hastily and told [09 ISA 04 14](#) # And when Eli heard the noise of the crying, he said, What [meaneth] the noise of this tumult? And the man came in hastily, and told Eli.

hastily and went [43 JOH 11 31](#) # The Jews then which were with her in the house, and comforted her, when they saw Mary, that she rose up hastily and went out, followed her, saying, She goeth unto the grave to weep there.

hastily at the [20 PRO 20 21](#) # An inheritance [may be] gotten hastily at the beginning; but the end thereof shall not be blessed.

hastily catch it [11 1KI 20 33](#) # Now the men did diligently observe whether [any thing would come] from him, and did hastily catch [it]: and they said, Thy brother Benhadad. Then he said, Go ye, bring him. Then Benhadad came forth to him; and he caused him to come up into the chariot.

hastily neither delivered [07 JUD 02 23](#) # Therefore the LORD left those nations, without driving them out hastily; neither delivered he them into the hand of Joshua.
