hiss and gnash 25 LAM 02 16 # All thine enemies have opened their mouth against thee: they hiss and gnash the teeth: they say, We have swallowed [her] up: certainly this [is] the day that we looked for; we have found, we have seen [it].

hiss and they 11 1KI 09 08# And at this house, [which] is high, every one that passeth by it shall be astonished, and shall hiss; and they shall say, Why hath the LORD done thus unto this land, and to this house?

hiss and wag 25 LAM 02 15 # All that pass by clap [their] hands at thee; they hiss and wag their head at the daughter of Jerusalem, [saying, Is] this the city that [men] call The perfection of beauty, The joy of the whole earth?

hiss and wag 36 ZEP 02 15 # This [is] the rejoicing city that dwelt carelessly, that said in her heart, I [am], and [there is] none beside me: how is she become a desolation, a place for beasts to lie down in! every one that passeth by her shall hiss, [and] wag his hand.

hiss at all 24 JER 49 17 # Also Edom shall be a desolation: every one that goeth by it shall be astonished, and shall hiss at all the plagues thereof.

hiss at all 24 JER 50 13 # Because of the wrath of the LORD it shall not be inhabited, but it shall be wholly desolate: every one that goeth by Babylon shall be astonished, and hiss at all her plagues.

hiss at thee 26 EZE 27 36 # The merchants among the people shall hiss at thee; thou shalt be a terror, and never [shalt be] any more.

hiss because of 24 JER 19 08# And I will make this city desolate, and an hissing; every one that passeth thereby shall be astonished and hiss because of all the plagues thereof.

hiss for the 23 ISA 07 18# And it shall come to pass in that day, [that] the LORD shall hiss for the fly that [is] in the uttermost part of the rivers of Egypt, and for the bee that [is] in the land of Assyria.

hiss for them 38 ZEC 10 08 # I will hiss for them, and gather them; for I have redeemed them: and they shall increase as they have increased.

hiss him out 18 JOB 27 23 # [Men] shall clap their hands at him, and shall hiss him out of his place.

hiss unto them 23 ISA 05 26# And he will lift up an ensign to the nations from far, and will hiss unto them from the end of the earth: and, behold, they shall come with speed swiftly:

hissing and a 24 JER 25 18# [To wit], Jerusalem, and the cities of Judah, and the kings thereof, and the princes thereof, to make them a desolation, an astonishment, an hissing, and a curse; as [it is] this day;

hissing and a 24 JER 29 18 # And I will persecute them with the sword, with the famine, and with the pestilence, and will deliver them to be removed to all the kingdoms of the earth, to be a curse, and an astonishment, and an hissing, and a reproach, among all the nations whither I have driven them:

hissing and perpetual 24 JER 25 09 # Behold, I will send and take all the families of the north, saith the LORD, and Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon, my servant, and will bring them against this land, and against the inhabitants thereof, and against all these nations round about, and will utterly destroy them, and make them an astonishment, and an hissing, and perpetual desolations.

hissing as ye 14 2CH 29 08 # Wherefore the wrath of the LORD was upon Judah and Jerusalem, and he hath delivered them to trouble, to astonishment, and to hissing, as ye see with your eyes.

hissing every one 24 JER 18 16 #To make their land desolate, [and] a perpetual hissing; every one that passeth thereby shall be astonished, and wag his head.

hissing every one 24 JER 19 08# And I will make this city desolate, and an hissing; every one that passeth thereby shall be astonished and hiss because of all the plagues thereof.

hissing therefore ye 33 MIC 06 16 # For the statutes of Omri are kept, and all the works of the house of Ahab, and ye walk in their counsels; that I should make thee a desolation, and the inhabitants thereof an hissing: therefore ye shall bear the reproach of my people.

hissing without an 24 JER 51 37 # And Babylon shall become heaps, a dwellingplace for dragons, and astonishment, and an hissing, without an inhabitant.
