heaviness and comfort [18 JOB 09 27](#) # If I say, I will forget my complaint, I will leave off my heaviness, and comfort [myself]:

heaviness and continual [45 ROM 09 02](#) # That I have great heaviness and continual sorrow in my heart.

heaviness and having [15 EZR 09 05](#) # And at the evening sacrifice I arose up from my heaviness; and having rent my garment and my mantle, I fell upon my knees, and spread out my hands unto the LORD my God,

heaviness and I [19 PSA 69 20](#) # Reproach hath broken my heart; and I am full of heaviness: and I looked [for some] to take pity, but [there was] none; and for comforters, but I found none.

heaviness and sorrow [23 ISA 29 02](#) # Yet I will distress Ariel, and there shall be heaviness and sorrow: and it shall be unto me as Ariel.

heaviness because that [50 PHP 02 26](#) # For he longed after you all, and was full of heaviness, because that ye had heard that he had been sick.

Heaviness in the [20 PRO 12 25](#) # Heaviness in the heart of man maketh it stoop: but a good word maketh it glad.

heaviness of his [20 PRO 10 01](#) # The proverbs of Solomon. A wise son maketh a glad father: but a foolish son [is] the heaviness of his mother.

heaviness strengthen thou [19 PSA 119 28](#) # My soul melteth for heaviness: strengthen thou me according unto thy word.

heaviness that they [23 ISA 61 03](#) # To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified.

heaviness through manifold [60 1PE 01 06](#) # Wherein ye greatly rejoice, though now for a season, if need be, ye are in heaviness through manifold temptations:

heaviness [47 2CO 02 01](#) # But I determined this with myself, that I would not come again to you in heaviness.

heaviness [59 JAM 04 09](#) # Be afflicted, and mourn, and weep: let your laughter be turned to mourning, and [your] joy to heaviness.
