hard after him <u>10\_2SA\_01\_06</u># And the young man that told him said, As I happened by chance upon mount Gilboa, behold, Saul leaned upon his spear; and, lo, the chariots and horsemen followed hard after him.

hard after Saul <u>13\_1CH\_10\_02</u># And the Philistines followed hard after Saul, and after his sons; and the Philistines slew Jonathan, and Abinadab, and Malchishua, the sons of Saul.

hard after thee 19\_PSA\_63\_08 # My soul followeth hard after thee: thy right hand upholdeth me.

hard after them <u>09\_1SA\_14\_22</u> # Likewise all the men of Israel which had hid themselves in mount Ephraim, [when] they heard that the Philistines fled, even they also followed hard after them in the battle.

hard after them <u>07\_JUD\_20\_45</u># And they turned and fled toward the wilderness unto the rock of Rimmon: and they gleaned of them in the highways five thousand men; and pursued hard after them unto Gidom, and slew two thousand men of them.

hard as a 18\_JOB\_41\_24 # His heart is as firm as a stone; yea, as hard as a piece of the nether [millstone].

hard for me 24\_JER\_32\_27 # Behold, I [am] the LORD, the God of all flesh: is there any thing too hard for

hard for the <u>01\_GEN\_18\_14</u># Is any thing too hard for the LORD? At the time appointed I will return unto thee, according to the time of life, and Sarah shall have a son.

hard for thee 44\_ACT\_09\_05# And he said, Who art thou, Lord? And the Lord said, I am Jesus whom thou persecutest: [it is] hard for thee to kick against the pricks.

hard for thee <u>44\_ACT\_26\_14</u># And when we were all fallen to the earth, I heard a voice speaking unto me, and saying in the Hebrew tongue, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me? [it is] hard for thee to kick against the pricks.

hard for thee <u>05\_DEU\_17\_08</u># If there arise a matter too hard for thee in judgment, between blood and blood, between plea and plea, and between stroke and stroke, [being] matters of controversy within thy gates: then shalt thou arise, and get thee up into the place which the LORD thy God shall choose;

hard for thee <u>24\_JER\_32\_17</u># Ah Lord GOD! behold, thou hast made the heaven and the earth by thy great power and stretched out arm, [and] there is nothing too hard for thee:

hard man reaping 40 MAT 25 24 # Then he which had received the one talent came and said, Lord, I knew thee that thou art an hard man, reaping where thou hast not sown, and gathering where thou hast not strowed:

hard questions at <u>14\_2CH\_09\_01</u># And when the queen of Sheba heard of the fame of Solomon, she came to prove Solomon with hard questions at Jerusalem, with a very great company, and camels that bare spices, and gold in abundance, and precious stones: and when she was come to Solomon, she communed with him of all that was in her heart.

hard questions 11\_1KI\_10\_01# And when the queen of Sheba heard of the fame of Solomon concerning the name of the LORD, she came to prove him with hard questions.

hard saying who 43\_JOH\_06\_60 # Many therefore of his disciples, when they had heard [this], said, This is an hard saying; who can hear it?

hard sentences and 27\_DAN\_05\_12 # Forasmuch as an excellent spirit, and knowledge, and understanding,

interpreting of dreams, and showing of hard sentences, and dissolving of doubts, were found in the same Daniel, whom the king named Belteshazzar: now let Daniel be called, and he will show the interpretation.

hard speeches which <u>65\_JDE\_01\_15</u># To execute judgment upon all, and to convince all that are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have ungodly committed, and of all their hard [speeches] which ungodly sinners have spoken against him.

hard thing nevertheless 12 2KI 02 10 # And he said, Thou hast asked a hard thing: [nevertheless], if thou see me [when I am] taken from thee, it shall be so unto thee; but if not, it shall not be [so].

hard things and 19\_PSA\_94\_04 # [How long] shall they utter [and] speak hard things? [and] all the workers of iniquity boast themselves?

hard things thou 19\_PSA\_60\_03 # Thou hast showed thy people hard things: thou hast made us to drink the wine of astonishment.

hard to be <u>61\_2PE\_03\_16</u> # As also in all [his] epistles, speaking in them of these things; in which are some things hard to be understood, which they that are unlearned and unstable wrest, as [they do] also the other scriptures, unto their own destruction.

hard to be <u>58\_HEB\_05\_11</u># Of whom we have many things to say, and hard to be uttered, seeing ye are dull of hearing.

hard to bring 32\_JON\_01\_13 # Nevertheless the men rowed hard to bring [it] to the land; but they could not: for the sea wrought, and was tempestuous against them.

hard to the <u>44\_ACT\_18\_07</u># And he departed thence, and entered into a certain [man's] house, named Justus, [one] that worshipped God, whose house joined hard to the synagogue.

hard unto the <u>07\_JUD\_09\_52</u> # And Abimelech came unto the tower, and fought against it, and went hard unto the door of the tower to burn it with fire.

hard 20 PRO 13 15 # Good understanding giveth favour: but the way of transgressors [is] hard.

harden his heart <u>02\_EXO\_04\_21</u># And the LORD said unto Moses, When thou goest to return into Egypt, see that thou do all those wonders before Pharaoh, which I have put in thine hand: but I will harden his heart, that he shall not let the people go.

harden myself in <u>18\_JOB\_06\_10</u> # Then should I yet have comfort; yea, I would harden myself in sorrow: let him not spare; for I have not concealed the words of the Holy One.

Harden not your <u>58\_HEB\_03\_08</u># Harden not your hearts, as in the provocation, in the day of temptation in the wilderness:

harden not your 58\_HEB\_03\_15 # While it is said, To day if ye will hear his voice, harden not your hearts,

as in the provocation.

harden not your <u>58\_HEB\_04\_07</u># Again, he limiteth a certain day, saying in David, To day, after so long a time; as it is said, To day if ye will hear his voice, harden not your hearts.

Harden not your 19\_PSA\_95\_08 # Harden not your heart, as in the provocation, [and] as [in] the day of temptation in the wilderness:

harden Pharaoh's heart <u>02\_EXO\_07\_03</u> # And I will harden Pharaoh's heart, and multiply my signs and my wonders in the land of Egypt.

harden Pharaoh's heart <u>02\_EXO\_14\_04</u># And I will harden Pharaoh's heart, that he shall follow after them; and I will be honoured upon Pharaoh, and upon all his host; that the Egyptians may know that I [am] the LORD. And they did so.

harden the hearts <u>02\_EXO\_14\_17</u># And I, behold, I will harden the hearts of the Egyptians, and they shall follow them: and I will get me honour upon Pharaoh, and upon all his host, upon his chariots, and upon his horsemen.

harden their hearts <u>06\_JOS\_11\_20</u># For it was of the LORD to harden their hearts, that they should come against Israel in battle, that he might destroy them utterly, [and] that they might have no favour, but that he might destroy them, as the LORD commanded Moses.

hardened and he <u>02\_EXO\_08\_19</u> # Then the magicians said unto Pharaoh, This [is] the finger of God: and Pharaoh's heart was hardened, and he hearkened not unto them; as the LORD had said.

hardened and he <u>02\_EXO\_09\_07</u># And Pharaoh sent, and, behold, there was not one of the cattle of the Israelites dead. And the heart of Pharaoh was hardened, and he did not let the people go.

hardened he refuseth <u>02\_EXO\_07\_14</u># And the LORD said unto Moses, Pharaoh's heart [is] hardened, he refuseth to let the people go.

hardened himself against <u>18\_JOB\_09\_04</u> # [He is] wise in heart, and mighty in strength: who hath hardened [himself] against him, and hath prospered?

hardened his heart <u>14\_2CH\_36\_13</u># And he also rebelled against king Nebuchadnezzar, who had made him swear by God: but he stiffened his neck, and hardened his heart from turning unto the LORD God of Israel.

hardened his heart 02\_EXO\_08\_15 # But when Pharaoh saw that there was respite, he hardened his heart,

and hearkened not unto them; as the LORD had said.

hardened his heart <u>02\_EXO\_08\_32</u># And Pharaoh hardened his heart at this time also, neither would he let the people go.

hardened neither would <u>02\_EXO\_09\_35</u> # And the heart of Pharaoh was hardened, neither would he let the children of Israel go; as the LORD had spoken by Moses.

hardened our heart 23\_ISA\_63\_17 # O LORD, why hast thou made us to err from thy ways, [and] hardened our heart from thy fear? Return for thy servants' sake, the tribes of thine inheritance.

hardened Pharaoh's heart <u>02\_EXO\_07\_13</u># And he hardened Pharaoh's heart, that he hearkened not unto them; as the LORD had said.

hardened Pharaoh's heart <u>02\_EXO\_10\_20</u># But the LORD hardened Pharaoh's heart, so that he would not let the children of Israel go.

hardened Pharaoh's heart <u>02\_EXO\_10\_27</u># But the LORD hardened Pharaoh's heart, and he would not let them go.

hardened their necks <u>16\_NEH\_09\_16</u># But they and our fathers dealt proudly, and hardened their necks, and hearkened not to thy commandments,

hardened their necks <u>16\_NEH\_09\_17</u> # And refused to obey, neither were mindful of thy wonders that thou didst among them; but hardened their necks, and in their rebellion appointed a captain to return to their bondage: but thou [art] a God ready to pardon, gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and forsookest them not.

hardened through the <u>58\_HEB\_03\_13</u># But exhort one another daily, while it is called To day; lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin.

hardened <u>41\_MAR\_06\_52</u> # For they considered not [the miracle] of the loaves: for their heart was hardened.

hardened <u>41\_MAR\_08\_17</u> # And when Jesus knew [it], he saith unto them, Why reason ye, because ye have no bread? perceive ye not yet, neither understand? have ye your heart yet hardened?

hardeneth his face <u>20\_PRO\_21\_29</u> # A wicked man hardeneth his face: but [as for] the upright, he directeth his way.

hardeneth his heart 20\_PRO\_28\_14 # Happy [is] the man that feareth alway: but he that hardeneth his heart shall fall into mischief.

hardeneth his neck <u>20\_PRO\_29\_01</u># He, that being often reproved hardeneth [his] neck, shall suddenly be destroyed, and that without remedy.

hardeneth <u>45\_ROM\_09\_18</u> # Therefore hath he mercy on whom he will [have mercy], and whom he will he hardeneth.

harder than a 24\_JER\_05\_03 # O LORD, [are] not thine eyes upon the truth? thou hast stricken them, but they have not grieved; thou hast consumed them, [but] they have refused to receive correction: they have made their faces harder than a rock; they have refused to return.

harder than flint <u>26\_EZE\_03\_09</u> # As an adamant harder than flint have I made thy forehead: fear them not, neither be dismayed at their looks, though they [be] a rebellious house.

harder to be <u>20\_PRO\_18\_19</u> # A brother offended [is harder to be won] than a strong city: and [their] contentions [are] like the bars of a castle.

hardhearted <u>26\_EZE\_03\_07</u> # But the house of Israel will not hearken unto thee; for they will not hearken unto me: for all the house of Israel [are] impudent and hardhearted.

hardly bestead and <u>23\_ISA\_08\_21</u># And they shall pass through it, hardly bestead and hungry: and it shall come to pass, that when they shall be hungry, they shall fret themselves, and curse their king and their God, and look upward.

hardly departeth from 42\_LUK\_09\_39 # And, lo, a spirit taketh him, and he suddenly crieth out; and it teareth him that he foameth again, and bruising him hardly departeth from him.

hardly enter into 40\_MAT\_19\_23 # Then said Jesus unto his disciples, Verily I say unto you, That a rich man shall hardly enter into the kingdom of heaven.

hardly let us <u>02\_EXO\_13\_15</u># And it came to pass, when Pharaoh would hardly let us go, that the LORD slew all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both the firstborn of man, and the firstborn of beast: therefore I sacrifice to the LORD all that openeth the matrix, being males; but all the firstborn of my children I redeem.

hardly passing it <u>44\_ACT\_27\_08</u># And, hardly passing it, came unto a place which is called The fair havens; nigh whereunto was the city [of] Lasea.

hardly shall they <u>42\_LUK\_18\_24</u> # And when Jesus saw that he was very sorrowful, he said, How hardly shall they that have riches enter into the kingdom of God!

hardly shall they <u>41\_MAR\_10\_23</u> # And Jesus looked round about, and saith unto his disciples, How hardly shall they that have riches enter into the kingdom of God!

hardly with her <u>01\_GEN\_16\_06</u># But Abram said unto Sarai, Behold, thy maid [is] in thy hand; do to her as it pleaseth thee. And when Sarai dealt hardly with her, she fled from her face.

hardness and impenitent <u>45\_ROM\_02\_05</u># But after thy hardness and impenitent heart treasurest up unto thyself wrath against the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God;

hardness and the <u>18\_JOB\_38\_38</u># When the dust groweth into hardness, and the clods cleave fast together?

hardness as a 55\_2TI\_02\_03 # Thou therefore endure hardness, as a good soldier of Jesus Christ.

hardness of heart <u>41\_MAR\_16\_14</u> # Afterward he appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and upbraided them with their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they believed not them which had seen him after he was risen.

hardness of their <u>41\_MAR\_03\_05</u># And when he had looked round about on them with anger, being grieved for the hardness of their hearts, he saith unto the man, Stretch forth thine hand. And he stretched [it] out: and his hand was restored whole as the other.
