAN_05_06](#) # Then the king's countenance was changed, and his thoughts troubled him, so that the joints of his loins were loosed, and his knees smote one against another.

changed and Shibmah [04_NUM_32_38](#) # And Nebo, and Baalmeon, [their names being changed,] and Shibmah: and gave other names unto the cities which they builded.

changed but thou [58_HEB_01_12](#) # And as a vesture shalt thou fold them up, and they shall be changed: but thou art the same, and thy years shall not fail.

changed concerning Daniel [27_DAN_06_17](#) # And a stone was brought, and laid upon the mouth of the den; and the king sealed it with his own signet, and with the signet of his lords; that the purpose might not be changed concerning Daniel.

changed from man's [27_DAN_04_16](#) # Let his heart be changed from man's, and let a beast's heart be given unto him: and let seven times pass over him.

changed his apparel [10_2SA_12_20](#) # Then David arose from the earth, and washed, and anointed [himself], and changed his apparel, and came into the house of the LORD, and worshipped: then he came to his own house; and when he required, they set bread before him, and he did eat.

changed his behaviour [09_1SA_21_13](#) # And he changed his behaviour before them, and feigned himself mad in their hands, and scrabbled on the doors of the gate, and let his spittle fall down upon his beard.

changed his behaviour [19_PSA_34_01](#) # [A Psalm] of David, when he changed his behaviour before Abimelech; who drove him away, and he departed. I will bless the LORD at all times: his praise [shall] continually [be] in my mouth.

changed his colour [03_LEV_13_55](#) # And the priest shall look on the plague, after that it is washed: and, behold, [if] the plague have not changed his colour, and the plague be not spread; it [is] unclean; thou shalt burn it in the fire; it [is] fret inward, [whether] it [be] bare within or without.

changed his name [12_2KI_24_17](#) # And the king of Babylon made Mattaniah his father's brother king in his stead, and changed his name to Zedekiah.

changed his prison [12_2KI_25_29](#) # And changed his prison garments: and he did eat bread continually before him all the days of his life.

changed his prison [24_JER_52_33](#) # And changed his prison garments: and he did continually eat bread before him all the days of his life.

changed his raiment [01_GEN_41_14](#) # Then Pharaoh sent and called Joseph, and they brought him hastily

out of the dungeon: and he shaved [himself], and changed his raiment, and came in unto Pharaoh.

changed in him [27 DAN 05 09](#) # Then was king Belshazzar greatly troubled, and his countenance was changed in him, and his lords were astonished.

changed in me [27 DAN 07 28](#) # Hitherto [is] the end of the matter. As for me Daniel, my cogitations much troubled me, and my countenance changed in me: but I kept the matter in my heart.

changed into the [47 2CO 03 18](#) # But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, [even] as by the Spirit of the Lord.

changed it bindeth [18 JOB 30 18](#) # By the great force [of my disease] is my garment changed: it bindeth me about as the collar of my coat.

changed my judgments [26 EZE 05 06](#) # And she hath changed my judgments into wickedness more than the nations, and my statutes more than the countries that [are] round about her: for they have refused my judgments and my statutes, they have not walked in them.

changed my wages [01 GEN 31 07](#) # And your father hath deceived me, and changed my wages ten times; but God suffered him not to hurt me.

changed my wages [01 GEN 31 41](#) # Thus have I been twenty years in thy house; I served thee fourteen years for thy two daughters, and six years for thy cattle: and thou hast changed my wages ten times.

changed nor the [27 DAN 03 27](#) # And the princes, governors, and captains, and the king's counsellors, being gathered together, saw these men, upon whose bodies the fire had no power, nor was an hair of their head singed, neither were their coats changed, nor the smell of fire had passed on them.

changed the glory [45 ROM 01 23](#) # And changed the glory of the uncorruptible God into an image made like to corruptible man, and to birds, and fourfooted beasts, and creeping things.

changed the king's [27 DAN 03 28](#) # [Then] Nebuchadnezzar spake, and said, Blessed [be] the God of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, who hath sent his angel, and delivered his servants that trusted in him, and have changed the king's word, and yielded their bodies, that they might not serve nor worship any god, except their own God.

changed the ordinance [23 ISA 24 05](#) # The earth also is defiled under the inhabitants thereof; because they have transgressed the laws, changed the ordinance, broken the everlasting covenant.

changed the portion [33 MIC 02 04](#) # In that day shall [one] take up a parable against you, and lament with a doleful lamentation, [and] say, We be utterly spoiled: he hath changed the portion of my people: how hath he removed [it] from me! turning away he hath divided our fields.

changed the stones [25 LAM 04 01](#) # How is the gold become dim! [how] is the most fine gold changed! the stones of the sanctuary are poured out in the top of every street.

changed the truth [45 ROM 01 25](#) # Who changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator, who is blessed for ever. Amen.

changed their glory [24 JER 02 11](#) # Hath a nation changed [their] gods, which [are] yet no gods? but my people have changed their glory for [that which] doth not profit.

changed their glory [19 PSA 106 20](#) # Thus they changed their glory into the similitude of an ox that eateth grass.

changed their gods [24 JER 02 11](#) # Hath a nation changed [their] gods, which [are] yet no gods? but my people have changed their glory for [that which] doth not profit.

changed their minds [44 ACT 28 06](#) # Howbeit they looked when he should have swollen, or fallen down dead suddenly: but after they had looked a great while, and saw no harm come to him, they changed their minds, and said that he was a god.

changed there is [58 HEB 07 12](#) # For the priesthood being changed, there is made of necessity a change also of the law.

changed therefore tell [27 DAN 02 09](#) # But if ye will not make known unto me the dream, [there is but] one decree for you: for ye have prepared lying and corrupt words to speak before me, till the time be changed: therefore tell me the dream, and I shall know that ye can show me the interpretation thereof.

changed unto white [03 LEV 13 16](#) # Or if the raw flesh turn again, and be changed unto white, he shall come unto the priest;

changed [46 1CO 15 51](#) # Behold, I show you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,

changed [46 1CO 15 52](#) # In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

changed [27 DAN 05 10](#) # [Now] the queen by reason of the words of the king and his lords came into the banquet house: [and] the queen spake and said, O king, live for ever: let not thy thoughts trouble thee, nor let thy countenance be changed:

changed [27 DAN 06 15](#) # Then these men assembled unto the king, and said unto the king, Know, O king, that the law of the Medes and Persians [is], That no decree nor statute which the king establisheth may be changed.

changed [21 ECC 08 01](#) # Who [is] as the wise [man]? and who knoweth the interpretation of a thing? a man's wisdom maketh his face to shine, and the boldness of his face shall be changed.

changed [24 JER 48 11](#) # Moab hath been at ease from his youth, and he hath settled on his lees, and hath not been emptied from vessel to vessel, neither hath he gone into captivity: therefore his taste remained in him, and his scent is not changed.

changed [19 PSA 102 26](#) # They shall perish, but thou shalt endure: yea, all of them shall wax old like a garment; as a vesture shalt thou change them, and they shall be changed:

hanged about his [42 LUK 17 02](#) # It were better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and he cast into the sea, than that he should offend one of these little ones.

hanged about his [41 MAR 09 42](#) # And whosoever shall offend one of [these] little ones that believe in me, it is better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and he were cast into the sea.

hanged about his [40 MAT 18 06](#) # But whoso shall offend one of these little ones which believe in me, it were better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and [that] he were drowned in the depth of the sea.

hanged Haman on [17 EST 07 10](#) # So they hanged Haman on the gallows that he had prepared for Mordecai. Then was the king's wrath pacified.

hanged Haman's ten [17 EST 09 14](#) # And the king commanded it so to be done: and the decree was given at Shushan; and they hanged Haman's ten sons.

hanged himself and [10 2SA 17 23](#) # And when Ahithophel saw that his counsel was not followed, he saddled [his] ass, and arose, and gat him home to his house, to his city, and put his household in order, and hanged himself, and died, and was buried in the sepulchre of his father.

hanged himself [40 MAT 27 05](#) # And he cast down the pieces of silver in the temple, and departed, and went and hanged himself.

hanged in an [10 2SA 18 10](#) # And a certain man saw [it], and told Joab, and said, Behold, I saw Absalom hanged in an oak.

hanged is accursed [05 DEU 21 23](#) # His body shall not remain all night upon the tree, but thou shalt in any wise bury him that day; [for he that is hanged [is] accursed of God;] that thy land be not defiled, which the LORD thy God giveth thee [for] an inheritance.

hanged on a [44 ACT 05 30](#) # The God of our fathers raised up Jesus, whom ye slew and hanged on a tree.

hanged on a [44 ACT 10 39](#) # And we are witnesses of all things which he did both in the land of the Jews, and in Jerusalem; whom they slew and hanged on a tree:

hanged on a [17 EST 02 23](#) # And when inquisition was made of the matter, it was found out; therefore they were both hanged on a tree: and it was written in the book of the chronicles before the king.

hanged on a [06 JOS 08 29](#) # And the king of Ai he hanged on a tree until eventide: and as soon as the sun was down, Joshua commanded that they should take his carcase down from the tree, and cast it at the entering of the gate of the city, and raise thereon a great heap of stones, [that remaineth] unto this day.

hanged on the [17 EST 09 25](#) # But when [Esther] came before the king, he commanded by letters that his wicked device, which he devised against the Jews, should return upon his own head, and that he and his sons should be hanged on the gallows.

hanged our harps [19 PSA 137 02](#) # We hanged our harps upon the willows in the midst thereof.

hanged railed on [42 LUK 23 39](#) # And one of the malefactors which were hanged railed on him, saying, If thou be Christ, save thyself and us.

hanged the chief [01 GEN 40 22](#) # But he hanged the chief baker: as Joseph had interpreted to them.

hanged the shield [26 EZE 27 10](#) # They of Persia and of Lud and of Phut were in thine army, thy men of war: they hanged the shield and helmet in thee; they set forth thy comeliness.

hanged their shields [26 EZE 27 11](#) # The men of Arvad with thine army [were] upon thy walls round about, and the Gammadims were in thy towers: they hanged their shields upon thy walls round about; they have made thy beauty perfect.

hanged them in [10 2SA 21 09](#) # And he delivered them into the hands of the Gibeonites, and they hanged them in the hill before the LORD: and they fell [all] seven together, and were put to death in the days of harvest, in the first [days], in the beginning of barley harvest.

hanged them on [06 JOS 10 26](#) # And afterward Joshua smote them, and slew them, and hanged them on five trees: and they were hanging upon the trees until the evening.

hanged them up [10 2SA 04 12](#) # And David commanded his young men, and they slew them, and cut off their hands and their feet, and hanged [them] up over the pool in Hebron. But they took the head of Ishbosheth, and buried [it] in the sepulchre of Abner in Hebron.

hanged them when [10 2SA 21 12](#) # And David went and took the bones of Saul and the bones of Jonathan his son from the men of Jabeshgilead, which had stolen them from the street of Bethshan, where the Philistines had hanged them, when the Philistines had slain Saul in Gilboa:

hanged thereon and [15 EZR 06 11](#) # Also I have made a decree, that whosoever shall alter this word, let timber be pulled down from his house, and being set up, let him be hanged thereon; and let his house be made a dunghill for this.

hanged thereon then [17 EST 05 14](#) # Then said Zeresh his wife and all his friends unto him, Let a gallows be made of fifty cubits high, and to morrow speak thou unto the king that Mordecai may be hanged thereon: then go thou in merrily with the king unto the banquet. And the thing pleased Haman; and he caused the gallows to be made.

hanged up by [25 LAM 05 12](#) # Princes are hanged up by their hand: the faces of elders were not honoured.

hanged upon the [17 EST 08 07](#) # Then the king Ahasuerus said unto Esther the queen and to Mordecai the Jew, Behold, I have given Esther the house of Haman, and him they have hanged upon the gallows, because he laid his hand upon the Jews.

hanged upon the [17 EST 09 13](#) # Then said Esther, If it please the king, let it be granted to the Jews which [are] in Shushan to do to morrow also according unto this day's decree, and let Haman's ten sons be hanged upon the gallows.

hanged [10 2SA 21 13](#) # And he brought up from thence the bones of Saul and the bones of Jonathan his son; and they gathered the bones of them that were hanged.

hanged [01 GEN 41 13](#) # And it came to pass, as he interpreted to us, so it was; me he restored unto mine office, and him he hanged.
