heaviness and comfort <u>18\_JOB\_09\_27</u> # If I say, I will forget my complaint, I will leave off my heaviness, and comfort [myself]:

heaviness and continual 45\_ROM\_09\_02 # That I have great heaviness and continual sorrow in my heart.

heaviness and having <u>15\_EZR\_09\_05</u># And at the evening sacrifice I arose up from my heaviness; and having rent my garment and my mantle, I fell upon my knees, and spread out my hands unto the LORD my God,

heaviness and I <u>19\_PSA\_69\_20</u> # Reproach hath broken my heart; and I am full of heaviness: and I looked [for some] to take pity, but [there was] none; and for comforters, but I found none.

heaviness and sorrow 23\_ISA\_29\_02 # Yet I will distress Ariel, and there shall be heaviness and sorrow: and it shall be unto me as Ariel.

heaviness because that <u>50\_PHP\_02\_26</u> # For he longed after you all, and was full of heaviness, because that ye had heard that he had been sick.

Heaviness in the <u>20\_PRO\_12\_25</u># Heaviness in the heart of man maketh it stoop: but a good word maketh it glad.

heaviness of his <u>20\_PRO\_10\_01</u># The proverbs of Solomon. A wise son maketh a glad father: but a foolish son [is] the heaviness of his mother.

heaviness strengthen thou <u>19\_PSA\_119\_28</u># My soul melteth for heaviness: strengthen thou me according unto thy word.

heaviness that they <u>23\_ISA\_61\_03</u> # To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified.

heaviness through manifold <u>60\_1PE\_01\_06</u> # Wherein ye greatly rejoice, though now for a season, if need be, ye are in heaviness through manifold temptations:

heaviness 47\_2CO\_02\_01 # But I determined this with myself, that I would not come again to you in heaviness.

heaviness <u>59\_JAM\_04\_09</u> # Be afflicted, and mourn, and weep: let your laughter be turned to mourning, and [your] joy to heaviness.

heaviness **20\_PRO\_14\_13** # Even in laughter the heart is sorrowful; and the end of that mirth [is] heaviness.
